attune

to make receptive or aware; to bring into harmony or alignment

synonym: align, harmonize, acclimate

- to make something or someone more humane or compassionate; to make something more relatable or understandable to humans

synonym: civilize, personalize

(1) humanize my pet, (2) humanize a room The charity event aims to **humanize** the homeless rather than treat them as mere statistics.

to receive money, property, or a title from someone after they have died

synonym: obtain, gain, acquire

amputation

beetle

mandarin

flashcard

- a card with a word, picture, or other information on one side, used as an aid in learning

rectum

superficial

aspen

whiz

v. to move or run quickly and smoothly with a hissing or buzzing sound; to excel or perform skillfully in a particular area; to urinate; (noun) a person who is very clever or skilled at something

synonym: zoom, zip, hurry

(1) whiz kid, (2) whiz through the book

The racing car **whizzed** past the grandstands, leaving a trail of dust behind it.

neuroscience

- the scientific study of the function, structure, and disorder of the brain and the nervous system

synthesize

materialistic

synonym: worldly, consumerist, acquisitive

(1) materialistic lifestyle, (2) materialistic values Some people believe that the pursuit of wealth is a materialistic goal.

enchantment

 a feeling of great pleasure or delight; a magical spell or charm

synonym: charm, magic, spell

(1) sense of **enchantment**, (2) poetic **enchantment**The **enchantment** of the forest made it feel like a fairy tale.

autobiography

n. a written account of someone's own life, written by that person

synonym: bio, life story, biography

(1) **autobiography** of his early life, (2) fictionalized **autobiography**

consciously

adv. with awareness; in a deliberate manner synonym: intentionally, deliberately, knowingly

oddity

n. something unusual or differentsynonym: rarity, curiosity, peculiarity

disproportionately

adv. in a way that is not reasonably or appropriately balanced, equal, or distributed; in a manner that is unequal or excessive about something else

synonym: excessively, unequally

The rich can often **disproportionately** benefit from tax breaks and other advantages.

gravitation

 the force by which a celestial body, such as the Earth, pulls objects toward its center; the attraction between two or more objects due to their mass

synonym: attraction, pull, gravity

(1) terrestrial **gravitation**, (2) universal **gravitation**The force of **gravitation** keeps the planets in our solar system in orbit around the sun.

marinade

 a liquid mixture of herbs, spices, oil, and vinegar or citrus juice used to flavor and tenderize meat or fish before cooking; a soaking or immersion in this mixture

gluttony

imprint

contagion

the spread of a disease or harmful influence from one person or thing to another

synonym: infection, disease, transmission

(1) a contagion of fear, (2) contagion effect The government has implemented measures to prevent the contagion of COVID-19, such as social distancing and mandatory mask-wearing.

enlightenment

education that results in understanding and the spread of knowledge

synonym: civilization, awareness, sophistication

- (1) spiritual **enlightenment**, (2) **enlightenment** activity He finally brought his **enlightenment** to perfection.
- a tax or payment, particularly a share or portion of something; a person from Scotland or a Scottish immigrant

synonym: tax, charge, toll

blacksmith

- a smith who forges and shapes iron with a hammer and anvil

synonym: waggle, swish, wave

tack

n. a method of changing the course of a sailing vessel by turning the bow through the wind so that the wind switches from one side of the vessel to the other; a course of action or strategy, particularly in politics or business; (verb) to fasten or attach something, such as pinning or nailing an object in place

synonym: course, direction, approach

(1) change **tack**, (2) **tack** to the refrigerator door I need to change the **tack** of the sailboat to avoid hitting the rocks.

equipoise

 a state of balance, equilibrium, or equal distribution of weight or forces; a sense of stability or calmness in a situation or decision-making process

synonym: balance, stability, poise

serenity

 the state of being calm, peaceful, and untroubled; a feeling of tranquility or peacefulness

Meditation and yoga are great ways to achieve **serenity** and peace of mind.

overconfidence

 excessive trust or faith in one's abilities, judgments, or decisions, often leading to mistaken assumptions or risky behavior

drown

v. to die or cause to die by being unable to breathe underwater

synonym: douse, drench, overwhelm

Floods have the potential to **drown** any subsurface animals easily.

epistemology

 a branch of philosophy that deals with knowledge and belief, including the nature and limits of knowledge, the sources and criteria of knowledge, and the justification of belief

synonym: theory of knowledge, knowledge science

(1) a specialist in **epistemology**, (2) **epistemology** study Evolutionary **epistemology** is a field of study that seeks to

understand how knowledge has evolved.

modesty

n. the quality of being modest (= having or showing a humble estimate of one's merits, importance, etc.), which can include humility or shyness; the act of not showing too much of oneself or being overly boastful

synonym: humility, reserve, bashfulness

(1) behave with **modesty**, (2) **modesty** panel Many people with true talent show a sense of **modesty** rather than arrogance.

ambiguity

- n. the quality of being open to more than one interpretation; the uncertainty of meaningsynonym: uncertainty, vagueness, obscurity

correlate

 to have a connection or relationship in which one thing affects or depends on another

gist

- n. the essence or main point of a text, speech, or situationsynonym: essence, core, summary
- (1) the **gist** of a claim, (2) get the **gist**The **gist** of the article was that technology is rapidly changing our world.

landmine

 an explosive device hidden underground and designed to be detonated by the presence, proximity, or contact with a person or vehicle

synonym: mine, explosive device, antipersonnel mine

(1) destroy a landmine, (2) landmine removal

The antipersonnel **landmine** was a dangerous obstacle in the war-torn area.

nonverbal

adj. not involving or using spoken or written language; communicated through body language, facial expression, or other means besides language

determinant

pretension

phenomenally

adv. extremely or exceptionally, especially in a way that is surprising

entail

v. to involve or require something as necessary, particularly as a consequence of a particular situation or

entail legal consequences, (2) entail risks

limerence

 a state of being infatuated or obsessed with another person, typically characterized by intense emotions, fantasies, and longing for reciprocation

synonym: infatuation, obsession, crush

transcend
