## hypocrite

n. a person who claims to have certain beliefs or values but acts in a way that contradicts those beliefs or values; a person who pretends to be virtuous or moral but behaves in an unethical or deceitful way

synonym: pretender, two-faced, insincere

(1) environmental **hypocrite**, (2) religious **hypocrite**She accused her boss of being a **hypocrite** for advocating for workers' rights while mistreating his employees.

#### courageous

adj. able to face and deal with danger or fear without flinching

synonym: brave, valiant, fearless

(1) make a **courageous** decision, (2) **courageous** rescue attempt

He was a **courageous** soldier who had served his country with honor.

#### crusade

 a series of wars fought by Christians in the middle ages to recover the holy land from the Muslims; a series of actions advancing a principle or tending toward a particular end

synonym: holy war, religious war, expedition

(1) a **crusade** against smoking, (2) environmental **crusade** During the **Crusade** period, many European Christians went on a pilgrimage to the Holy Land.

#### empower

- v. to give someone the power or authority to do something synonym: authorize, endow, entitle
- (1) **empower** my life, (2) **empower** the secretary to do the same

The company **empowered** employees to buy low-price items

without approval to achieve efficient purchasing.

#### muse

 a source of inspiration, particularly for creative endeavors such as writing or art; a mythical spirit thought to inspire poets and artists

synonym: source of inspiration, minstrel, versifier

She gazed out the window, deep in thought, as if waiting for her **muse** to strike.

## philanthropy

the practice of voluntarily helping the poor, especially by giving money

synonym: altruism, benevolence, generosity

#### creditor

- n. a person, company, etc. to whom a debtor owes money

#### premed

#### rigor

#### excite
