#### confuse

#### limitless

adj. without end, limit, or boundary; infinite synonym: boundless, infinite, unrestricted

### galvanize

synonym: energize, invigorate, motivate

(1) galvanize steel, (2) galvanize the country

The motivational speech **galvanized** the team and gave them the drive to succeed.

#### cherish

v. to hold someone or something dear; to feel or show affection for someone or something

synonym: treasure, value, hold dear

(1) **cherish** a stuffed animal, (2) **cherish** relationships She **cherished** the memories of her childhood.

#### enamel

 a hard, glossy coating that is applied to surfaces such as metal, glass, or ceramics to protect them from wear, corrosion, or weathering; the hard, white outer layer of teeth

synonym: glaze, varnish, coating

The dentist recommended using toothpaste with extra **enamel** protection to prevent cavities.

# spoil

synonym: rot, decay, deteriorate

#### ripen

 to cause something to be fully developed; to become ripe

synonym: mature, grow, age

#### rubble

 fragments of rock, stone, or other materials that remain after a building or other structure has been destroyed or demolished; the remains of something that has been broken down or destroyed

synonym: debris, ruins, wreckage

(1) clear away **rubble**, (2) **rubble-strewn** road
After the earthquake, the city was left in a pile of **rubble**.

### precipice

 a steep cliff, especially one that is high and has a vertical or nearly vertical face

synonym: cliff, drop, brink

(1) leap off a **precipice**, (2) mural **precipice**The hiker stood at the edge of the **precipice**, taking in the breathtaking view.

#### facto

adj. of or relating to facts; done in reality; actually existing or occurring

synonym: actual, real

#### landmine

#### smolder

#### contaminate
