#### decode

- v. to convert something, such as a message or piece of information, from a specific form into one that you can understand
- synonym: decipher, translate, interpret

(1) **decode** a message, (2) ability to **decode** the differences The software could **decode** the encrypted data and reveal the hidden information.

#### reconfigure

v. to change the configuration or arrangement of something, often to improve its performance or functionality

synonym: reshape, restructure, realign

(1) **reconfigure** the network, (2) **reconfigure** the operating system

We need to **reconfigure** the office layout to use the space better.

rot

v. to decay, or cause something to decay, naturally and gradually

synonym: perish, decay, corrode

(1) begin to **rot**, (2) **rot** with age

Please refrigerate the meat, or it will rot.

#### embed

- v. to fix or set firmly in a surrounding mass synonym: entrench, fix, set
- (1) **embed** scripts in the message, (2) **embed** a sensor The company **embedded** a tracking code in the product's packaging to monitor its shipment.

#### tetrahedron

a solid geometric figure with four triangular faces,
typically used in 3d geometry

synonym: triangular pyramid, four-faced solid

(1) regular **tetrahedron**, (2) **tetrahedron** molecule In chemistry and physics, the **tetrahedron** shape describes the geometry of certain molecules and crystals.

### blueprint

 a photographic print of an early plan for a building or machine

synonym: draft, prototype, sketch

(1) blueprint for economic reform, (2) architect's blueprint

A business plan is a **blueprint** for your success.

## replicate

- v. to make an exact copy of something; to repeat a process or experiment to confirm the results
- synonym: duplicate, imitate, reproduce
- (1) replicate the cell, (2) replicate data

The experiment was **replicated** several times to ensure accuracy.
