revive

synonym: reanimate, rejuvenate, renew

artistic

adj. of or relating to art or artist; satisfying aesthetic standards and sensibilities

synonym: beautiful, aesthetic, creative

(1) an **artistic** photograph, (2) cultural and **artistic** activity Promising entrepreneurs often have a high artistic sensibility.

context

the circumstances, facts, or conditions that surround a particular event, situation, or statement and that give it meaning

synonym: background, setting, environment

(1) historical context, (2) legal context It's important to understand the **context** of a situation before making a decision.

elect

to choose someone for a specific position by voting for them; to decide or choose to do something

synonym: select, choose, prefer

(1) **elect** the school board, (2) **elect** death Every five years, the provincial governors are **elected**.

splash

to cause liquid to scatter in irregular drops, especially with force

synonym: scatter, dash, gurgle

(1) **splash** water, (2) **splash** everywhere The mountain was **splashed** with snow.

radiant

adj. emitting light or heat; shining brightly

synonym: shining, glowing, brilliant

(1) radiant smile, (2) radiant light

She looked **radiant** on her wedding day.

somber

adj. having a serious or sad atmosphere or character; gloomy or dark

synonym: gloomy, dark, dreary

(1) a suit of **somber** black, (2) **somber** atmosphere

The **somber** mood at the funeral was palpable.

facade

n. the face or front of a building, especially a large one;
 superficial or false appearance intended to conceal
 something unpleasant

unimaginable

traffic

jam

spectacular

accident

 an unfortunate event, especially one causing damage or injury

synonym: calamity, casualty, chance

(1) cause an **accident**, (2) injury in a car **accident** The **accident** partially destroyed my vehicle.

sight

n. the ability to see; anything that is seen

synonym: vision, spectacle, view

(1) an unexpected **sight**, (2) dull **sight**

Many famous sights are within walking distance.

screech

v. to make a loud, high-pitched, piercing sound, often indicating pain or fear

synonym: shriek, scream, yelp

financing

 the process of providing funds for running a business, activity, or project; the money for a business, activity, or project synonym: funding, loan, expenditure

The investment fund offered **financing** for a company on the brink of bankruptcy.

surround

- v. to be all around something or somebodysynonym: encircle, encompass, envelop

confer

v. to have a meeting or discussion to come to a decision or agreement or exchange ideas; to bestow something

censor

a person or institution responsible for examining books, movies, and other forms of media to determine if they are harmful or offensive and should be banned or altered; an official in charge of banning or suppressing information

socialist

compromise

pride

bury

- v. to place a dead body in the ground, grave, or tomb synonym: entomb, sink, forget
- (1) **bury** in the earth, (2) **bury** emotion There is plenty of space to **bury** everyone.

fury

n. intense and often violent anger

synonym: rage, wrath, ire

(1) market fury, (2) fury of the storm

The crowd's **fury** was palpable as they shouted and protested against the government's decision.

barbaric

 adj. characterized by extreme cruelty or brutal violence;
 resembling the behaviors or practices of a barbarian or uncivilized society

synonym: savage, cruel, primitive

(1) barbaric treatment, (2) barbaric act

The **barbaric** practice of gladiator fighting was popular in ancient Rome.

mood

 the way you feel at a particular time; an angry or impatient state of mind

synonym: mindset, disposition, temper

transform

v. to change in outward structure or looks;

synonym: alter, convert, change

(1) **transform** an education system, (2) **transform** heat into power

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My father's death **transformed** my life completely.

spirit

poll

n. the part of a person which is the seat of their mind, feelings, and character rather than their physical body; the general atmosphere of a place or situation and the effect that it has on people

synonym: soul, attitude, enthusiasm

- an inquiry into public opinion conducted by interviewing a random sample of people; the process of voting at an election

fascinating

municipal

adj. of or relating to a municipality, which is a small administrative division within a larger city or townsynonym: civic, city, urban

process

n. a series of actions or operations performed to achieve a particular outcome or goal; a systematic procedure or approach used to accomplish a specific task or objective; a method of treating milk to make it suitable for consumption or use in other dairy products

synonym: procedure, method, system

shopkeeper

 a person who owns or manages a shop, especially a small local business

garbage

- n. waste material, especially food waste and kitchen refusesynonym: waste, trash, debris

pave

pothole

 a hole or depression in a road surface, usually caused by wear, weathering, or erosion; can be dangerous to drivers and cause damage to vehicles

misplace

barb

concrete

 adj. existing in a physical or material form rather than an abstract one; based on facts rather than ideas or guesses; made of or covered with cement

riverbank

 the land along the edge of a river, often used for recreation or agricultural purposes

synonym: riverside, embankment

demolish

 to completely destroy or tear down a building, structure, or other entity; to ruin or eliminate the effectiveness or power of something

The city decided to **demolish** the old, unsafe building and build a new one.

bush

 a plant growing thickly with many small branches and several stiff stems coming up from the root

synonym: copse, scrub, brushwood

businessperson

a person who is engaged in business, typically as an owner or executive

synonym: entrepreneur, executive

(1) a young **businessperson**, (2) **businessperson** network He was a successful **businessperson** and had much experience in the field.

regularly

adv. at regular intervals or times

synonym: repeatedly, routinely, usually

(1) **regularly** arranged, (2) post **regularly** to a blog This site **regularly** shares high-quality academic materials.

competition

 a situation in which someone is attempting to beat or outperform another

synonym: contest, match, fight

(1) the first round of the **competition**, (2) intraspecific

competition

Global **competition** is rising in virtually every industry.

recruit

v. to persuade someone to work for a company; to find new members for an organization, the armed forces, etc.

synonym: raise, enroll, enlist

(1) recruit a good worker, (2) recruit a new hire

The colonial government **recruited** militia support when civil war broke out.

administer

v. to oversee and control the operation or arrangement of something

synonym: allocate, distribute, dispense

(1) administer justice, (2) administer the funds

After the accident, three governmental bodies **administer** the company.

politicize

v. to make something political or to involve it in politics, often for personal or ideological gain or to influence public opinion

synonym: politize, exploit, manipulate

(1) **politicize** climate change, (2) **politicize** a tragedy I wish people would stop trying to **politicize** fundamental human rights issues.

institutionalize

v. to establish or make something a part of an institution (= a place such as a university, hospital, etc.)

synonym: formalize, establish, regularize

The new policy aims to **institutionalize** the use of renewable energy sources.

represent

v. to speak, act, or be present on behalf of another person or group; to form or constitute

invest

v. to put money, effort, time, etc. into something to make a profit or achieve a result

synonym: fund, sponsor, support

(1) **invest** in stocks, (2) **invest** capital

The government should view children as national assets and actively **invest** in them.

finance

n. the management of money, credit, banking, and investments, especially by a government or commercial organization; the branch of economics that studies the management of money and other assets

synonym: banking, investment, fund

(1) finance act, (2) manage my finances

Our company decided to hire an advisor who specializes in **finance**.

reception

- n. the act of receiving or the state of being received, especially warmly or kindly; a formal party of people synonym: welcome, greeting, party

precise

adj. sharply exact or accurate or delimitedsynonym: accurate, exact, distinct

endemic

 adj. (of a disease or other problem) regularly found among particular people or in a certain area

synonym: prevalent, widespread, native

(1) **endemic** disease, (2) cholera- **endemic** area Malaria is **endemic** in many tropical countries.

corruption

queue

n. dishonest, harmful, or illegal behavior, especially of people in positions of power

synonym: depravity, bribery, degeneration

- (1) **corruption** accusation, (2) federal **corruption** charges Rampant **corruption** led to a loss of trust in the government.
- a line of people or vehicles, especially one that forms outside a place of entertainment or a public building,

synonym: range, sequence, waiting line

form a queue, (2) queue system
 There was a long queue at the popular attraction.

certificate

n. an official document stating that the information contained within is true

waiting for something to become available

synonym: diploma, credential, certification

- n. a small, often freestanding structure or booth, typically used as a retail outlet or information center, particularly in a public space or high-traffic area

synonym: booth, stand, counter

- to move along lightly and quickly, making a step from one foot to the other with a hop or bounce; to intentionally fail to do something which would normally do

skip

mysterious

adj. difficult to understand, explain, or identify; having an aura of secrecy, intrigue, or puzzlement

synonym: enigmatic, cryptic, puzzling

bribe

v. to try to make someone do something to gain one's favors or influence by giving a gift of money or other inducements

synonym: graft, corrupt

invisible

adj. impossible or nearly impossible to see

synonym: hidden, imperceptible, unseen

(1) an **invisible** asset, (2) **invisible** stars

The phenomenon is **invisible** at optical wavelengths.

clerk

 a person who works in an office and is responsible for keeping records, writing letters, etc.; a person who works in a store and is responsible for serving customers

synonym: worker, record-keeper, letter-writer

(1) clerk job, (2) clerk position

The **clerk** at the store helped me find what I needed.

corrupt

adj. characterized by dishonest behavior or actions, often involving bribery, fraud, or the abuse of power for personal gain; morally or ethically flawed or polluted; (verb) to make someone or something morally depraved or causing it to become dishonest

synonym: dishonest, unethical, immoral

(1) corrupt good manners, (2) corrupt discipline

The **corrupt** politician was finally exposed and faced criminal charges.

convinced

adj. completely certain about something; having a strong belief or conviction in a particular religion

synonym: confident, positive, indoctrinated

(1) **convinced** of the idea, (2) **convinced** criminal The public is **convinced** that the prime minister has committed fraud.

germ

 a very tiny living that causes the disease; a piece of something such as an organism, concept, etc., capable of growing into a new one or part of one

synonym: bacterium, microbe, pathogen

(1) antibiotic-resistant **germ**, (2) a **germ-free** environment The **germ** of his idea came from watching birds flying in flocks.

conscience

- a person's inner sense of what is right or wrong in their conduct or motives, viewed as a guide to their behavior
 synonym: morality, ethics, scruples
- (1) inner **conscience**, (2) guilty **conscience**He couldn't bear the thought of acting against his **conscience**, even if it meant losing the job.

environment

n. the natural world such as air, water, and land in which humans, animals, and plants live

synonym: atmosphere, surroundings, climate

 Every human is responsible for taking care of the Earth's environment.

modernize

v. to bring up to date or make contemporary in style or function; to bring modern methods or resources into an existing organization or system

synonym: develop, update, upgrade

reinvent

v. to change something so drastically that it looks to be completely new

synonym: recreate, remake, revive

government

 n. the group of people with authority to control a country or state

synonym: administration, regime, state

(1) **government** bureaucracy, (2) **government** funding The federal **government** is planning to increase taxes for the next fiscal year.

ready-made

adj. (of a product) already made or prepared; (of an idea or solution) preconceived or complete and requiring no further development or work

synonym: pre-made, off-the-shelf, prefab

formula

vain

adj. having an excessively high opinion of oneself; excessively concerned with one's appearance or achievements; producing no result or effect, or being unsuccessful

impose

resemble

cynical

synonym: skeptical, mistrustful, doubtful

stadium

 a large, usually roofless building with tiers of seats for spectators at sports or other events

gradual

adj. happening slowly over a long period of time or distance; not steep or abrupt

blind

adj. unable to see; unable or unwilling to perceive or understand the true nature of something

inspire

synonym: boost, encourage, enlighten

aggressive

adj. behaving in an angry, energetic, or threatening way towards another person; tending to spread quicklysynonym: assertive, combative, threatening

pessimism

n. a tendency to see the worst in things and anticipate adverse outcomes; a belief that the world is generally bad or that something will go wrong more often than it will go right

cohesion

 the quality of inventing things or solving problems in clever new ways
