# brainstorming

# comparable

# galaxy

n. an independent group of stars, interstellar gas, dark matter, etc., in the universe, bound together by gravity synonym: star cluster, nebula, star system

#### universe

#### **fundamental**

adj. forming an essential base or core from which everything else develops or is affected

synonym: characterize, depict, express

roll

# valley

 a long depression on the surface of the land, which typically contains a river

synonym: canyon, gorge, dale

toil

#### popcorn

# symphony

# preparation

#### motor

#### embedded

# digital

#### command

# reproduce

# voluntary

#### robotic

#### mechanical

# computation

#### actuate

# machinery

 a group of large machines or the components of a machine that make it work; social institution functions or structure for doing something

synonym: apparatus, appliance, equipment

# superstar

- n. a very famous and successful performer or athletesynonym: celebrity, icon, megastar

- a natural appearance of colored light in Earth's sky that is usually seen in high-latitude regions, especially around the Arctic and Antarctic

#### cursor

# trajectory

*n.* the curved path followed by an object moving through space

# biology

- the scientific study of life and the natural processes of living things
- (1) evolutionary **biology**, (2) cell and molecular **biology** In junior high school, we had to dissect a frog in **biology** class.

#### scratch

v. to cut or damage the surface of something or the skin with a sharp or pointed object

synonym: claw, rub, scrape

# incorporate

- v. to include something as a part of a larger entity synonym: contain, integrate, amalgamate

#### extension

# expand

# proportion

 a part, share, or amount of something considered in comparative relation to a whole

synonym: ratio, balance, consonance

(1) direct **proportion**, (2) a building of vast **proportions**He is more concerned about the **proportion** of his body fat than usual because of an upcoming bodybuilding competition.

#### tactile

adj. relating to the sense of touch; tangible or perceptible through the sense of touch

*synonym*: touchable, tangible, palpable

(1) tactile stimulation, (2) tactile feedback

The **tactile** sensation of the fabric was soft and smooth to the touch.

# process

a series of actions or operations performed to achieve a particular outcome or goal; a systematic procedure or approach used to accomplish a specific task or objective; a method of treating milk to make it suitable for consumption or use in other dairy products

synonym: procedure, method, system

(1) **process** improvement, (2) decision-making **process** The **process** for applying for a visa can be lengthy and complicated.

# pathway

 a track that constitutes or serves as a path; an approach or a way of doing something

synonym: route, footpath, trail

#### reward

*n*. a thing given in acknowledgment of service, hard work, achievement, etc.

#### constraint

n. a limit or restriction on something, such as an action, behavior, or thought

# perception

# legend

# shifting

adj. constantly changing or movingsynonym: unfirm, shifty, fluctuating

#### discriminate

v. to treat a person or particular group of people worse or better than another, especially in an unfair way; to recognize or perceive the difference between people or things

# panel

 a square or rectangular and flat piece of something that forms a distinct section or component of something; a small group of specialists who discuss particular topics or give their advice or opinion about something

synonym: board, commission, discussion

 A panel of economic advisers from the United States visited the country to help rebuild its economy.

# alignment

- n. an arrangement in which two or more elements are placed in a straight line or parallel to each othersynonym: conjunction, arrangement, coalition
- (1) **alignment** in an organization, (2) be in **alignment** In the last century, Britain formed a strong **alignment** with Egypt.

# physiology

- the branch of the biological sciences dealing with the functioning of organisms
- (1) human **physiology**, (2) **physiology** research **Physiology** is the science of how living things work.

#### reset

 to set again or differently; to return to a previous state or condition

synonym: restart, reinitialize, set anew

(1) reset password, (2) reset my brain

#### shift

- n. a slight transition in position, direction, or trendsynonym: transition, change, modification

#### represent

v. to speak, act, or be present on behalf of another person or group; to form or constitute

synonym: depict, express, describe

(1) **represent** by a diagram, (2) the characters that **represent** numbers

We elected him to **represent** us at the international conference.

#### assimilate

 to take in and understand information or ideas; to integrate

synonym: absorb, incorporate, integrate

(1) **assimilate** into society, (2) **assimilate** a language The immigrant struggled to **assimilate** into the new culture.

# epithelial

- adj. relating to the layer of cells that covers the majority of the body's surfaces
- epithelial surface, (2) epithelial layer
   The majority of cells in the lung are epithelial cells.

#### electron

n. a tiny particle with the negative electrical charge

*synonym*: negatron

(1) flow of **electrons**, (2) beam of **electrons**The outermost **electron** shell determines the chemical properties of an atom.

#### violin

 a four-stringed wooden musical instrument held against the neck and played by passing a bow across the strings

synonym: fiddle

#### voracious

# amazing

# dynamic

adj. having a lot of energy, ideas, and enthusiasm, and a strong personality; of or relating to dynamics (= the branch of physics and engineering concerned with the forces that cause motions of bodies)

synonym: energetic, active, vital

(1) a **dynamic** market, (2) **dynamic** person

The sprinter has a **dynamic** way of running.

# experiment

n. the scientific test conducted to observe what happens and gain new knowledge

synonym: experimentation, investigation

(1) **experiment** design, (2) series of **experiments** His **experiments** showed highly positive results.

#### treadmill

n. a piece of exercise equipment consisting of a moving belt on which the user walks, jogs, or runs in place; a monotonous, repetitive task or activity that feels like it is going nowhere, much like a person walking on a treadmill

synonym: exercise machine, routine

#### statistics

# **laboratory**

 a workplace for doing scientific research or teaching science; a lab

synonym: lab, workshop, testing room

transmit

v. to send or forward an electronic signal; to pass something from one person or thing to another

*synonym*: convey, share, dispatch

transmit the disease, (2) transmit information

#### planet

 any of the nine large celestial bodies that circle in the solar system; any celestial body that revolves around a star

synonym: earth, world, globe

#### globe

the earth or world, mainly used to emphasize its vastness

synonym: Earth, world, sphere
