#### contagious

# terrifying

#### nocturnal

# scavenger

an animal or bird that feeds on carrion, dead animals, or other scavenged material; a person who searches for and collects discarded or unwanted items, often to sell or reuse them

Crows are common **scavengers** in urban areas and will eat almost anything.

# chomp

rot

#### extinct

#### unaffected

#### gruesome

#### ulcer

#### riddle
