disturb

idol

 an image or representation of a god or goddess, or a person or thing that is greatly admired, loved, or revered

synonym: icon, hero, legend

(1) idol worship, (2) idol singer

He was an **idol** to his fans, who looked up to him as a role model.

dupe

to deceive or trick someone into believing something that is not true; to cheat or swindle someone; (noun) a person who has been deceived or tricked into believing something that is not true, often by someone who is trying to take advantage of them

synonym: trick, deceive, fool

He tried to **dupe** me into buying a product that didn't work.

heterosexual

adj. attracted to individuals of the opposite sex synonym: straight, conventional

penguin

pebble

synonym: rock, stone, cobble

disqualify
