insist	<ul> <li>v. to say something clearly or demand something forcefully, especially when other people disagree with or oppose what you say</li> <li>synonym: demand, assert, claim</li> </ul>

responsible	<i>adj.</i> answerable or accountable for something within one's power, control, or management
