### proposal

### economy

### empirical

elect

v. to choose someone for a specific position by voting for them; to decide or choose to do something

#### government

 the group of people with authority to control a country or state

*synonym*: administration, regime, state

#### communal

adj. belonging to or used by a group rather than individuals; for common use

synonym: collaborative, combined, collective

### employer

a person or organization that pays workers to work for them

*synonym*: boss, owner, company

### refrigerator

 an appliance or device used for preserving and cooling food and beverages by maintaining a low temperature within a closed compartment

#### cabinet

#### concession

something that is granted or given up, often in a n. negotiation or argument; a place or stand where goods or services are sold or provided, often in a public setting such as a stadium or amusement park

### president

### agriculture

 a fuel produced from organic matter, such as crops or waste material, that can be used to replace or supplement traditional fossil fuels

### efficiency

ion
