The book designer chose a font with an elegant **serif** to enhance readability.

deem

- v. to consider or decide something in a particular way synonym: believe, consider, suppose
- (1) **deem** socially responsible, (2) **deem** wrong or inappropriate

Regarding earthquakes, some commercial buildings were **deemed** unsafe.

doe

 a mature female of mammals of which the male is called a buck, such as a deer or a rabbit

synonym: rabbit, bunny, hare

(1) doe rabbit, (2) buck and doe

Hunters use a whistle that makes the **doe** sound to lure stags.

consciously

adv. with awareness; in a deliberate manner *synonym*: intentionally, deliberately, knowingly

(1) **consciously** aware of a problem, (2) act **consciously** He **consciously** criticizes her in the publicity.

overpass

n. a bridge or elevated roadway that passes over a road, railway, or other obstruction, typically designed to improve traffic flow by allowing vehicles to pass over or bypass an obstacle

synonym: bridge, flyover, viaduct

The **overpass** over the busy highway made getting to the other side much easier without waiting in traffic.

sideshow

lenticular
