likable

adj. having qualities that make a person or thing well-liked or attractive; pleasant, friendly, or enjoyable

synonym: sympathetic, appealing, charming

(1) likable personality, (2) a likable character

He's a very **likable** person who makes friends easily.

protagonist

the main character in a literary work, film, or other stories

synonym: hero, central figure, leading character

(1) protagonist of drama, (2) play a protagonist

The **protagonist's** triumph over adversity was the theme of this play.

congratulation

n. the act of expressing that someone has an occasion for celebration or the expression of pleasure at the success or good fortune of another

synonym: praise, compliment, felicitation

(1) **congratulation** on a promotion, (2) a matter for **congratulation**

The **congratulations** from her friends and family were overwhelming after she won the championship.

contradictory

adj. containing or consisting of conflicting or incompatible elements

synonym: conflicting, opposing, inconsistent

(1) apparently **contradictory**, (2) **contradictory** evidence His statements were **contradictory**, leaving the audience confused.

weir

 a barrier or dam built across a river or waterway to control the flow of water; a low dam or fence used to trap fish

synonym: dam, barrages, barricade

(1) weir on a river, (2) diversion weir

The local government installed a fish ladder next to the **weir** to help them migrate upstream.

reconcile

- v. to find a way of dealing with two or more ideas, needs, etc. that are opposed to each other to agree and coexist synonym: harmonize, moderate, conciliate
- (1) **reconcile** these differences, (2) **reconcile** a dispute Sometimes it is challenging to **reconcile** science and religion.

confuse

v. to mistake one thing for another; to make somebody hard to understand

synonym: confound, obscure, disorient

(1) **confuse** the listener, (2) **confuse** fantasy with reality Her remarks **confused** the debate.

empower

- v. to give someone the power or authority to do something synonym: authorize, endow, entitle
- (1) **empower** my life, (2) **empower** the secretary to do the same

The company **empowered** employees to buy low-price items without approval to achieve efficient purchasing.

misconception

- n. a belief or an idea that is wrong because it has been based on faulty thinking, understanding, or hypothesis synonym: fallacy, incomprehension, misunderstanding

feminism

insecure
