depression

 a mental condition in which a person feels very unhappy and without hope for the future; a severe recession in an economy or market

morphine

 a powerful narcotic drug used to relieve pain and induce sleep

 the inability to stop using or doing something as a habit, especially something harmful

panel

n. a square or rectangular and flat piece of something that forms a distinct section or component of something; a small group of specialists who discuss particular topics or give their advice or opinion about something

A **panel** of economic advisers from the United States visited the country to help rebuild its economy.

screw

v. to turn something, such as a bolt, with a driver or wrench to tighten or loosen it; (noun) a cylindrical rod with a helical ridge used to fasten things together

synonym: tighten, fix, secure

(1) screw the cap, (2) a female screw

He had to **screw** the loose knob back onto the cabinet door.

voltage

- the difference in the force of an electric current between two points
- (1) the voltage spiked, (2) low voltage

Connecting batteries in series increase the **voltage** of the circuit.

primal

adj. of or relating to the earliest stage of development; fundamental; primitive

synonym: original, fundamental, basic

(1) primal eras, (2) primal fear

appreciation

 the act of recognizing and valuing the worth or importance of something or someone; gratitude or thankfulness; an increase in value over time

synonym: recognition, admiration, esteem

(1) express my **appreciation**, (2) **appreciation** for diversity The artist received a lot of **appreciation** for his latest work.

brawl

 a noisy and violent fight involving a group of people; a chaotic and unruly disturbance or conflict

synonym: fight, scuffle, skirmish

(1) barroom brawl, (2) street brawl

The **brawl** at the nightclub resulted in several injuries and arrests.

loyal

adj. giving or remaining firm and constant support to a person, institution, product, etc.;

synonym: dedicated, devoted, faithful

(1) a **loyal** friend, (2) become a **loyal** customer Enemy armies are **loyal** to their monarch.

individual

- n. a single person or thing, as distinct from a group synonym: person, being, self
- (1) a private **individual**, (2) **individual** freedom
 As an **individual**, he had the right to make his own decisions and live his life as he saw fit.

strength

 the quality or state of being physically, or sometimes mentally, strong

synonym: resilience, power, muscles

claim

interchange

 an exchange of one thing for another, often involving a replacement or substitution; a meeting or intersection of two or more roads or routes

synonym: exchange, swap, trade

fungible

adj. able to be replaced or exchanged with another identical item; uniform and interchangeable in value or use *synonym*: interchangeable, exchangeable, tradable

(1) **fungible** securities, (2) **fungible** assets Gold is a **fungible commodity**, meaning its value is interchangeable with other gold of the same quality and quantity.

commodity

a product or a raw material that can be traded, bought, or sold

synonym: merchandise, goods, entity

- (1) commodity tax, (2) international commodity The government announced a policy to control the rise in commodity prices.
- a state of being equal to someone or something *synonym*: equality, standard, balance
- (1) above par performance, (2) not up to par Shares in the company finally fell below their **par** value.

- a complete list of all the items or goods held in stock by a business or organization; the act of making such a list synonym: stock, supplies, goods
- (1) inventory control, (2) annual inventory The store manager took **inventory** of the products on the shelves to know what needed restocking.

sperm

- the reproductive cell produced by a man or male animal synonym: seed, semen, seminal fluid
- (1) man with a low **sperm** count, (2) production of **sperm** The male **sperm** fertilizes the female egg.

economics

 n. the branch of social science that deals with the production, consumption, and transfer of goods and services

synonym: social science, finance, business

arrangement

 a plan or preparation for the future event; the action or process of placing things in a particular order

synonym: placement, configuration, account

wrestling

 a sport in which two contestants grapple and try to throw each other to the ground

synonym: grappling, fighting, brawling

straightforward

penguin

 a flightless sea bird that is found in the Southern Hemisphere and is known for its distinctive black and white coloring and its upright, waddling gait

 n. a structure in which animals lay their eggs or give birth to their young
