jihad

n. a concept in Islam referring to a struggle or effort, often internal, to uphold or defend the faith, which can be interpreted in different ways, including as a spiritual or political struggle

faith

n. complete trust in something or someone's ability or knowledge; a strong belief in religion, divine power, etc.

synonym: belief, trust, confidence

vice

sin

 wrongdoing or wicked behavior; (in the form of vice versa) with the order reversed; (as a prefix) someone with a job immediately below a particular person

synonym: corruption, depravity, evil

- (1) virtue and **vice**, (2) **vice-chair** of the committee Cats hate dogs and **vice** versa.
- n. the offense against a religious or moral law or against God

synonym: misdeed, quilt, wrong

(1) forgive a **sin**, (2) **sin** of omission

temptation

n. the desire to do or have something that you know you should not do or have; the act of influencing by exciting hope or desire

lust

grace

n. a quality of being pleasing, especially in appearance or manner; a temporary exemption, especially an extended period granted as a special favor; a short prayer of thanks before a meal

synonym: charm, poise, elegance

(1) say a **grace**, (2) end of the **grace** period

The old oak tree stood with **grace** and majesty in the park's center.

Christ

 the man that Christians believe is the prophet and the son of God, and whose life and sermons form the basis for Christianity

synonym: Savior, Jesus Christ, Jesus

(1) teaching of **Christ**, (2) before **Christ**

Christmas is the day to celebrate the birth of Christ.

mystical

adj. relating to or characterized by spiritual powers; beyond ordinary understanding

synonym: occult, esoteric, enigmatic

(1) mystical intuition, (2) mystical belief

While meditating, he had a **mystical** experience and felt a sense of unity with the universe.

resonance

 a deep, full, or reverberating sound or tone; a quality or feeling of a particular emotional or mental vibration or significance; a mutual or sympathetic connection or correspondence between two things

Sanskrit

spiritual

flock

- n. a gathering of sheep, goats, or birdssynonym: herd, crowd, assembly

occupation

n. a person's job or profession; the act of taking possession

synonym: job, profession, vocation

- *adj.* renowned for possessing admirable attributes *synonym*: acclaimed, notable, prominent

holy

adj. of or related to a god, divine power, or a particular religion

synonym: sacred, religious, divine

warrior

n. a person who engaged in or experienced warfare, especially in the past

synonym: fighter, soldier, combatant

(1) armored warrior, (2) warrior spirit

ungodly

adj. not conforming to religious or moral principles; sinful or wicked; outrageous or excessive

synonym: sinful, wicked, unholy

communist

 adj. relating to or supporting the political ideology of communism (= a form of socialism that abolishes private ownership)

encourage

conception

n. a person who is committed to a cause or campaign that they see as being beneficial or righteous; historically, a person who took part in the medieval military campaigns to retake the Holy Land from the Muslims

pursue

stick

v. to put something, usually a sharp object, into something; to restrict yourself to doing or using one certain thing and not change; (noun) a thin piece of wood or other material

You **stick** a bill in the change machine, and the coins pop out.

pause

v. to take a short break from talking or doing something before continuing

insane

 adj. relating to or suffering from a serious, and often undiagnosed, mental disorder with extreme or violent social behavior

imam

n. a religious leader of the Muslim community, especially the leader of a mosque and a community

a Muslim place of worship that usually has a minaret (= slender tower with balconies)

reclaim

v. to take back something previously lost, given, or paid, or ask to have it back

synonym: recoup, regain, retake

congregate

- v. to come together or gather in a group or assembly; to collect or accumulate in a particular place or area
 synonym: assemble, converge, gather

tower

- a structure that is exceptionally high in proportion to its width and either forms part of a building or stands alone
 synonym: building, belfry, edifice
- (1) a bell **tower**, (2) the **tower** on a cliff She is a **tower** of strength for our team in trouble.

claim

v. to assert that something is true; to demand or request something as one's own; to lay legal or moral right to something; (noun) a demand or assertion of a right or something that one believes to be true

synonym: assert, declare, maintain

(1) claim responsibility, (2) false claim

He wants to claim ownership of the abandoned property.

victory

 success in a game, competition, election, or battle, or the knowledge that you have won

synonym: win, triumph, success

deaf

adj. lacking the ability to hear, or having impaired hearing; unresponsive or unaware of certain sounds or signals

synonym: hearing-impaired, unresponsive, insensitive

statistics

- *n.* the discipline that concerns the collection, organization, analysis, interpretation, and presentation of data

extremism

n. the holding of extreme political or religious views; actions or beliefs that fall outside of what is considered acceptable or reasonable

synonym: fanaticism, radicalism, zealotry

The rise of far-right **extremism** has sparked concern among many civil rights organizations.

suddenly

adv. quickly and unexpectedly

synonym: abruptly, unexpectedly, unawares

cross-hair

institute

 an organization that has a specific purpose, particularly one dealing with science, education, or a particular profession; (verb) to initiate, introduce, or establish something

synonym: academy, university, college

(1) institute a lawsuit, (2) research institutesThis region has many institutes offering higher education.

appropriate

adj. suitable or proper in the circumstances; fitting *synonym*: fitting, suitable, proper

(1) **appropriate** behavior, (2) an **appropriate** time It would be **appropriate** to dress nicely for the wedding.

kidnapping

 the act of taking somebody away illegally and holding them captive

synonym: abduction, snatch, kidnap

kidnapping attempt, (2) mass kidnapping
 She received a year's imprisonment for aggravated kidnapping.

debase

 to reduce the quality, value, or esteem of something, often by lowering its moral or ethical standard; to demean or degrade

synonym: degrade, lower, cheapen

(1) **debase** dignity, (2) **debase** the principles of justice The company's decision to **debase** its currency led to inflation and economic instability.

corrupt

adj. characterized by dishonest behavior or actions, often involving bribery, fraud, or the abuse of power for personal gain; morally or ethically flawed or polluted; (verb) to make someone or something morally depraved or causing it to become dishonest

synonym: dishonest, unethical, immoral

(1) **corrupt** good manners, (2) **corrupt** discipline

The **corrupt** politician was finally exposed and faced criminal charges.

persuade

v. to convince or induce someone to do something by presenting a reason or argument; to sway or influence someone's decision or opinion

define

v. to state or explain precisely the nature, scope, or meaning of something

poll

 an inquiry into public opinion conducted by interviewing a random sample of people; the process of voting at an election

synonym: survey, ballot, voting

dwindle

v. to gradually decrease in size, amount, or strength; to become smaller

synonym: shrink, decrease, fade

wealth

n. a large amount of money, property, or other things that someone or an organization owns

doe

n. a mature female of mammals of which the male is called a buck, such as a deer or a rabbit

synonym: rabbit, bunny, hare

Hunters use a whistle that makes the **doe** sound to lure stags.

champagne

 a type of sparkling wine produced in the Champagne region of France, or any similar wine produced elsewhere

synonym: sparkling wine, prosecco, cava

(1) **champagne** toast, (2) **champagne** celebration They opened a bottle of **champagne** to celebrate their success.

disengage

v. to withdraw or separate oneself from a situation or relationship

synonym: withdraw, separate, detach

(1) **disengage** the clutch, (2) **disengage** socially He **disengaged** from the conversation and walked away.

survive

- v. to live or exist despite a dangerous event or period synonym: endure, persist, stay
- (1) **survive** a blizzard, (2) **survive** a plane crash These birds can only **survive** in temperate climates.

violent

adj. involving or caused by physical force or aggression against someone or something

synonym: aggressive, intense, turbulent

(1) victim of a **violent** crime, (2) **violent** incident The protesters became **violent** when the police tried to disperse them.

inherit

v. to receive money, property, or a title from someone after they have died

synonym: obtain, gain, acquire

(1) **inherit** estate, (2) **inherit** ancestral property After his death, his sons **inherited** his business.

rhetoric

 speech or writing intended to please or persuade someone; the art or study of using language effectively and persuasively in spoken or written form

synonym: oratory, eloquence, persuasion

(1) the **rhetoric** of a debate, (2) high-flown **rhetoric** He was known for his powerful **rhetoric** and ability to persuade people with his words.

brand

n. a type of product, service, etc., made by a particular company and sold under a specific name; identification mark on the skin of livestock, criminals, etc., made by burning

synonym: trademark, label, symbol

(1) create a **brand** logo, (2) the **brand** of the new car There's a new **brand** of hero in the movies now.

peninsula

 a long piece of land that is almost surrounded by water but is linked to a larger part of the land

synonym: cape, foreland

(1) the tip of the **peninsula**, (2) the Arab **peninsula**That **peninsula** was an essential base for the country's defense.

haram

 adj. (opposite of "halal") a term in Islam that refers to something forbidden or prohibited based on religious or moral grounds

synonym: forbidden, prohibited

homage

 a show of respect or honor, often by performing an act of reverence or by paying tribute

ethnicity

 the cultural characteristics of a particular group, such as language, religion, and traditions, that distinguish them from other groups

sectarian

relax

 to become or cause someone to become less active or tense and calmer

synonym: soften, comfort, soothe

franchise

n. a legal agreement between two parties in which one party grants the other the right to use or sell its products or services under a specific brand name and business model; a business that operates under such an agreement; the right to vote in an election

synonym: dealership, enterprise, suffrage

(1) **franchise** agreement, (2) **franchise** owner The fast-food **franchise** kept expanding and opening new restaurants across the country.

aspire

v. to have an ambition or a desire to achieve something, typically something high or great

synonym: aim, desire, strive

underwear

 n. (also "undies") clothes worn next to the skin under outer clothes

synonym: undergarments, lingerie, innerwear

bomb

 a weapon that explodes and is used to kill or injure people or to cause damage to something

synonym: missile, explosive, ammunition

instigate

v. to initiate, start or incite something, often to cause trouble, conflict, or violence; to urge or stir someone to take a particular action or behavior

distracted

adj. having one's attention diverted or divided; being unable to concentrate because of being preoccupied or worriedsynonym: preoccupied, inattentive, absent-minded

military

adj. not different, exceptional, or unexpected in any way, especially in quality, ability, size, or degree

defeat

- to win against somebody in a fight, war, or attempt *synonym*: conquer, beat, overpower

- a group of employees who have banded together to advocate for their rights and better their working conditions; the act or the state of joining together or being joined together

celebrate

- to intentionally not listen or pay attention to synonym: neglect, disregard, shun
