represent

v. to speak, act, or be present on behalf of another person or group; to form or constitute

proposal

- n. a formal suggestion or offer, sometimes a written onesynonym: offer, suggestion, proposition
- an innovative proposal,

graduated

- adj. having received a degree from a school, college, or university; marked with or divided into levels or degreessynonym: completed, finished, earned
- graduated taxation, (2) graduated flask
 She was a graduated student of a prestigious university.

hostel

 a type of inexpensive lodging or accommodation, often offering shared rooms and facilities and frequently used by travelers, backpackers, or students

synonym: inn, lodge, boarding house

castle

 a large building, typically of the medieval period, fortified against attack with thick walls, battlements, towers, and often a moat
