fatty

adj. containing a lot of fat

synonym: greasy, oily

(1) less fatty meat, (2) fatty acid

You should keep away from fatty foods.

unfair

 adj. not giving equal treatment or opportunities to people involved; marked by injustice, partiality, or deception

synonym: wrongful, biased, dishonest

(1) **unfair** employment practices, (2) have an **unfair** advantage

In a democracy, it is necessary to monitor the judiciary to see if it is making **unfair** decisions.

presuppose

 to assume or require as an essential condition or prerequisite; to take for granted or consider as a necessary assumption before further discussion or action

synonym: assume, suppose, postulate

(1) **presuppose** certain conditions, (2) **presuppose** a limitation

To fully understand the concept, we must **presuppose** certain background knowledge.

retirement

- n. the fact or act of stopping working and leaving one's jobsynonym: resignation, withdrawal, retreat
- (1) retirement from politics, (2) impending retirementThis fund is responsible for disability and retirement benefits.

shave

v. to remove body hair with a razor; to cut the price of something

synonym: trim, cut down, prune

(1) shave my head, (2) shave cheese

That supermarket tried to shave certain costs by saving

electricity.

marine

adj. relating to the sea and the creatures and plants that live there

synonym: sea-dwelling, maritime, aquatic

(1) marine insurance, (2) variety of marine life

Seals and whales are marine animals beloved by the people.

biology

- the scientific study of life and the natural processes of living things
- (1) evolutionary **biology**, (2) cell and molecular **biology** In junior high school, we had to dissect a frog in **biology** class.

realistic

adj. having or showing a sensible and practical idea that is possible to achieve

synonym: practical, pragmatic, down-to-earth

(1) a realistic goal, (2) a realistic goal

That story was so realistic, and it was scary.

professional

adj. having or showing the skill appropriate to a particular job; competent or skillful

synonym: skilled, competent, accomplished

(1) **professional** athlete, (2) certified **professional** secretary

He has a **professional** demeanor and always presents himself in a polished manner.

wrestling

a sport in which two contestants grapple and try to throw each other to the ground

synonym: grappling, fighting, brawling

(1) wrestling match, (2) arm wrestling

He had always been interested in sumo **wrestling** and decided to try it.

sacrifice

n. the act of killing an animal or person or surrendering a possession as an offering to a deity; (verb) to give up

something important or valuable to help another person or get or do something that seems more important

synonym: forfeit, immolation, gift

(1) small **sacrifice** for a great cause, (2) **sacrifice** anything to get ahead

You cannot accomplish great things without a **sacrifice** of your time or money.

inherit

 to receive money, property, or a title from someone after they have died

synonym: obtain, gain, acquire

(1) **inherit** estate, (2) **inherit** ancestral property After his death, his sons **inherited** his business.

masquerade

 a party, dance, or other festive gatherings of persons wearing masks and other disguises, or a costume worn on such an occasion; making a false outward show

synonym: disguise, pretense, facade

(1) show up in a **masquerade**, (2) absurd **masquerade**The **masquerade** party was lavish, with guests in elaborate costumes and masks.

identity

n. the fact of being who or what somebody or something is; the features, emotions, or ideas that distinguish persons from one another

synonym: character, personality, individuality

(1) mistaken **identity**, (2) **identity** as an individual The terrorist's **identity** remains unknown.

dismiss

 to regard something or someone as not important and not worth considering; to terminate someone's employment

synonym: decline, disband, dissolve

(1) **dismiss** a person from the office, (2) **dismiss** a matter with a laugh

The committee has decided to dismiss the president from

#### grant

- v. to agree to give or allow somebody
- synonym: allocate, authorize, give
- (1) grant a new license, (2) grant a land

The chairperson **granted** him the right to speak.

### shyness

- n. the quality or state of being worried or embarrassed about meeting and speaking to other people
- synonym: bashfulness, timidity, modesty
- (1) lose some of my **shyness**, (2) **shyness** barrier He finally overcame his **shyness**.

#### conscious

- adj. being aware of and able to respond to what is happening around you
- synonym: aware, cognizant, deliberate
- (1) **conscious** effort, (2) **conscious** of having succeeded He became **conscious** that he was being followed.

#### overly

- adv. to a greater degree than is appropriate or desirable synonym: excessively, too much
- (1) **overly** excessive, (2) **overly** unnecessary
  The movie was **overly** dramatic, with exaggerated emotions and cliched plot twists.

### apologetic

adj. feeling or expressing regret, remorse, or sorrow for one's actions; making an apology or expressing an excuse for something

synonym: sorry, regretful, remorseful

(1) apologetic tone, (2) apologetic letterHe was apologetic for being late to the meeting.

### foolish

- adj. lacking good sense or judgment; displaying a lack of wisdom or intelligence
- synonym: silly, absurd, imprudent
- (1) foolish behavior, (2) foolish decision

Forgetting to save his work was a **foolish** mistake that cost him hours of effort.

### garbage

- n. waste material, especially food waste and kitchen refusesynonym: waste, trash, debris
- (1) **garbage** collection, (2) lump of **garbage**The **garbage** truck will be coming to pick up the trash every Monday morning.

#### trash

- n. discarded material, refuse, or waste
- synonym: garbage, waste, refuse
- (1) trash bin, (2) trash disposal site

### dumpster

- a large, commercial trash receptacle designed to be emptied mechanically by a garbage truck

#### crush

- v. to press it firmly, usually with your hands or a tool, so that it becomes flat or smaller
- synonym: destroy, demolish, pulverize

### compact

- adj. closely and firmly united or packed together, using very little space; smaller than is usual

#### poetry

- n. poems in general as a genre of literature
- synonym: ode, poesy, verse
- (1) modern **poetry**, (2) book of **poetry**

### boomerang

 a curved, flat wooden or metal weapon that is thrown and can return to the thrower; a plan, action, or attempt that unintentionally rebounds on the person who initiates it

synonym: bouncing bomb, comeback, backfire

(1) **boomerang** effect, (2) throw a **boomerang** The criticism that he gave to his boss ended up **boomeranging** on himself.

#### loath

bully

 adj. unwilling or reluctant to; feeling strong dislike or aversion towards

synonym: reluctant, unwilling, disinclined

- (1) **loath** to negotiate, (2) **loath** to fire my loyal employee I'm **loath** to go to the dentist because I fear the pain.
- a person who uses strength or power to harm or intimidate those who are weaker; (verb) to intimidate, harass, or mistreat someone weaker or less powerful

synonym: tormentor, intimidator, aggressor

(1) **bully** bystander, (2) **bully** the weak

The schoolyard **bully** terrorized the other children and made their lives miserable.

### lean

adj. having a noticeably small amount of body fat; (verb) to bend or move from a straight to a sloping posture

synonym: skinny, slender, (verb) slant

a lean horse, (2) lean athletic figure
 Lean operational improvements often lead to better

environmental performance.

### opposition

the act of disagreeing or resisting; the state of strong disagreement

synonym: resistance, hostility, antagonism

(1) opposition campaign, (2) meet with oppositionThe opposition party strongly disagreed with the

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government's proposed legislation.

### standing

adj. existing or remaining upright; having a vertical position; (noun) social, financial, or professional status or reputation

synonym: upright, vertical, (noun) position

(1) standing water, (2) his social standing

The **standing** concert was packed with fans.

#### embrace

v. to accept something willingly and enthusiastically; (noun) the act of clasping another person in the arms as in greeting or affection

synonym: grasp, hold tightly, accept

(1) **embrace** an opportunity, (2) a warm **embrace** The woods **embrace** the house.

### violent

adj. involving or caused by physical force or aggression against someone or something

synonym: aggressive, intense, turbulent

(1) victim of a **violent** crime, (2) **violent** incident The protesters became **violent** when the police tried to disperse them.

### assignment

 a duty or task given to someone, usually as part of their job or studies

synonym: task, duty, designation

(1) finish the **assignment**, (2) **assignment** of interest My **assignment** was overwhelming and complicated, but it was also exciting.

### frustration

 the feeling of being upset or annoyed as a result of being unable to change or achieve something

synonym: disappointment, discouragement, dissatisfaction

(1) frustration level, (2) express frustration

He felt a deep **frustration** as he realized the project would not be completed on time.

### yoga

 a Hindu spiritual and ascetic discipline including breath control, simple meditation, and the adoption of specific bodily postures, which is widely practiced for health and relaxation

synonym: meditation, exercise, spiritual practice

(1) aerial yoga, (2) yoga teacher

Many people find that regular **yoga** practice can help reduce stress and anxiety.

### picnic

 an outdoor meal or social gathering where food is served and eaten in nature, typically in a park, forest, or other outdoor settings

synonym: outing, barbecue, walkover

(1) picnic basket, (2) picnic table

The family enjoyed a lovely **picnic** in the park on a sunny day.

#### satisfaction

 a pleasant feeling you have when you have fulfilled a desire, need, or expectation or have achieved something

synonym: delight, pleasure, content

(1) a sense of **satisfaction**, (2) customer **satisfaction**The mediated settlement brought **satisfaction** to both sides.

### puzzled

adj. confused or uncertain because you do not understand something

synonym: confused, perplexed, bewildered

(1) **puzzled** expression, (2) **puzzled** by the question She was **puzzled** by the strange behavior of her cat.

chop

v. to cut something into pieces with a sharp tool, such as a knife

synonym: cut, hack, slice

(1) **chop** wood, (2) **chop** a meet with a knife The cook **chopped** the vegetables for the soup.

#### karate

n. a Japanese martial art that emphasizes hand and foot strikes, blocks, and evasions, often using a combination of techniques to overpower an opponent, also seen as a form of self-defense and physical training

synonym: martial art, self-defense discipline

(1) karate moves, (2) black belt in karate

She has been practicing **karate** for years and has won many tournaments.

#### bruise

 a mark caused by a blow, typically one that is purple or black on the skin

synonym: contusion, injury, wound

(1) livid **bruise**, (2) earlier emotional **bruise** 

She had a **bruise** on her arm from where she fell on the playground.

#### scared

adj. afraid or frightened

synonym: frightened, fearful, dreading

(1) scared all the time, (2) scared dog

I'm scared of insects.

#### gym

- n. a place equipped for exercise and other physical trainingsynonym: fitness center, athletic club
- (1) gym membership, (2) a gym suit

She went to the fully equipped **gym** to work out every day.

### principal

adj. most important, main, or chief

synonym: main, leading, chief(1) principal actor, (2) principal responsible

The **principal** reason for the company's success is its innovative products.

### investigation

*n.* the act or process of thoroughly examining a crime, problem, statement, etc., to uncover the truth

*synonym*: examination, analysis, inspection

(1) a preliminary investigation, (2) the scope of an

### investigation

We have never before conducted a legitimate **investigation**.

#### decide

- v. to make up someone's mind about something; to come to a conclusion or judgment after considering options
   synonym: choose, determine, settle
- (1) **decide** a question, (2) **decide** on a course of action She couldn't **decide** whether to order the pizza or the pasta for dinner.

#### nickname

 a familiar or humorous name given to a person or thing instead of or as well as the real name

synonym: moniker, sobriquet, handle

(1) endearing **nickname**, (2) **nickname** for a person The team has a **nickname** for their star player: "The Ace."

#### surround

- v. to be all around something or somebody synonym: encircle, encompass, envelop
- (1) **surround** a town, (2) a stone wall **surrounds** the palace On three sides, mountains **surround** the settlement.

### rhyme

 a word or phrase that has the same last sound as another word or phrase, often used in poetry and songwriting

synonym: verse, poetry, meter

(1) rhyme poem, (2) write in rhyme

The poem had a consistent rhyme scheme throughout.

#### stick

v. to put something, usually a sharp object, into something; to restrict yourself to doing or using one certain thing and not change; (noun) a thin piece of wood or other material

synonym: pierce, adhere, stay

(1) stick a key in a lock, (2) fire stick

You **stick** a bill in the change machine, and the coins pop out.

#### shed

v. to get rid of something as superfluous or unwanted; to cast off hair, skin, horn, or feathers; (noun) an outbuilding with a single story, mainly used for shelter or storage

synonym: discard, drop, cast off

(1) shed an old skin, (2) a cow shed

He **shed** a secret tear when he heard the news of his friend's death.

### heartstring

- someone's most profound feelings, especially used to express love or compassion
- (1) tear the **heartstrings**, (2) touch everyone's **heartstrings**. Her story tugged at my **heartstrings**.

### ingrown

adj. referring to a hair or nail that has grown into the skin surrounding it, causing irritation or infection

synonym: embedded, imbedded, encased

(1) ingrown pimple, (2) ingrown hair

An **ingrown** toenail can be very painful and requires medical attention.

### surgeon

 a doctor who is trained to perform medical operations that involve cutting open a person's body

synonym: sawbones, doctor

an excellent brain surgeon, (2) army surgeon
 a skilled surgeon that has many years of training and experience.

#### metastasize

v. (of a cancerous tumor or disease) to spread or grow to other parts of the body from its original location

synonym: spread, multiply, disseminate

(1) **metastasize** to the liver, (2) **metastasize** from breast cancer

Cancer cells can **metastasize** and spread to other body parts if left untreated.

### grade

- n. a particular level of quality, size, importance, etc.
- synonym: score, rate, degree
- (1) boys in the twelfth **grade**, (2) students at all **grade** levels Departments may set requirements for a higher **grade** point average.

### ugly

- adj. unattractive in appearance; unpleasant to look at synonym: unattractive, unsightly, repulsive
- (1) an **ugly** sound, (2) **ugly** building

The **ugly** truth was that he had been lying to her for months.

#### bombard

- to attack a place with bombs or gunshots continuously;
   to address with continuously or persistently, as if with a barrage
- synonym: bomb, shoot, blitz
- (1) **bombard** him with questions, (2) **bombard** a fort with heavy shells

Overprotective parents often **bombard** their children with messages reinforcing their lack of mastery.

### spitball

 a small ball made from chewing gum or paper and moistened with saliva, typically thrown as a prank or in a playful manner; (verb) brainstorm or throw out ideas, often in a casual or non-committal manner

synonym: paper ball, chewed paper, spit wad

(1) fling a spitball, (2) spitball ideas

The teacher caught the student making a **spitball** gun in the back of the classroom.

### battleground

- n. a place where a battle is foughtsynonym: arena, field, theater
- (1) **battleground** states, (2) the legal **battleground** The city became a **battleground** during the war.

#### outnumber

 to be more numerous or greater in number than another group or entity; to exceed in quantity or number

synonym: surpass, exceed

(1) **outnumber** our opponents, (2) **outnumber** males The number of tourists in the city now **outnumbers** the locals.

#### wretchedness

- the state of being miserable, unhappy, or distressed; the quality of being unfortunate or deeply distressed synonym: misery, unhappiness, distress
- (1) emotional wretchedness, (2) economic wretchedness The book delves into the wretchedness and misery of life in a war-torn country.
- a period of time when the members of a parliament, recess committee, etc., are adjourned; a short break in a trial in court

synonym: break, interval, pause

(1) a court recess, (2) during noon recess The company decided to take a **recess** and reconvene the meeting later that day.

#### rehearse

to practice or repeat something, such as a performance, ν. speech, or action, to prepare for an event or to improve one's skills; to go through the motions of a planned activity before executing it

synonym: practice, recite, drill

(1) rehearse an opera, (2) rehearse a speech The actors needed to **rehearse** their lines before the performance.

statue

a sculpture of a person or animal, typically made of stone or metal, that is intended to represent the subject in a lifelike or symbolic way

synonym: sculpture, figurine, monument

(1) a beautiful **statue**, (2) the ancient Egyptian **statues** The **statue** of the famous hero stood proudly in the town square.

#### clue

tap

 an object, a piece of evidence, or some information that helps someone to find the answer to a problem, question, or mystery

synonym: hint, indication, inkling

- (1) a **clue** about the crime, (2) a **clue** to the diagnosis. The police couldn't find a **clue** to her whereabouts.
- to hit someone or something quickly, gently, and often repeatedly; to use existing resources, such as energy, knowledge, etc.

synonym: knock, exploit, use

(1) **tap** a new market, (2) **tap** keyboard with an index finger To expand the company, we must **tap** new human resources.

#### beware

v. to be cautious or careful about something or someone that may cause harm or danger

*synonym*: heed, caution, alert

beware of scams, (2) beware of strangers
 Please beware of the slippery floor after it rains, or you could fall.

#### birthmark

 a mark or discolored spot on the skin that is present at birth or appears soon after, usually caused by a concentration of pigment or blood vessels

synonym: nevus

(1) congenital **birthmark**, (2) permanent **birthmark**The **birthmark** on her forehead was shaped like a star and made her stand out from the crowd.

#### erase

- v. to remove something completely, especially by rubbing it synonym: wipe out, delete, obliterate
- (1) **erase** a memory, (2) **erased** the files He attempted to **erase** the misspelled word.

#### definition

 a concise explanation of the meaning of a word, phrase, or symbol

synonym: description, connotation, meaning

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(1) a precise **definition**, (2) the **definition** of a word Parallel lines are, by **definition**, lines on the same plane that never cross.

### amazing

adj. extremely surprising, especially in a way that you like or admire

synonym: exceptional, extraordinary, wonderful

(1) **amazing** advances, (2) the most **amazing** feeling The golfer recorded an **amazing** distance.

### branch

 a division of a tree or woody shrub that grows out from the trunk or a main stem; a division of some larger or more complex organization

synonym: limb, twig, bough

(1) branch office, (2) a branch pipe

The **branch** of the tree had fallen and blocked the road.

### graft

n. a transplanted portion of tissue or skin, often taken from one part of the body and used to repair or replace damaged or missing tissue in another part; a corrupt or illegal means of acquiring wealth or power through illicit or unethical methods

*synonym*: transplant, implantation, bribery

(1) graft surgery, (2) anti- graft law

The patient's skin **graft** procedure was successful, and he was released from the hospital.

### adopt

v. to choose to follow something; to legally take a child from another family and care for them as if they were one's own

synonym: accept, assume, take on

(1) adopt a child, (2) adopt a bill

The national assembly has **adopted** the budget.

#### opt

- v. to make a choice from a range of possibilities synonym: choose, select, pick
- (1) opt out of society, (2) opt for a traditional wedding

I decided to **opt** for premature retirement.

### destiny

the events that will inevitably happen to a particular person or thing in the future

synonym: fate, future, outcome

- (1) foreordained **destiny**, (2) **destiny** of the individual It is said that our **destiny** is written in the stars.
- an event or situation causing great loss, misfortune, or destruction; a play or literature that deals with a severe and sad event and often ends with the death of the main character

*synonym*: disaster, adversity, calamity

(1) a **tragedy** during work, (2) the aftermath of this **tragedy** Macbeth is a famous tragedy by Shakespeare.

### therapy

the act of caring for someone through medication, n. remedial training, etc.

synonym: antidote, medicine, treatment

(1) therapy for a patient, (2) field of gene therapy I underwent aversion **therapy** for my addiction to alcohol.

### uphill

adj. sloping upward; difficult or challenging; (adverb) upward on a hill or slope

*synonym*: skyward, ascending, difficult

(1) an **uphill** road, (2) an **uphill** task

The road is **uphill** for a while.

adv. in a direction that is downward or from a higher to a lower point; in a progressively worse or deteriorating manner

*synonym*: downslope

(1) ski downhill, (2) walk downhill to the beach The family's finances have been going **downhill** since they lost their main source of income.

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tragedy

downhill

cliff

 a steep rock face, especially one at the edge of the sea or a river

synonym: crag, escarpment, precipice

(1) a bold cliff, (2) cliff diving

He stood at the edge of the **cliff** and looked out to sea.

#### suicide

n. the act of killing yourself intentionally

synonym: self-destruction, self-annihilation, felo-de-se

(1) commit suicide, (2) suicide attack

In an economically prosperous country, most male **suicide** is due to child support problems.

tide

 the cyclical rise and fall of sea level caused by the moon's gravitational pull

synonym: ripple, surge, swell

(1) tide cycle, (2) ride the tide of change

Red **tide** is often harmful to the local ecosystem.

### antidepressant

- any of a class of drugs used to reduce feelings of sadness and worry
- (1) an **antidepressant** drug, (2) **antidepressant** effect She has been taking **antidepressants** since her baby died.

### adolescent

 a young person who is in the process of developing from a child into an adult

synonym: teen, preadult, youth

(1) **adolescent** girl, (2) pre- **adolescent** children Timely education about birth control might help reduce **adolescent** pregnancies.

cruel

adj. feeling or showing pleasure in causing pain or suffering to others

synonym: heartless, sadistic, vicious

(1) a **cruel** and unusual punishment, (2) **cruel** joke The dictator was known for his **cruel** and oppressive regime.

### audacity

boldness or daring, especially when it is foolhardy or reckless

*synonym*: boldness, daring, temerity

(1) audacity of hope, (2) act of audacity

His **audacity** in stealing the painting matched his foolishness in getting caught.

### depression

a mental condition in which a person feels very unhappy and without hope for the future; a severe recession in an economy or market

*synonym*: recession, slump, despair

(1) the Great **Depression**, (2) the root problem of her depression

**Depression** symptoms might include a decrease in appetite and weight loss.

### remedy

a successful way of dealing with or improving an unpleasant or difficult situation or curing an illness

*synonym*: treatment, medication, therapy

(1) **remedy** for air pollution, (2) an internal **remedy** This drug will be a good **remedy** for your stomach trouble.

things sent to help countries in need, notably food or n. money; support

synonym: helper, resource, assistance

- (1) financial **aid**, (2) country-by-country **aid** programs Pakistan's aid budget was still being reviewed.
- a set of tools, supplies, or equipment for a particular purpose

synonym: set, package, bundle

(1) survival **kit**, (2) a first-aid **kit** 

I bought a new tool kit for my home repair projects.

### inspiration

something that motivates or encourages someone to create or achieve something, or a feeling of excitement or creativity

aid

kit

synonym: motivation, drive, encouragement

(1) source of **inspiration**, (2) get **inspiration** from nature He found **inspiration** in the works of his favorite authors.

#### conversation

*n.* an informal talk between two or more people to exchange their views, ideas, information, etc.

synonym: chat, discussion, dialogue

(1) **conversation** in English, (2) a friendly **conversation** Your **conversation** reflects your thoughts.

#### addiction

 the inability to stop using or doing something as a habit, especially something harmful

synonym: dependence

(1) alcohol **addiction**, (2) **addiction** to foreign oil He is now fighting his **addiction** to drugs.

### sanity

- n. the state of being mentally sound, healthy, and rational synonym: mental health, rationality, soundness
- (1) **sanity** check, (2) have a **sanity** hearing
  Her job's long hours and high pressure started affecting her **sanity**.

#### arsenal

- a collection of weapons or military equipment stored in preparation for war or conflict; a collection of resources or tools available for use in a particular field or endeavor synonym: storage, stockpile, armory
- (1) **arsenal** of knowledge, (2) political **arsenal**The police found a hidden **arsenal** of weapons in the suspect's house.

### background

n. the details of a person's social heritage, such as family, vocational or educational experience; past information that is essential to understanding a situation or problem

synonym: ground, experience, backdrop

(1) a **background** color, (2) a criminal **background**The company's hiring criteria emphasize personality, not a

### person's background.

#### soundtrack

n. the recorded audio that accompanies a movie, television program, or video game

synonym: score, background music, accompaniment

(1) **soundtrack** album, (2) a motion picture with a **soundtrack** 

The **soundtrack** to the movie was composed by a famous musician.

#### circus
