synonym: lobby, hall, chamber

ventricle

 a chamber or cavity within an organ or structure, particularly the lower chamber of the heart that pumps blood to the lungs and other parts of the body

synonym: chamber, pumping heart muscle

The heart's **ventricles** are responsible for pumping blood out to the body.

dissect

v. to cut into pieces to study the structure of something in detail

synonym: analyze, examine, study

(1) dissect the data, (2) dissect a personality

skeletal

adj. of, relating to, or forming a skeleton (= frame of bones);very thin or emaciated

synonym: bony, emaciated, gaunt

(1) skeletal system, (2) skeletal muscles
