#### bond

 a close emotional connection between two or more people; a certificate of debt that a government or corporation issues to raise money

*synonym*: bind, adhesion, attachment

#### astonishing

adj. surprising or shocking; difficult to believesynonym: surprising, shocking, astounding

(1) **astonishing** achievement, (2) make **astonishing** gains The news of her sudden death was **astonishing** to everyone who knew her.

### strength

 the quality or state of being physically, or sometimes mentally, strong

synonym: resilience, power, muscles

(1) **strength** of the economy, (2) muscular **strength** Health and **strength** are, above all, gold.

### huddle

v. to crowd or press closely together; cuddle

synonym: cluster, crowd, group

(1) **huddle** in a temporary shelter, (2) **huddle** around the open fire

The children huddled together for warmth in the cold winter

storm.

### jigsaw

n. a tool with a fine-toothed blade used for cutting intricate curves and patterns in thin material such as wood or metal, typically with the blade being reciprocating; a type of puzzle that consists of irregularly shaped pieces that must be fitted together to form a complete picture

synonym: fretsaw, puzzle

(1) jigsaw puzzle, (2) jigsaw woodworking

The **jigsaw** blade needs to be changed before we can continue the project.

### puzzle

 a situation that is difficult to follow or solve; a game, problem, or toy that tests a person's ingenuity or knowledge; (verb) to cause someone to feel confused because of something difficult to understand

synonym: plight, maze, (verb) perplex

(1) crossword **puzzle**, (2) mathematical **puzzle** 

This jigsaw **puzzle** is challenging because there are no pictures.

#### poet

n. a person who writes poetry

synonym: versifier, rhymer, writer

(1) a court **poet**, (2) a **poet** of sorts

She is a talented **poet** who has been recognized for her work.

### playwright

*n*. a person who writes plays

synonym: dramatist, scribe, librettist

(1) acclaimed **playwright**, (2) a **playwright** attached to the theatre

The **playwright's** work was praised by critics and audiences alike.

#### balanced

adj. taking all sides or opinions into account equally; being in a state of proper equilibrium

*synonym*: equitable, congruous, flat

(1) a **balanced** diet, (2) a well-**balanced** mind We conducted a **balanced** assessment of intellectual and cultural history.

#### communist

 adj. relating to or supporting the political ideology of communism (= a form of socialism that abolishes private ownership)

synonym: socialist, marxist, leninist

(1) **communist** party, (2) **communist** activist During the Cold War, many countries feared the spread of **communist** ideology.

#### confront

v. to face, meet or deal with a problem or difficult situation or person

*synonym*: engage, encounter, contend

(1) **confront** a global warming, (2) **confront** the issue He finally decided to **confront** problems directly.

#### mock

v. to make fun of someone, usually by imitating them in a witty but harsh way

synonym: gibe (or jibe), make fun of, laugh at

mock his accent, (2) mock at his misfortune
 is impolite to mock fun of an international student's English mistakes.

retreat

 n. the act of moving back or withdrawing from a position or situation; a period of rest or relaxation away from work or everyday life

*synonym*: escape, withdrawal, vacation

(1) **retreat** deeper into their territory, (2) **retreat** in a mountain region

Many people go on a **retreat** to recharge and reconnect with themselves.

#### silent

adj. without any or little sound synonym: quiet, hushed, mute

(1) **silent** reading, (2) give **silent** consent

The politician remained **silent** despite intense media scrutiny.

vain

adj. having an excessively high opinion of oneself; excessively concerned with one's appearance or achievements; producing no result or effect, or being unsuccessful

synonym: conceited, narcissistic, egotistic

(1) vain hope, (2) vain pursuit

He is in **vain** searching for a new job since he has no experience in the field.

crush

v. to press it firmly, usually with your hands or a tool, so that it becomes flat or smaller

synonym: destroy, demolish, pulverize

dawn

 the time of day when the sun's light starts to show in the sky

synonym: daybreak, sunrise, advent

arrange

- v. to plan, prepare for, and carry out something synonym: set up, order, organize
- (1) **arrange** the meeting, (2) the list was **arranged** alphabetically

I need to **arrange** plans with him for the celebration.

distill

- v. to purify or refine; to extract the essential elements synonym: extract, condense, purify
- (1) distill a liquid, (2) distill information

She decided to **distill** her thoughts into a more manageable list.

#### inconceivable

adj. hard to imagine or believe

synonym: unimaginable, impossible, unthinkable

(1) inconceivable pain, (2) inconceivable ideas

It would be inconceivable for him to alter his behavior.

#### saga

 a long, detailed story or account of heroic deeds, family history, or notable events, often consisting of a series of connected episodes

synonym: epic, tale, chronicle

(1) fantasy saga, (2) historical saga

The epic **saga** of the family's journey through time captivated readers worldwide.

### defy

v. to challenge or dare someone to do something; to resist or disobey a rule, decision, etc.

synonym: challenge, resist, disobey

(1) **defy** gravity, (2) **defy** authority

She tried to **defy** her parents by moving to the city against their wishes.

#### fiction

 n. the type of book or story, especially novels, that describes imaginary events and people; anything made up or imagined that is not true

synonym: fantasy, fable, invention

(1) stuff of science **fiction**, (2) non-**fiction** bestseller Truth is stranger than **fiction**.

### disguise

 to hide or alter someone's appearance to deceive or mislead others

synonym: mask, misinterpret, cloak

(1) **disguise** my feelings, (2) **disguise** his voice Later it turned out that the politician **disguised** the fact from the public.

#### vessel

n. a ship or large boat

*synonym*: boat, ship, craft

(1) blood vessels, (2) naval vessels

The **vessel** arrived in port the following day.

### pirate

n. (especially in the past) a person who attacks and robs ships at sea

*synonym*: buccaneer, corsair, privateer

(1) pirate treasure, (2) video pirate

The **pirate** captain ordered his crew to attack the merchant ship.

rap

 a type of music characterized by a strong, repetitive beat and lyrics that often focus on social and political issues; a reproach for some lapse or misdeed

*synonym*: hip-hop, emceeing, MCing

(1) rap music, (2) get a rap

The new **rap** album is getting a lot of attention.

### poison

n. a substance that can cause illness, injury, or death when ingested, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin; something harmful, malicious, or toxic; the act of damaging or ruining a relationship; (verb) to introduce a substance into something or someone harmful and potentially deadly

synonym: toxin, venom, pollutant

(1) **poison** ivy, (2) **poison** bilateral relations

The plant's leaves contain a deadly **poison** that can cause hallucinations and seizures.

capture

v. to catch a person or an animal and confine them in an area which they cannot escape

synonym: catch, arrest, imprison

steady

adj. firmly fixed, supported, or balanced; not shaking or moving

*synonym*: stable, solid, secure

(1) steady increase, (2) take a steady job

The patient's vital signs are **steady**, indicating a stable condition.

### engine

 a machine that converts thermal energy to mechanical work; something that has an important role used to achieve a purpose

*synonym*: motor, locomotive, driver

- (1) a steam **engine**, (2) an air-cooled **engine**The policies he announces can be the **engine** of economic growth in the country.
- v. to bend your knee or body, or lower your head; (noun) a weapon made of a curved piece of wood or other flexible material, strung with a cord and used to shoot arrows

synonym: bend, curve, arch

(1) **bow** and greet, (2) a **bow** wave

She **bowed** to the audience after her performance.

dip

v. to put something into a liquid for a short time and take it out again

synonym: dunk, dive, plunge

- (1) **dip** a pen in ink, (2) **dip** a chip in the sauce Please **dip** up a bucketful of water from the well.
- adj. enormous in size, number, amount, or quantity synonym: expansive, extended, boundless
- (1) vast majority, (2) vast desert

A **vast** audience viewed the broadcast.

horizon

 the line at which the earth's surface and the sky appear to meet; the range of interest or activity that can be anticipated

synonym: skyline, view, visible boundary

(1) the event **horizon** of a black hole, (2) business **horizon** As the sun set, the colors of the sky merged with the **horizon**, creating a beautiful orange and pink hue.

bow

vast

bluff

to try to deceive someone into believing that you can or are going to do something, or that you have knowledge or abilities; (noun) a high steep bank, usually formed by river erosion

synonym: abrupt, cliff, precipice

(1) **bluff** the other side, (2) riverside **bluff** 

He **bluffed** a person out of going.

bravado

a bold, swaggering display of courage or confidence that is intended to impress or intimidate people, often in a way that is exaggerated or insincere

synonym: boldness, swagger, arrogance

(1) lose my bravado, (2) heroic bravado

The show of **bravado** by the bully only served to mask his insecurity and fear.

rig

to prepare or set up something in a certain way, typically in a carefully planned or fraudulent manner; to equip with sails or masts

*synonym*: set up, prepare, arrange

(1) rig an election, (2) rig a ship with new sails

He **rigged** the game so he could win the prize.

collapse

to fall down or give way suddenly, often after breaking ν. apart

synonym: tumble, spill, bankruptcy

(1) the stock market **collapsed**, (2) ready to **collapse** The roof finally **collapsed** after three days and three nights of heavy snowfall.

aft

- adj. (the opposite of "forward") located at or towards the rear or back of a ship, aircraft, or other vehicle
- (1) aft cabin, (2) aft view

The **aft** section of the ship suffered significant damage after the collision with the reef.

### refugee

 a displaced person who has crossed national borders and who cannot or is unwilling to return home due to political, religious, or economic reasons or because of a war

synonym: emigrant, evacuee, exile

(1) global **refugee** crisis, (2) the **refugee** camp The community warmly welcomed the **refugees**.

#### settle

- v. to reach an agreement of disagreement synonym: inhabit, occupy, decide
- (1) **settle** a dispute, (2) **settle** down in the town I don't want to **settle** for second best.

#### suburb

 an outlying district or residential area of a city or town, typically comprising middle-class and affluent neighborhoods

synonym: outskirts, district, quarter

(1) **suburb** development, (2) **suburb** life
He grew up in the **suburbs** but always dreamed of living in the city.

### demographic

- a statistic characterizing that describes people or groups of people based on their age, sex, income, etc.
- (1) **demographic** analyses, (2) **demographic** policy Several **demographic** indicators correlate with care admission.

### **immigrant**

 a person who has come to a country where they were not born to live there permanently

synonym: settler, expatriate, emigrant

(1) **immigrant** communities, (2) an **immigrant** from the country

Police received a report of illegal immigrants in the area.

#### oblivious

adj. not aware of something, especially what is happening around you; forgetful

synonym: forgetful, clueless, unaware

(1) **oblivious** of his promise, (2) **oblivious** to our response She was so engrossed in her work that she was **oblivious** to her surroundings.

#### entitle

v. to give someone the right to have or do something; to give a title to someone or something

synonym: allow, permit, enable

(1) **entitle** him to a pension, (2) **entitle** the company to use the logo

The employee was **entitled** to a week of vacation time.

### snippet

- n. a small piece or brief extract of somethingsynonym: fragment, excerpt, brief
- (1) snippet of wisdom, (2) code snippet
  The journalist saved a snippet of the interview for later reference.

### halting

- adj. hesitant or wavering in speech or action; faltering;stopping or pausing repeatedly and intermittentlysynonym: stuttering, hesitant, faltering
- (1) halting speech, (2) halting progress

The negotiations between the two countries were proceeding in a **halting** manner.

### exchange

v. to give something and receive something else in return, often with the implication that the items being traded are of equal or comparable value; (noun) the act of giving or taking something in return for something else; a place or system where goods or services can be bought, sold, or traded

synonym: trade, swap, interchange

(1) **exchange** rate, (2) **exchange** a few friendly words My sister and I frequently **exchange** books, as we love reading.

assembly

 a group of people who have been elected, especially one that meets regularly and makes decisions or laws for a specific region or country synonym: crowd, gathering, mass

(1) assembly line, (2) assembly hall

This company's **assembly** plant is an enormous facility.

#### shift

- n. a slight transition in position, direction, or trendsynonym: transition, change, modification
- (1) Doppler **shift**, (2) major paradigm **shift** Could you help me **shift** some furniture?

### qualification

an official record of an exam showing that you have completed

synonym: credentials, capability, adequacy

(1) **qualifications** for the job, (2) possess distinctive **qualifications** 

Applicants must possess a verified teaching qualification.

#### allocate

- to give or distribute something, such as resources or duties, to someone or something for a particular purpose
   synonym: apportion, assign, distribute
- (1) **allocate** resource, (2) **allocate** budgets

  The company **allocated** a portion of its profits to developing new products.

#### tuition

 the act of teaching something, especially when given to a small group or one person; fees charged by education institutions for instruction or other services

synonym: fee, schooling, education

(1) tuition assistance, (2) a college tuition

His father cannot afford his tuition.

#### mathematics

 the science dealing with the logic of quantities, shapes, spaces, and arrangement

synonym: arithmetic, calculation, calculus

### regardless

adv. not paying attention or considering something or someone even if the situation is bad or there are difficulties

synonym: anyhow, nevertheless, still

#### secondhand

- adj. having been previously owned or used by someone else synonym: used, pre-owned, recycled
- (1) **secondhand** car, (2) **secondhand** information He was excited to find a vintage suit at the **secondhand** shop for a fraction of the price of a new one.

#### uniform

adj. always the same; showing a single form or character in all occurrences; (noun) the special set of clothes worn by members of a particular group as a means of identification

synonym: livery, outfit

at a uniform temperature, (2) our school uniform
 This country has a nationally uniform culture.

### ankle

- n. the part or joint connecting the foot to the legsynonym: mortise joint
- (1) **ankle** injury, (2) pair of **ankle** boots

  He accidentally sprained his **ankle** playing squash.

sear

 to char, scorch, or burn the surface of something with intense heat; (of pain or experience) to be deeply felt or remembered over a long time

synonym: scorch, cook, burn

(1) **sear** tissue using a hot iron, (2) **sear** the memory into your mind

Be careful not to **sear** the meat too long, as it can become tough and chewy.

#### chant

 a simple melody or tune, typically one that is repeated or sung in a monotonous way; (verb) recite with musical intonation

synonym: hymn, mantra, (verb) recite

(1) **chant** melodies, (2) **chant** in the chapel

The soccer game crowd broke into a **chant** of "Go, team, go!"

slit

n. a narrow cut or opening, often made by a sharp instrument or tool; (verb) to cut or make a long, narrow opening or incision in something, typically with a sharp instrument such as a knife or scissors

synonym: slash, incision, cut

(1) **slit** pocket, (2) **slit** the fabric

He made a small **slit** in the paper to fit it in the envelope.

#### occasional

adj. happening or appearing at irregular intervals; not constant or regular

synonym: infrequent, sporadic, irregular

She only visited her grandparents on **occasional** weekends.

### graffiti

writing or drawings scribbled, scratched, or sprayed illicitly on a wall or other surface in a public place

synonym: street art, tagging, vandalism

(1) graffiti art, (2) graffiti tag

The city spent a lot of money cleaning up the **graffiti** on the buildings downtown.

stiffen

v. to make or become stiff or rigid; to become inflexible or unyielding in one's attitude or behavior

synonym: harden, solidify, tense

(1) **stiffen** joints, (2) **stiffen** penalties

The cold weather made my muscles **stiffen** up.

#### resolve

- v. to find a suitable answer to the problems or difficulty synonym: decide, determine, fix
- (1) resolve a dispute, (2) resolve the computer error

### bypass

- an alternative road, channel, pipe, or connection that allows flow while the main one is closed or obstructed; (verb) to go past or round

adj. extremely tired

synonym: drowsy, depleted, fatigued

#### movement

n. a group of people working together to achieve a shared goal, especially a political, social, or artistic one; the process of moving or being moved, physically or figuratively

synonym: motion, progression, action

The **movement** of the dancers on stage was graceful and elegant.

#### suffer

v. to experience pain, distress, or hardship; to undergo or endure something painful or unpleasant

synonym: endure, undergo, tolerate

(1) suffer a setback, (2) suffer bad grades

The older man **suffers** from arthritis and finds it difficult to move around.

### nightmare

n. a very frightening or unpleasant dream

synonym: agony, misery, suffering

(1) have a **nightmare**, (2) **nightmare** situation Life as a waiter was a big **nightmare** for him.

#### transition

 the process or period of changing from one state or circumstance to another

synonym: change, growth, shift

(1) **transition** phase, (2) ensure a smooth **transition**The nation's healthcare system is in **transition** at the moment.

#### inflexible

adj. not able to be changed or adapted; rigid or unyielding synonym: rigid, unyielding, unadaptable

(1) **inflexible** rule, (2) take an **inflexible** stance His **inflexible** schedule did not allow for any changes.

### grant

- v. to agree to give or allow somebody synonym: allocate, authorize, give
- grant a new license, (2) grant a land
   The chairperson granted him the right to speak.

### sponsor

v. to provide funds for a particular event, program, individual, etc. as a way of advertising

synonym: back, fund, finance

(1) **sponsor** a contest, (2) **sponsor** a local group Our company **sponsors** numerous disabled athletes.

#### parallel

 adj. being everywhere equidistant and not intersecting; of or relating to the simultaneous performance of multiple operations

synonym: aligned, side-by-side, similar

(1) a **parallel** case, (2) **parallel** processing He walked a road **parallel** to the railroad.

#### classic

adj. judged or deserving to be regarded as one of the best or most important of its kind over a period of time; of a well-known type

synonym: definitive, traditional, typical

(1) a **classic** experiment, (2) Chinese **classic** literature He displayed the **classic** symptoms of depression.

#### relentless

adj. persistent and determined; continuing despite difficulties or setbacks

*synonym*: unyielding, tireless, unremitting

(1) **relentless** attack, (2) face **relentless** pressure The athlete's **relentless** training paid off in the end.

#### enmesh

v. to entangle or involve someone or something in a complicated or difficult situation; to catch or trap as if in a net or mesh; to become entangled or caught up in something

synonym: entangle, trap, ensnare

(1) **enmesh** the fly in its web, (2) become **enmeshed** in legal battles

Her family drama enmeshed her in a web of lies and deceit.

### precarious

adj. not securely held or in position; dangerously unstable or uncertain; dependent on chance or uncertain conditionssynonym: precariousness, instability, uncertainty

(1) **precarious** job, (2) **precarious** financial situation She had a **precarious** hold on the ladder and was afraid to move.

#### tragic

adj. causing great sadness or suffering; very unfortunatesynonym: calamitous, disastrous, catastrophic

tragic love stories, (2) tragic death
 tragic events of the war left many families torn apart.

scar

 a mark that remains on the skin after a wound has healed

synonym: blemish, imperfection, blotch

(1) burn scar, (2) carry a scar

Even after the wound has healed, a **scar** remains.

#### violent

adj. involving or caused by physical force or aggression against someone or something

synonym: aggressive, intense, turbulent

(1) victim of a **violent** crime, (2) **violent** incident
The protesters became **violent** when the police tried to disperse them.

#### abuse

- the use of something in an incorrect or harmful manner synonym: misuse, misconduct, vilification
- (1) the problem of drug abuse, (2) victim of sexual abuse Our company has an audit team that monitors directors for abuse of authority.

#### isolation

- the condition of being alone or lonely; the act or state of separation between persons or groups
- synonym: aloneness, seclusion, separateness
- (1) isolation booth, (2) the country's isolation That incident led to his **isolation**.

### catapult

- a device used to hurl an object a long distance synonym: launcher, trebuchet, slingshot
- (1) powerful catapult, (2) catapult mechanism The army used a catapult to launch large rocks over the castle walls.

#### tan

- to become brown as a result of exposure to the sun synonym: brown, sunburn
- (1) tan after sun exposure, (2) tan poorly She spent the whole summer tanning on the beach.

#### anonymous

- adj. having no known name, identity, or known source synonym: nameless, unidentified, unnamed
- (1) anonymous letter, (2) anonymous house She received several **anonymous** calls.

#### resident

- a person who lives in a particular place or has their n. home in a place
- synonym: dweller, inhabitant, inhabitant
- (1) a **resident** of the city, (2) **resident** tax Visa renewal for **resident** foreigners in this country is once every five years.

#### invite

v. to ask someone to come or join; to offer an opportunity or possibility for something to happen or take place

synonym: ask, request, summon

(1) invite guests, (2) invite criticism

We want to **invite** you to our annual charity event.

#### venue

 a location or place where an event or activity takes place; a place where something happens or is performed

synonym: location, site, arena

(1) venue capacity, (2) wedding venue

### protocol

 a set of rules or procedures for transmitting data or conducting a process or activity, especially in computer networks or scientific experiments; the initial or original version of an agreement

synonym: procedure, system, method

The company has a strict **protocol** for handling sensitive information to ensure security.

### cutlery

 a collective term for utensils used for eating and serving food, typically made of metal, such as knives, forks, and spoons

synonym: silverware, utensils, flatware

The restaurant set the table with gleaming **cutlery** for the fine dining experience.

#### routine

 a usual or habitual way of doing things; a set sequence of steps, part of a larger computer program

#### comfort

 a state of physical ease and freedom from pain or constraint

### unsung

 adj. not praised or famous but deserving to be recognized for one's accomplishments or contributions; not publicized or acclaimed

### asleep

adj. in a state of sleep

### margin

#### disenfranchise
