### spectacular

adj. striking or impressive to look at or in performance or achievement

#### fashion

 a style that is popular at a particular time or place; the state of being popular

synonym: style, manner, fad

### picky

 adj. overly particular or selective, especially about food or other consumable goods; difficult to please or satisfy because of one's specific tastes or preferences

*synonym*: fussy, choosy, particular

My **picky** eater only likes to eat certain types of vegetables.

### constantly

adv. all the time

synonym: continuously, always, frequently

(1) a **constantly** innovative enterprise, (2) a **constantly** varying mind

The mobile application industry is **constantly** changing.

#### formula

 a group of symbols, letters, or numbers that represent a rule, law, or mathematical statement

synonym: expression, recipe, procedure

(1) structural formula, (2) a binomial formula

The teacher told the students to memorize the math **formula**.

#### chart

 a visual display of information such as a diagram, lists of figures, etc.; a map designed to assist navigation by air or sea

synonym: diagram, graph, map

(1) a weather chart, (2) a statistical chart

This pie **chart** represents our market share.

#### tight

adj. fixed, fastened, or kept together firmly or closely

synonym: closed, secured, cramped

(1) a tight game, (2) student on a tight budget

The national election was held amid tight security.

#### knit

v. to make a garment or fabric by interlocking loops of yarn with needles or a machine

synonym: weave, crochet, knot

(1) **knit** my eyebrows, (2) **knit** a pair of socks

The grandmother **knit** a warm sweater for her grandchild.

### breakup

the end of a relationship between persons or nations;
 the separation of something into several pieces or sections

*synonym*: breakdown, divorce, separation

(1) a **breakup** hug, (2) air **breakup** 

He got over the big **breakup** with his wife.

#### monogamy

 the practice of being married to only one person at a time; the state of having a mutually exclusive romantic or sexual relationship with one partner

synonym: marriage, monandry, monogamousness

(1) monogamy rules, (2) practice monogamy

Many religious institutions promote **monogamy** as the ideal form of marriage.

#### cohabit

- v. to live together in a sexual relationship without being married; to inhabit or occupy the same space or dwellingsynonym: live together, reside, dwell

#### engage

v. to attract and keep someone's attention and interest; to participate in or obtain services of something

### strategy

 a detailed plan of action designed to achieve a long-term or overall goal.

#### variable

adj. likely to change or vary often; (noun) a symbol, like x or y, that is used in mathematical or logical expressions to represent a value that may be changed

*synonym*: erratic, inconsistent, irregular

(1) a **variable** species, (2) a dependent **variable** Rainfall in the tropics is highly **variable**.

### serendipity

 the occurrence and development of events by chance in a happy or beneficial way; a fortunate accident or discovery

synonym: luck, chance, fortune

(1) **serendipity** moment, (2) **serendipity** discovery The discovery of penicillin was a result of **serendipity**.

### probabilistic

adj. characterized by the influence of chance or probability;
 involving the use of statistical models or methods to
 estimate likelihoods or risks

synonym: probable, statistical, likely

(1) **probabilistic** model, (2) **probabilistic** approach In a **probabilistic** system, the outcome is uncertain and can vary based on chance.

### possibility

- n. a chance that something may happen or be truesynonym: chance, prospect, likelihood

#### mathematics

 the science dealing with the logic of quantities, shapes, spaces, and arrangement

#### population

n. the total number of people in a country, region, or location

#### matchmake

### questionnaire

#### résumé

### descriptive

#### award

a prize or other mark of recognition given in honor of an achievement

synonym: prize, honor, accolade

award ceremony, (2) participation award
 He won the award for best actor at the film festival.

### journalist

 a person who collects and writes news stories or articles for newspapers, magazines, radio, television, or other online media

synonym: reporter, newsperson, press

(1) a China-based **journalist**, (2) **journalist** on a magazine Foreign TV crews and **journalists** can go as they please in various locations during the Olympics.

#### monetize

v. to earn money from something, such as an asset, business, etc.; to coin into money

synonym: mint, make profit

(1) monetize my skill, (2) monetize nickel

He explored ways to **monetize** his digital content.

#### fluent

adj. able to communicate in a specific language smoothly or effectively, or easily

synonym: eloquent, articulate, smooth-spoken

(1) fluent Chinese, (2) in a fluent tone

She learned five languages but is only **fluent** in two of them.

#### obvious

adj. easy to see, discover or understand synonym: apparent, conspicuous, evident

### gadget

- n. a small tool or device that is useful for a particular jobsynonym: appliance, gimmick, device

#### invite

#### bat

n. a nocturnal animal with wings that flies and feeds at night, similar to a mouse; a piece of wood with a handle used for hitting the ball in sports including baseball, cricket, and table tennis

The cave was a habitat for **bats**.

#### conversation

n. an informal talk between two or more people to exchange their views, ideas, information, etc.

flee

v. to leave by running away, especially out of fear or danger

### appetizer

### suddenly

#### pile

#### modern

*adj.* of or belonging to the present time or recent times *synonym*: contemporary, stylish, current

split

v. to divide, or to make something divide into two or more parts, especially along a particular line

synonym: break, divide, break apart

gasp

v. to inhale sharply and audibly, often in response to strong emotion or sensation; to catch one's breath suddenly, often due to shock or surprise

needless

 adj. describing something unnecessary, pointless, or superfluous and could be avoided without any harm or adverse consequences

This **needless** paperwork is wasting our time and resources.

complain

 to say dissatisfaction or annoyance about something or somebody

synonym: gripe, claim, denounce

(1) **complain** about a job, (2) call and **complain** frequently Our users are often **complaining** about the slow application.

laptop

- a portable computer that is small enough to be carried around easily and used on your lap
- (1) bring my **laptop**, (2) thin-and-light **laptop**I need to finish this report by tonight, so I'll be working on my **laptop** all day.

shove

- v. to push someone or something in a rough waysynonym: push, jab, elbow
- (1) **shove** a person aside, (2) **shove** hamburger into my mouth

He forcibly **shoved** the flyer into my bag.

#### template

 a pre-designed file or document used as a starting point for a particular application so that the format does not have to be created from scratch

synonym: pattern, model, blueprint

(1) template file, (2) template design

The **template** format provided a useful guide for creating the budget.

### empirical

adj. based on or verifiable by observation or experience rather than theory or pure logic

synonym: observational, experiential, factual

(1) empirical research, (2) empirical philosophy

The study's results were based on **empirical** evidence gathered from extensive research.

#### awkward

adj. making you feel uncomfortable or embarrassed; causing inconvenience or difficulty

synonym: embarrassing, discomfiting, clumsy

The **awkward** design of the interface made the operation difficult.

#### remark

 a comment or observation, or something said or written about a particular subject or situation; (verb) to give a spoken statement on a particular subject or situation

### vocabulary

n. the words used by a language, group, or individual; the knowledge and understanding of words and their meanings that a person possesses

synonym: lexicon, glossary, dictionary

(1) **vocabulary** list, (2) academic **vocabulary** Using proper **vocabulary** is essential for writing a good essay.

#### crunch

a loud, crackling noise made by something being crushed or broken; a difficult or critical situation
 synonym: crushing, snapping, crisis

#### correlation

 a statistical relationship between two variables in which one variable is affected by the other; a reciprocal relation between two or more facts, numbers, etc.

#### scotch

kink

refer

synonym: bend, twist, curl

v. to face, meet or deal with a problem or difficult situation or person

synonym: engage, encounter, contend

#### blank

adj. without any writing or printing; empty or devoid of ideas, information, or meaning; unable to remember or recall information

synonym: empty, void, barren

(1) blank expression, (2) blank paper

The computer screen displayed nothing but a **blank** white screen

#### suppose

- v. to think that something is likely to be actual or possible synonym: guess, assume, presume
- (1) **suppose** you're right, (2) **suppose** beforehand What do you **suppose** the culprit's motive was?

brutal

adj. harsh or cruel

synonym: harsh, cruel, barbarous

(1) brutal bully, (2) brutal honesty

The **brutal** attack left the victim with serious injuries.

horror

 intense fear or disgust, especially at something shocking or terrifying

synonym: fear, terror, dread

(1) horror movie, (2) horror-struck look

The stories of war crimes filled her with horror.

romantic

adj. of or relating to love or a sexual relationship

synonym: idealistic, unrealistic, amatory

(1) romantic movies, (2) romantic breakup

It was his first romantic love.

pal

*n.* a close friend

synonym: buddy, friend, chum

(1) baseball pal, (2) long-time pal

She is a pen pal of mine.

superficial

adj. existing or occurring only at or on the surface; appearing to be true or real only until examined more closely

synonym: shallow, facile, cursory

(1) superficial wound, (2) superficial knowledge

The journalist's **superficial** reporting should have captured the full scope of the issue.

database

- a large amount of data stored in a computer system in such a way that it can be searched and updated easily
- (1) **database** administrator, (2) employee **database**Each country's officials can access the central **database**.

reverse

 to change something's direction, order, position, decision, etc., to the opposite one; (adjective) directed or moving toward the rear

synonym: overturn, shift, switch

(1) **reverse** the trend, (2) **reverse** the order The restaurant **reversed** a ban on smoking.

### engineer

- n. a person whose job is designing, building, or maintaining something such as machines, structures, or software
   synonym: architect, creator, builder
- (1) a civil engineer, (2) engineer shortageThe engineer will repair my telephone tomorrow morning.

#### amass

v. to accumulate or gather a large quantity of something over time; to collect or assemble for future use or reference

synonym: gather, collect, accumulate

(1) **amass** a patent portfolio, (2) **amass** followers

She had **amassed** a fortune through wise investments and shrewd business decisions.

### background

 the details of a person's social heritage, such as family, vocational or educational experience; past information that is essential to understanding a situation or problem

synonym: ground, experience, backdrop

(1) a **background** color, (2) a criminal **background**The company's hiring criteria emphasize personality, not a person's **background**.

### synagogue

n. (also "shul") a Jewish house of worship, typically consisting of a hall for prayer and study and often containing a sanctuary, a social hall, and a collection of administrative offices

synonym: temple, shul, tabernacle

(1) reconstructed **synagogue**, (2) historical **synagogue** We attended services at the local **synagogue** during the High Holidays.

#### launch

v. to send or propel something into the air or space using a device such as a rocket, missile, or spacecraft; to make something available or on sale for the first time

synonym: start, initiate, begin

(1) **launch** a spaceship into orbit, (2) **launch** a big attack The company is set to **launch** its new product line next month.

#### attitude

- the way you think and feel about someone or something *synonym*: mindset, perspective, philosophy

### wrangle

a noisy or contentious dispute or argument, particularly one involving multiple parties; a physical altercation or brawl; (verb) to have a dispute or argument, often over a trivial matter

*synonym*: argument, dispute, quarrel

(1) wrangle over money, (2) political wrangle The two politicians had a heated wrangle over the proposed tax reform.

fling

- to throw or push something or someone with force or recklessness, especially because you are angry synonym: throw, dump, hurl
- (1) fling a stream of abuse, (2) fling a door open forcefully

#### exotic

He was provoked to **fling** the draft on the floor.

adj. originating from or characteristic of a foreign country or culture; strikingly unusual, uncommon, or intriguing synonym: foreign, alien, unfamiliar

(1) exotic species, (2) exotic vacation I love trying **exotic** foods from different cultures.

### weigh

to have a particular weight; to carefully evaluate things before making a conclusion

synonym: consider, cogitate, count

(1) weigh heavily on stock prices, (2) weigh a cargo The baby weighs 1 pound 3 oz.

#### pound

- the standard unit of money in the UK; the standard unit of weight equal to 16 ounces
- (1) three-fourths of a **pound**, (2) thousands of **pounds**. The car's front bumper cost fifteen hundred **pounds**.

### regardless

 adv. not paying attention or considering something or someone even if the situation is bad or there are difficulties

synonym: anyhow, nevertheless, still

(1) **regardless** of the difficulties, (2) **regardless** tread People can pick out superior products **regardless** of the quality of the advertising.

### prioritize

v. to assign a higher level of importance to something compared to other things

synonym: rank, order, arrange

- tier n. one of a series of rows or levels arranged one above the other, typically used to describe the arrangement of

synonym: level, layer, class

objects or levels of importance

rank

 a position in a hierarchy of status or authority; (verb) to take or have a position relative to others

synonym: position, status, standing

(1) rank amateur, (2) high rank

He was promoted to the **rank** of captain in the military.

#### stimulate

to encourage something to develop or become more active; to stir the feelings or emotions

synonym: excite, provoke, arouse

(1) **stimulate** the economy, (2) **stimulate** the nervous

#### system

The book **stimulated** my imagination.

#### balance

 a condition in which everything has the same weight or force; something left after other parts have been taken away

synonym: equilibrium, counterpoise, remainder

(1) the **balance** of power, (2) asset on the company's **balance** sheet

Try to keep a **balance** between work and off.

### necessarily

adv. in an essential manner; in such a way as could not be otherwise

*synonym*: inevitable, certainly, automatically

(1) not **necessarily** a problem, (2) **necessarily** true

This accident was something that happened **necessarily**.

#### deal-breaker

 a condition, demand, or factor that is essential or critical in a negotiation, contract, or relationship; failure to meet this condition may result in a breakdown or abandonment of the deal or agreement

*synonym*: stumbling block, showstopper

(1) **deal-breaker** issue, (2) financial **deal-breaker**Not liking the same music was a **deal-breaker** for their relationship.

#### calculate

v. to judge or find out the amount or number of something by using mathematics

*synonym*: compute, figure, estimate

(1) **calculate** the distance, (2) **calculate** his credit score He couldn't **calculate** the actual value of the artwork.

#### threshold

n. the floor or ground that forms the bottom of a doorway and offers support when passing through a doorway; the smallest detectable sensation

synonym: anteroom, brink, verge

(1) the **threshold** between rooms, (2) high pain **threshold** 

She's on the **threshold** of adulthood.

### incredibly

adv. in a way that is very difficult to believe; exceedingly or extremely

synonym: enormously, exceptionally, extraordinarily

#### hike

 a long walk or journey, especially for pleasure or exercise; an increase in cost

#### involve

v. to include or affect someone or something as a necessary part of something else

#### cruise

 a voyage on a large ship for pleasure; driving or traveling at a leisurely pace

#### crack
