The banking industry feared the economy would **implode** due to risky investments.

#### pavilion

 a large, often ornate tent or booth, often used for entertainment or public events; a building or structure, often in a park or other public space, used for meetings, exhibitions, or social gatherings

synonym: gazebo, kiosk, pagoda

(1) garden pavilion, (2) beach pavilion

The outdoor wedding reception was held in a beautiful **pavilion** overlooking the lake.

#### outflow

 the leakage of fluid from a container; a natural flow of groundwater

synonym: discharge, outpouring, gush

(1) **outflow** fluid, (2) **outflow** of capital

After the valves were closed, the **outflow** halted.

### grieve

 to feel or show great sadness or sorrow, especially for someone who has died

synonym: mourn, lament, sorrow

(1) **grieve** for loss, (2) **grieve** at the sad news She **grieved** the loss of her parents.

# gridlock

 a situation in which traffic or progress is obstructed due to congestion, blockage, or a lack of movement; a deadlock or impasse in negotiations or decision-making

synonym: traffic jam, standstill, impasse

(1) gridlock situation, (2) political gridlock

The rush hour traffic in the city often leads to **gridlock** on the highways.

#### cockroach

 a flat, brown or black, chiefly nocturnal insects sometimes found in the home

synonym: roach

cockroach killer, (2) have a cockroach phobia
Cockroaches sometimes cause allergic reactions in humans.

#### louse

 a small, wingless insect that lives on the bodies of mammals and birds, often considered a parasite; a contemptible or despicable person

synonym: bug, insect, parasite

(1) pubic louse, (2) louse egg

The child was sent home from school because of a lice infestation caused by one **louse**.

#### trump

- a playing card with a picture of a trumpeter on it, used in certain card games
- (1) trump card, (2) choose trump

The **trump** suit in the game of bridge is determined at the beginning of each hand.

### methamphetamine

n. (commonly known as "meth" or "crystal meth") a
powerful and highly addictive stimulant drug that affects
the central nervous system

synonym: meth, crystal

(1) **methamphetamine** addiction, (2) fatal **methamphetamine** overdose

The use of **methamphetamine** has been linked to several mental health disorders.

# gonorrhea

- a sexually transmitted infection caused by the bacterium Neisseria gonorrhoeae, characterized by inflammation of the mucous membranes of the reproductive organs, urinary tract, or rectum
- (1) **gonorrhea** infection, (2) **gonorrhea** outbreak Untreated **gonorrhea** can lead to serious complications like infertility and pelvic inflammatory disease.

# bipartisan

adj. involving or supported by both of the main political parties in a country

synonym: neutral, impartial, nonpartisan

- *adj.* hardworking, diligent, and persistent in effort *synonym*: diligent, hardworking, assiduous

## geothermal

adj. relating to or produced by the internal heat of the earth; often used to refer to energy produced by tapping into the natural heat of the earth

synonym: underground, thermal, subterranean

geothermal activity, (2) geothermal drilling
The town is exploring using geothermal energy to power its

homes and buildings.

#### biofuel

 a fuel produced from organic matter, such as crops or waste material, that can be used to replace or supplement traditional fossil fuels

synonym: renewable energy, green fuel, alternative fuel

(1) **biofuel** production, (2) **biofuel** technology

The airplane was powered by a **biofuel** made from plant-based materials.

#### seaboard

the coastal areas or region adjacent to the sea or ocean;
a coastline or shore

synonym: coastline, shoreline, seaside

(1) eastern seaboard, (2) coastal seaboard

The seafood cuisine in the **seaboard** region is renowned for its freshness and variety.

#### gutsy

adj. displaying courage, determination, or boldness;
characterized by a willingness to take risks or face challenges

synonym: courageous, brave, daring

(1) gutsy move, (2) gutsy performance

It was **gutsy** to quit her job and start her own business.

#### lithium

 a soft, silvery-white metal that is highly reactive and used in batteries, alloy production, and medications for bipolar disorder

synonym: lithy, Li, salt

(1) lithium carbonate, (2) lithium mining

**Lithium-ion** batteries are commonly used in laptops, smartphones, and electric vehicles.

# impatience

 a feeling of restlessness or irritation caused by a desire for something to happen or be done more quickly; lack of patience

synonym: impatience, restlessness, agitation

(1) impatience with delays, (2) business impatience

The doctor advised him to manage his **impatience** as stress could exacerbate his medical condition.

# renegade

 a person who deserts and betrays an organization, country, religious group, or set of principles

synonym: traitor, deserter, insurgent
