#### abuse

#### context

 the circumstances, facts, or conditions that surround a particular event, situation, or statement and that give it meaning

#### financier

 a person or organization that deals with or manages large sums of money, particularly for investment or financial trading purposes

synonym: banker, investor, capitalist

(1) financier scandals, (2) powerful financier

The wealthy **financier** made a generous donation to the charity.

### courage

 the ability to face danger, difficulty, uncertainty, or pain without being overcome by fear or despair; the quality of being brave or courageous

synonym: bravery, valor, fearlessness

synonym: fable, legend, lore

(1) mental courage, (2) inspire courage

It takes a lot of **courage** to stand up for what you believe is right.

### myth

- an ancient story or set of stories accepted as history, especially explaining the worldview of a people
- (1) the **myth** of an old religion, (2) perpetuate a **myth** With the financial bubble bursting, the **myth** of economic growth in investment banking collapsed.

#### discuss

 to talk about or examine in detail through conversation or debate; to exchange ideas, opinions, or information on a particular topic

synonym: talk about, converse, debate

We need to **discuss** the next steps for the project during our meeting tomorrow.

#### commissioner

 an official member of a government department or another organization who is responsible for controlling something or performing specific duties synonym: administrator, agent, official

(1) elect police **commissioners**, (2) **commissioner** of patent office

He became an audit **commissioner** because of his years of experience as an accountant.

#### minister

nation

a person appointed to or a job of a head of a government department

*synonym*: bishop, official, ambassador

- (1) **Minister** for Education, (2) deputy prime **minister** The **minister** occasionally preaches at this church.
- a large organized community of people living in a particular country or region and having a particular culture

synonym: country, state, sovereign entity

(1) nation-state, (2) a seafaring nation

The **nation** of Japan is known for its unique culture and advanced technology.

### security

n. the state of being free from danger, risk, or harm; measures taken to protect against threats or attacks; a financial asset, such as a stock or bond that derives value exclusively from the ownership interest or claim to a particular underlying asset or obligation

synonym: safety, protection, stock

(1) national security, (2) security analyst

The building's **security** system includes cameras, alarms, and security guards.

### economy

n. the system by which a country or region produces manages, and distributes goods and services, including the money and finances involved in these activities; (of an airline) the lowest-priced, most basic option for seating in commercial travel

synonym: finance, trade, business

(1) **economy** of scale, (2) **economy** class

The **economy** of the country is struggling due to the recent political instability.

involve

 to include or affect someone or something as a necessary part of something else

synonym: implicate, include, engage

(1) **involve** a lot of paperwork, (2) **involve** a high degree of risk

The investigation **involves** several government agencies and is expected to take several months.

loot

v. steal goods from a place or person, typically during a war or riot; (noun) steal goods from a place or person, typically using force, especially in times of war or civil disorder

synonym: plunder, pillage, rob

(1) **loot** the ship, (2) war **loot** 

The bandits looted the small town, leaving it in ruins.

taxpayer

- n. a person who pays taxes to the governmentsynonym: contributor, payer, financier

sector

 a distinct part or division of something often used to refer to a segment of an economy or industry; an area or field of work or activity

massive

adj. enormous amount; very heavy and solid synonym: enormous, giant, immense

### government

*n.* the group of people with authority to control a country or state

synonym: administration, regime, state

(1) **government** bureaucracy, (2) **government** funding The federal **government** is planning to increase taxes for the next fiscal year.

#### bribe

v. to try to make someone do something to gain one's favors or influence by giving a gift of money or other inducements

*synonym*: graft, corrupt

#### backhand

- n. (in sports such as tennis and squash) a stroke or shot made with the back of the hand facing forward is used to hit the ball on the non-dominant side of the body

### participate

#### dismantle

v. to take apart or demolish (a structure, machine, system, or the like); to strip off fittings or equipment

#### ridicule

n. speech or behavior that makes fun of or mocks someone or something; teasing, sarcasm, or scornful remarks that are intended to belittle or humiliate; (verb) to mock, criticize, or make fun of someone or something in a scornful or derisive way

synonym: derision, mockery, satire

(1) public **ridicule**, (2) **ridicule** at his expense The **ridicule** from his classmates made him feel embarrassed and ashamed.

#### demonstrate

v. to display something or give an exhibition to an interested audience

mischief

 playful, minor actions or behavior intended to cause harm, trouble, or annoyance; mischievous behavior that is not intended to cause harm or damage

#### wealth

 a large amount of money, property, or other things that someone or an organization owns

synonym: affluence, assets, fortunate

### petrol

 a flammable liquid made from petroleum that is used as a fuel in internal combustion engines, commonly known as gasoline in North America

synonym: gasoline, fuel, gas

I must fill my car with **petrol** before going on a long road trip.

#### treasury

n. the government department in charge of managing public funds; the funds of a government or institution or individual

synonym: coffer, exchequer, bank

The protracted war nearly depleted the country's treasury.

### ironic

adj. using words to express something different from and often opposite to their literal or usual meaning, often for humorous or rhetorical effect

synonym: sarcastic, wry, sardonic

It was **ironic** that the heavy rain started just as they set up for an outdoor picnic.

### irony

 the expression of one's meaning by using language that usually signifies the opposite, typically for humorous or rhetorical effect

synonym: sarcasm, cynicism, wit

The **irony** of the situation is that he won the lottery on the day he lost his job.

### responsible

adj. answerable or accountable for something within one's power, control, or management

synonym: accountable, answerable, liable

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(1) **responsible** action, (2) **responsible** for a customer service

She's a **responsible** pet owner who ensures her dog gets enough exercise and a healthy diet.

### irresponsible

*adj.* not showing a proper sense of responsibility; not reliable *synonym*: careless, reckless, thoughtless

(1) **irresponsible** actions, (2) **irresponsible** behavior It was **irresponsible** of him to drive home after drinking so much alcohol.

#### terrace

 n. commonly paved outdoor space next to a house; a row of homes that were all constructed in the same design and shared dividing walls

synonym: sundeck, balcony, patio

(1) private **terrace**, (2) rooftop **terrace**Heavy rain soaked a significant part of the **terrace**.

#### tower

- a structure that is exceptionally high in proportion to its width and either forms part of a building or stands alone
   synonym: building, belfry, edifice
- a bell tower,
   the tower on a cliff
   a tower of strength for our team in trouble.

### ministry

*n.* a department of government responsible for a particular area of public service

synonym: department, agency, bureau

(1) ministry officials, (2) enter the ministry

The **ministry** of education is responsible for managing the schools in the country.

#### finance

n. the management of money, credit, banking, and investments, especially by a government or commercial organization; the branch of economics that studies the management of money and other assets

synonym: banking, investment, fund

(1) finance act, (2) manage my finances

Our company decided to hire an advisor who specializes in **finance**.

### temple

 a place of worship, especially one that is associated with a particular religion or faith; the flat area on either side of

#### the forehead

synonym: shrine, mosque, synagogue

(1) temple complex, (2) a tour guide at the templeHe visited the temple to pray and make offerings to the gods.

#### embark

- v. to go on board a ship or plane; to set out on an enterprise or subject of study; to start something
- synonym: enter, undertake, commence
- (1) **embark** on a trip, (2) **embark** on a foolish adventure We **embarked** on a new project.

### arrangement

- a plan or preparation for the future event; the action or process of placing things in a particular order
- synonym: placement, configuration, account
- (1) **arrangement** of the furniture, (2) **arrangement** committee

As a first **arrangement**, we agreed to meet the following Friday.

### develop

v. to grow or expand; to improve or refine through a process of progress and refinement, often to achieve greater sophistication or complexity; to elaborate or add detail to something that is in the process of being created

synonym: evolve, progress, advance

(1) develop a strategy, (2) develop a skill

We must **develop** a new system to streamline our workflow and increase efficiency.

#### construct

v. to build or create something; to assemble or combine different parts to form something whole

synonym: build, assemble, create

(1) construct a 3D image, (2) construct a dam

He **constructs** hypotheses that no mathematician has ever imagined before.

#### statistics

- n. the discipline that concerns the collection, organization, analysis, interpretation, and presentation of data
- (1) statistics for cancer, (2) official statistics

The **statistics** demonstrate that poverty and unemployment are genuine problems.

### complexity

 the state or quality of being complicated or intricate and difficult to understand

*synonym*: intricacy, sophistication, elaboration

(1) cognitive **complexity**, (2) **complexity** theory

The project's **complexity** made it difficult for the team to complete it on time.

#### twin

- either of two children born at the same time from the same mother
- (1) a **twin-lens** camera, (2) a **twin** room Its **twin** brothers are difficult to tell apart except for their parents.

#### commission

 a formal instruction, command, or request given to a person or group; an official group of people entrusted by a government or other official body to control or enforce something

synonym: task, duty, authority

(1) **commission** appointed by the government, (2) the **commission** of murder

She gets a **commission** on each contract.

### inquiry

 n. the act or process of asking a question or asking for information; an official process of investigating a matter of public interest

*synonym*: question, research, exploration

(1) **inquiry** about the product, (2) launch an **inquiry**Our tech support responds to the first **inquiry** exceptionally promptly.

### appoint

 to give someone a job or role, especially as a public official or member of an organization; to arrange or decide on a time or a place

synonym: designate, assign, name

(1) appoint members, (2) appoint the day

The court **appointed** a guardian for the child.

### immediately

adv. now or without delay

*synonym*: directly, instantly, promptly

(1) **immediately** recall a product, (2) write him an answer **immediately** 

A suspension order from the court is effective **immediately**.

### prime

adj. main or most important; basic; (prime number, noun) a natural number greater than 1 that cannot be formed by multiplying two smaller natural numbers (e.g., 2, 3, 5, 7, 11 and 13)

synonym: excellent, exceptional, premium

(1) **prime** number, (2) deputy **prime** minister

After a thorough investigation, she has been named as the **prime** suspect.

### parliament

 a legislative body, especially the one that represents the people of a country or state

synonym: congress, assembly, legislature

(1) disband **parliament**, (2) event of a hung **parliament**. He was a member of **parliament**.

#### embarrass

- v. to cause someone to feel awkward, worried, or ashamed synonym: disconcert, unsettle, agitate
- (1) **embarrass** political enemy, (2) **embarrass** my project He looked for an opportunity to **embarrass** that actor in public.

#### suffer

v. to experience pain, distress, or hardship; to undergo or endure something painful or unpleasant

synonym: endure, undergo, tolerate

(1) **suffer** a setback, (2) **suffer** bad grades
The older man **suffers** from arthritis and finds it difficult to move around.

#### constitutional

adj. of or relating to a constitution (= the set of fundamental principles), especially of a country or government;
 existing as an essential characteristic

synonym: fundamental, basic, inherent

- (1) **constitutional** ban, (2) a **constitutional** disease The right to free speech is a **constitutional** right in the United States.
- a group of people who follow a particular religious or philosophical belief system, especially one that is regarded as outside the norm or mainstream

synonym: group, faction, cult

(1) sect beliefs, (2) secret sect

The minority **sect** believed in a set of unconventional religious practices.

#### fiasco

sect

- n. a complete failure or debacle, often resulting from poor planning, execution, or unforeseen circumstancessynonym: debacle, failure, disaster

### suspicious

- adj. making you feel that someone has done something wrong, illegal, or dishonest without any evidencesynonym: fishy, questionable, doubtful
- (1) report **suspicious** activity, (2) a person who is **suspicious**

We carefully examine each **suspicious** transaction report we receive.

#### suspect

v. to consider anything to be actual or probablesynonym: assume, distrust, surmise

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(1) **suspect** a plot, (2) **suspect** that he is sick The cops **suspected** him of being the killer.

accuse

v. to charge or criticize someone with a crime or wrongdoing

synonym: charge, blame, criticize

(1) **accuse** his rudeness, (2) **accuse** each other The witness **accused** the defendant of committing the robbery.

lexicon

- all the words and phrases of a particular language or branch of knowledge, such as nautical or medical
   synonym: glossary, dictionary, vocabulary
- (1) Greek-English **lexicon**, (2) **lexicon** of business phrases This bilingual **lexicon** was essential for his language improvement.

label

 a small piece of paper, fabric, or other material attached to an object and giving information about it; (verb) to assign to a category

synonym: tag, mark, identifier

(1) a mailing **label**, (2) **label** a bag with my name The **label** on the food package lists the ingredients and nutritional information.

plot

 a secret plan or scheme to achieve a specific goal; the plan or main story of a literary work; (verb) to plan secretly, usually something illegal

synonym: scheme, plan, design

(1) plot twist, (2) plot a revolution

The **plot** of the novel centers around a group of friends who uncover a conspiracy to control the world's water supply.

pervert

to change the inherent purpose or function of something; to influence somebody to behave in morally unacceptable ways; to corrupt or lead astray; (noun) a person who engages in sexual behavior or has sexual

interests that are considered abnormal or deviant by society

synonym: distort, corrupt, twist

(1) pervert justice, (2) pervert young men

The teacher warned the students not to **pervert** the story's meaning by twisting the facts.

#### institutionalize

 to establish or make something a part of an institution (= a place such as a university, hospital, etc.)

synonym: formalize, establish, regularize

(1) **institutionalize** a system, (2) **institutionalize** customary laws

The new policy aims to **institutionalize** the use of renewable energy sources.

### protest

a strong expression of disagreement, disapproval, or opposition

synonym: objection, disapproval, challenge

(1) hold a protest, (2) a silent protest

He left the party in **protest** at its radical political stance.

### embassy

n. the diplomatic building where a country's representatives to a foreign country are based

synonym: consulate, mission, legation

(1) embassy staff, (2) embassy function

The **embassy** building was heavily guarded by security personnel.

### complain

v. to say dissatisfaction or annoyance about something or somebody

synonym: gripe, claim, denounce

(1) **complain** about a job, (2) call and **complain** frequently Our users are often **complaining** about the slow application.

#### swift

*adj.* happening, moving, or capable of moving quickly *synonym*: quick, speedy, brisk

(1) take **swift** action, (2) a **swift** current of a river Her voice was **swift**, yet ever the last words fell lingeringly.

#### convene

reverse

v. to come or bring together a group of people for a meeting or activity

*synonym*: assemble, gather, summon

- (1) **convene** a press conference, (2) **convene** the council The parliament will **convene** at 1 p.m. tomorrow.
- v. to change something's direction, order, position, decision, etc., to the opposite one; (adjective) directed or moving toward the rear

synonym: overturn, shift, switch

(1) **reverse** the trend, (2) **reverse** the order The restaurant **reversed** a ban on smoking.

#### outwit

v. to defeat or overcome someone cleverly or cunningly by outsmarting them; to be more clever or cunning than someone else

synonym: outsmart, outmaneuver, outfox

(1) **outwit** a problem, (2) **outwit** his competitors

He could **outwit** his opponents with his quick thinking and clever strategy.

#### celebrated

*adj.* renowned for possessing admirable attributes *synonym*: acclaimed, notable, prominent

(1) **celebrated** artist, (2) **celebrated** paper Three **celebrated** tenors performed during the president's inauguration.

### anniversary

 the annual recurrence of a date marking a notable event; a date on which an event occurred in a previous year

synonym: commemoration, celebration, observance

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(1) **anniversary** celebration, (2) a bicentennial **anniversary** They celebrated their 10th **anniversary** with a romantic

dinner.

### independence

- n. freedom from another's or others' control or influencesynonym: freedom, liberty, autonomy
- (1) financial **independence**, (2) **independence** ceremony There is nothing more valuable than **independence** and freedom.

### jubilee

 a special anniversary or celebration, especially one marking a 25th, 50th, or 60th year

synonym: anniversary, celebration, commemorative event

(1) jubilee procession, (2) golden jubilee

The royal family celebrated their **jubilee** with a parade and a special concert.

### nasty

adj. very bad, unpleasant, or offensive synonym: disgusting, offensive, foul

(1) a **nasty** smell, (2) receive a **nasty** surprise The weather turned **nasty**.

#### mass

 a large amount of a substance with no definite shape or form; a large number of people or things grouped or crowded together

synonym: abundance, crowd, mob

(1) a mass of molten rock, (2) critical mass

The **mass** of people who do not own property is politically impotent.

#### fort

- n. a military structure designed to be defended from attacksynonym: stronghold, bastion, fortress
- (1) an isolated fort, (2) fort gate

The stone **fort** was built to protect the city from invading forces.

### superior

*adj.* better, higher in quality, or more advanced than others *synonym*: better, greater, exceptional

(1) **superior** performance, (2) provide **superior** customer service

The new smartphone model is **superior** to the previous version in terms of speed and features.

#### bluff

v. to try to deceive someone into believing that you can or are going to do something, or that you have knowledge or abilities; (noun) a high steep bank, usually formed by river erosion

synonym: abrupt, cliff, precipice

(1) **bluff** the other side, (2) riverside **bluff** He **bluffed** a person out of going.

### mysterious

adj. difficult to understand, explain, or identify; having an aura of secrecy, intrigue, or puzzlement

synonym: enigmatic, cryptic, puzzling

(1) **mysterious** object, (2) **mysterious** stranger The **mysterious** disappearance of the ship remains unsolved.

#### reconstruct

v. to build or form something again that has been damaged or destroyed

synonym: rebuild, revamp, reorganize

(1) **reconstruct** an image, (2) **reconstruct** the original text They've decided to **reconstruct** a ruined castle.

### largely

adv. virtually entirely; to a large degree synonym: mainly, chiefly, broadly

(1) **largely** accepted, (2) **largely** mitigate the issue Nevada is **largely** a desert state.

adj. no longer useful or valid because of being old-fashioned synonym: obsolete, ancient, bygone

(1) become **outdated**, (2) **outdated** technology We replaced **outdated** equipment to improve factory productivity.

rig

v. to prepare or set up something in a certain way, typically in a carefully planned or fraudulent manner; to equip with sails or masts

synonym: set up, prepare, arrange

(1) **rig** an election, (2) **rig** a ship with new sails He **rigged** the game so he could win the prize.

corrupt

adj. characterized by dishonest behavior or actions, often involving bribery, fraud, or the abuse of power for personal gain; morally or ethically flawed or polluted; (verb) to make someone or something morally depraved or causing it to become dishonest

synonym: dishonest, unethical, immoral

(1) **corrupt** good manners, (2) **corrupt** discipline
The **corrupt** politician was finally exposed and faced criminal charges.

consist

- v. to be composed or made up of synonym: lie in, comprise, exist
- (1) **consist** mainly of cells, (2) **consist** only in knowing facts This examination **consists** of five problems to solve.

relation

 the way two persons or groups of people feel and act toward one another

synonym: association, linkage, connection

(1) **relation** between cause and effect, (2) **relation** of inclusion

The industrial **relations** laws were passed with little to no alteration.

slide

 to move or cause to move smoothly along a surface without interruption

synonym: glide, drift, drop

(1) **slide** a card across the table, (2) **slide** a glance If necessary, you can **slide** the front seats forward.

### prosecution

n. the act of bringing legal charges against someone for a crime they are accused of committing; the legal team responsible for presenting the case against the defendant in a criminal trial

synonym: trial, lawsuit, legal action

(1) criminal prosecution, (2) wrongful prosecution
The judge denied the motion to dismiss the prosecution's case.

#### trace

- v. to find or discover someone or something that was lost synonym: seek, follow, depict
- (1) **trace** a telephone call, (2) **trace** back to medieval times Let's **trace** the origins of some familiar foreign words.

#### offshore

- adj. situated at or happening in the sea, not far from the shore or land; (of winds) coming from the landsynonym: seaward, alongshore
- (1) an **offshore** oil field, (2) an **offshore** fund

  The company undertakes **offshore** development for software companies in many countries.

#### locate

v. to specify or determine the exact position of someone or something

synonym: discover, find, place

(1) **locate** a missing pet, (2) **locate** a tumor

The robot can accurately locate construction material.

#### pause

 to take a short break from talking or doing something before continuing

synonym: halt, break, intermit

(1) **pause** a moment, (2) **pause** for a reaction The man **paused** before opening the door.

### damp

adj. slightly wet or moist; characterized by a lack of warmth, enthusiasm, or energy; depressing or dispiriting

synonym: moist, dampened, wet

(1) damp cloth, (2) damp weather

The clothes were still **damp** after being in the dryer for an hour.

### occupy

- v. to consume all of someone's space, attention, or time synonym: inhabit, settle, populate
- (1) **occupy** his time, (2) **occupy** a position The young prince will soon **occupy** the throne.

#### movement

 a group of people working together to achieve a shared goal, especially a political, social, or artistic one; the process of moving or being moved, physically or figuratively

synonym: motion, progression, action

(1) a circular **movement**, (2) **movement** of troops

The **movement** of the dancers on stage was graceful and elegant.

batter

- v. to hit something or someone repeatedly with much force; (noun, baseball) a ballplayer who is batting synonym: beat, pound, strike
- (1) batter the eggs, (2) the batter's boxHe got so angry that he battered the door down.

#### blond

adj. of a light, yellowish-brown or golden color, typically describing hair color; (also spelled "blonde") a female with such hair color

synonym: blonde, light-haired

(1) blond fuzz, (2) ash- blond ringlet

She is a natural **blond** and doesn't need to dye her hair.

#### brain

 the organ inside the head that is responsible for one's movement, thought, memory, and feeling

synonym: intellect, mind, encephalon

(1) basic **brain** function, (2) permanent **brain** damage X-rays revealed a small tumor in his **brain**.

spy

a person who is employed or trained to observe or gather information in secret, often for military or political purposes; a person who secretly or illegally gathers information about a private individual or organization

synonym: agent, undercover operative

(1) **spy** cameras, (2) digital **spy** tools

The government recruited a **spy** to gather information on a suspected terrorist cell

novel

an extended fictional work in prose; usually in the form of a story; (adjective) original and of a kind not seen before

synonym: fiction, story, (adjective) innovative

(1) historical **novel**, (2) **novel** effect

The **novel** has largely gotten positive feedback.

privilege

a special right or advantage that only one person or n. group of people has, usually because they are rich and powerful in a society

synonym: benefit, authorization, advantage
