synonym: peace, tranquility, serenity

The yoga instructor ended the class by leading a peaceful **shanti** meditation.

#### tinsel

 a shiny, metallic, or reflective decoration often used for festive purposes, such as adorning Christmas trees or enhancing party decorations

synonym: glitter, shimmer, sparkle

(1) tinsel decoration, (2) silver tinsel

We decorated the Christmas tree with colorful **tinsel** to create a festive atmosphere.

### **jealousy**

 a feeling of resentment or bitterness towards someone because they have something that you desire

synonym: envy, covetousness, resentment

(1) **jealousy** feeling towards another person, (2) burn with **jealousy** 

His **jealousy** of his brother's success caused a rift in their relationship.

#### louse

 a small, wingless insect that lives on the bodies of mammals and birds, often considered a parasite; a contemptible or despicable person

synonym: bug, insect, parasite

(1) pubic louse, (2) louse egg

The child was sent home from school because of a lice infestation caused by one **louse**.

# napkin

 a small piece of cloth or paper used for wiping one's mouth and hands while eating; a decorative cloth placed on a table for formal occasions

*synonym*: serviette, handkerchief, cloth

(1) paper napkin, (2) linen napkin

I always keep a stack of **napkins** on my desk while I eat to prevent any messes.

### trump

- a playing card with a picture of a trumpeter on it, used in certain card games
- (1) trump card, (2) choose trump

The **trump** suit in the game of bridge is determined at the beginning of each hand.

#### cellulose

 a complex carbohydrate that is the main structural component of plant cell walls and fibers; a substance used to make paper, textiles, and other materials

synonym: fiber, paper, wood pulp

(1) **cellulose** acetate, (2) **cellulose** insulation

The **cellulose** content in fruits and vegetables contributes to their dietary fiber.

#### boredom

 a state of weariness, restlessness, or impatience that arises from not being interested or engaged in an activity, task, or situation

synonym: ennui, tedium, monotony

(1) boredom relief, (2) chronic boredom

The long lecture on a topic I already knew left me struggling to fight off **boredom**.

# philanthropy

 the practice of voluntarily helping the poor, especially by giving money

synonym: altruism, benevolence, generosity

(1) **philanthropy** organization, (2) private **philanthropy** Tech billionaires often spend the majority of their time on **philanthropy**.

#### husk

n. the dry, outer covering of a seed, grain, or fruit, such as the shell of a nut or the skin of a corn kernel

synonym: shell, covering, outer layer

(1) husk removal, (2) seed husk

The **husk** of the coconut was removed to reveal the fruit inside.

#### transnational

adj. relating to or involving activities, organizations, or individuals that cross national boundaries or operate in multiple countries; having a presence or influence in multiple countries or regions

synonym: international, global, cross-border

offices and operations in multiple countries.

### dropout

synonym: noncompleter, quitter, school leaver

# puja

 a ritualistic act of worship commonly practiced in Hinduism, typically involving the offering of food, flowers, and prayers to a deity or divine entity
