## biomimetics

*n.* the study of natural systems and structures to create new technologies or improve existing ones

(1) **biomimetics** research, (2) **biomimetics** technology  
The aircraft's design was inspired by **biomimetics** principles, which allowed for improved aerodynamics and reduced fuel consumption.

## rhythmic

*adj.* having a pattern of regular beats or a regular beat; characterized by rhythm

*synonym* : measured, metrical, cadenced

The **rhythmic** sound of the drums was mesmerizing.

## tirelessly

*adv.* without getting tired or fatigued; persistently, energetically, and continuously working with great effort

*synonym* : inexhaustibly, indefatigably, unceasingly

(1) dedicated **tirelessly**, (2) **tirelessly** help out  
She worked **tirelessly** for hours to finish her project on time.

## pacemaker

*n.* a small electronic device that is implanted in the chest to regulate the heartbeat of people with certain heart conditions; a person or thing that sets the pace or rhythm for others

*synonym* : heartbeat regulator, pacer, pacesetter

(1) implanted **pacemaker**, (2) **pacemaker** battery  
Some people with **pacemakers** may need to avoid certain activities or sources of electromagnetic interference.

## greedy

*adj.* having or showing an intense or insatiable desire for wealth, status, power, or food

*synonym* :

avaricious, covetous, grasping

His **greedy** behavior led him to steal from the company.

## biomaterial

*n.* a substance, usually synthetic, that is used for medical or veterinary purposes and is designed to mimic or replace biological tissues

## scaffold
