probabilistic

adj. characterized by the influence of chance or probability;

 estimate likelihoods or risks

synonym: probable, statistical, likely

(1) **probabilistic** model, (2) **probabilistic** approach In a **probabilistic** system, the outcome is uncertain and can vary based on chance.

trait

n. a particular feature of your nature

synonym: attribute, feature, quality

(1) chemical **trait**, (2) personality **traits**

Multiple genes may influence behavioral traits concurrently.

descendant

n. children or offspring of a specific person, plant, or animal

synonym: child, offspring, heir

(1) descendant of a pioneer, (2) third-generation

descendant

Those warriors' **descendants** are still skilled archers.

monk

 a member of a religious community of men living under vows of poverty, chastity, and obedience

synonym: friar, cleric, brother

(1) monk lifestyle, (2) cloistered monk

The ascetic **monk** spent his days in prayer and contemplation in the monastery.

pea

 a small, round, green vegetable that grows in pods on a climbing plant and is eaten as a vegetable

synonym: legume, bean, pulse

(1) **pea** protein, (2) **pea** family

She shelled the **peas** and added them to the pot.

monastery

 a building or complex of buildings in which members of a male religious community, called monks, live and worship

synonym: abbey, convent, friary

(1) monastery garden, (2) leave a monastery

This ancient **monastery** was founded in the 13th century and had a long history of religious devotion.

purebred

 adj. belonging to a specific breed, type, or strain of animal, particularly a dog or horse, that has been selectively bred for specific traits over several generations

synonym: pedigreed, thoroughbred, pureblooded

(1) purebred dog, (2) purebred horse

The breeder assured us that our new puppy was **purebred** and came from a long line of champions.

fertilize

v. to cause an egg, female animal, or plant to develop by joining sperm from the male with them; to add a natural or chemical substance to land to make plants grow well

synonym: pollinate, inseminate, enrich

The couple decided to use the non-husband sperm to **fertilize** a wife.

recessive

adj. of or relating to the state of the economy declines; (of a gene) controlling a characteristic that is expressed only when a dominant allele is not present

synonym: latent, dormant, hidden

(1) recessive allele, (2) recessive mutant

The **recessive** gene for blue eyes is only expressed when both parents carry the gene.

infer

 ν . to form an opinion or conclude that something is true based on existing facts

synonym: guess, deduce, assume

(1) **infer** quality from price, (2) **infer** the possibility Animal desire and preference are always **inferred** from their behavior.

allele

 any of the alternative forms of a gene that can occupy a given chromosomal location

synonym: gene variant, genetic variant

(1) the allele in a pair, (2) inherit one allele

Environmental factors can also influence the expression of **alleles**, a phenomenon known as epigenetics.

homozygous

 adj. possessing identical alleles for a particular gene, having inherited the same version of the gene from both parents

synonym: same, identical

(1) **homozygous** allele, (2) **homozygous** mutation

The plant displayed the trait of resistance to pests due to

being homozygous for the resistant gene.

heterozygous

adj. possessing different alleles for a particular gene, having inherited different versions of the gene from each parent

synonym: mixed, non-identical

She inherited the genetic disorder because she is **heterozygous** for the mutated gene.

genotype

 the genetic constitution of an individual organism; the inherited collection of genes that determine an organism's traits and characteristics

synonym: genetic constitution

(1) **genotype** frequency, (2) heterozygous **genotype**The baby's **genotype** is determined by the combination of genes inherited from its parents.

phenotype

n. the observable physical or biochemical characteristics of an individual organism that result from the interaction between its genetic makeup and the environment in which it lives

synonym: trait, characteristic, attribute

phenotype variation, (2) dominant phenotype
 Our genetic phenotype determines the color of our eyes.

visualize

 to form a mental image or concept of something; to make something visible

synonym: imagine, picture, envision

- (1) **visualize** data, (2) **visualize** flying through space She tried to **visualize** the layout of the new house in her mind.
- a tool with a metal blade that is usually attached to a wooden handle and is used for chopping wood or other materials

synonym: hatchet, chopper, tomahawk

uppercase

 the capital form of a letter in a written or printed text; text or writing that is predominantly or exclusively in capital letters

synonym: capital, capital letter, majuscule

lowercase

 a letter or typeface that is small in size and typically sits below the baseline of a line of text; opposite of uppercase

synonym: small letters, minuscule
