#### imaginable

adj. capable of being imagined

synonym: conceivable, plausible, possible

(1) easily imaginable, (2) worst imaginable case

This is the only **imaginable** strategy.

#### minuscule

adj. extremely small; tiny

synonym: tiny, insignificant, microscopic

(1) minuscule amount, (2) minuscule letters

This ore emits **minuscule** quantities of radiation

#### proton

- a very small particle with a positive charge equal to the negative charge of an electron that forms part of the nucleus of all atoms
- (1) proton decay, (2) proton conductivity

The solar wind is composed almost entirely of electrons and **protons**.

#### quark

- n. a type of elementary particle and a fundamental constituent of matter that make up the heavier elementary particles, such as protons, neutrons, etc.; fresh unripened cheese of a smooth texture made from pasteurized milk, a starter, and rennet
- (1) **quark** physics, (2) the antiparticle of a **quark**The Big Bang theory states that **quark-gluon** plasma filled the entire universe before matter as we know it was created.

#### neutrino

- a very small and electrically neutral particle with a very small mass that rarely reacts with other matter
- (1) neutrino capture, (2) sterile neutrinos

This laboratory has a pool consisting of thousands of **neutrino** detectors.

#### nanosecond

- one thousand millionth or billionth (= 0.000,000,001) of a second
- (1) **nanosecond** response, (2) **nanosecond** laser pulse The processor performs calculations on the **nanosecond** timescale.

#### multiverse

- a hypothetical space or realm consisting of multiple universes, of which our universe is just one of them
- (1) the **multiverse** hypothesis, (2) the concept of the **multiverse**

The various universes within the **multiverse** are sometimes called parallel universes.

#### observable

adj. that can be noticed or seen

synonym: visible, perceptible, detectable

observable change, (2) experimentally observable
 Any theorem relies on both observable fact and assumption.

#### wrinkle

 a small line or fold in something, especially fabric or the skin of the face; a minor difficulty

synonym: crinkle, fold, crumple

(1) a fine **wrinkle** on a fabric, (2) a facial **wrinkle**This suit is made of **wrinkle-proof** material.

#### baffle

v. to bewilder or perplex someone completely and to be unable to understand or explain something

*synonym*: perplex, astound, hinder

(1) **baffle** his plan, (2) **baffle** outside noises The paradox **baffled** most philosophers.

#### spawn

v. to lay eggs or to produce offspring; to cause something to develop

*synonym*: beget, breed, generate

synonym: nonsense, bunk, ludicrousness
