#### recession

 a period of economic decline, typically lasting for six months or more, during which trade and industrial activity decrease, and unemployment increases

#### resume

### hardware

#### software

#### crater

 a huge bowl-shaped cavity in the earth or an object in space, usually created by an explosion or the impact of a meteorite

### bounce

# employee

# optimistic

# unpredictable

# jeopardy

# supercomputer

#### handle

## stop-and-go

adj. characterized by frequent starts and stops, interruptions, or pauses; describing a driving style in which a vehicle repeatedly stops and starts, often due to traffic or road conditions

traffic

### supreme

#### pose
