conscious

wreckage

survivor

a person who remains alive after an event in which others have died

synonym: subsister

depart

- to go away or leave, especially to start a journey synonym: go away, leave, vacate

extract

a short passage taken from a book, piece of music, etc.; n. a substance obtained from something through a specific process; (verb) to obtain from something or to remove something by effort or force

synonym: excerpt, quote, distillation
