bomb

asset

develop

v. to grow or expand; to improve or refine through a process of progress and refinement, often to achieve greater sophistication or complexity; to elaborate or add detail to something that is in the process of being created

synonym

: evolve, progress, advance

(1) **develop** a strategy, (2) **develop** a skill

We must **develop** a new system to streamline our workflow and increase efficiency.

nuclear

adj. of or relating to or constituting the nucleus of an atom;
 deriving destructive energy from the release of atomic energy

synonym: atomic

(1) nuclear fusion, (2) use of nuclear power

Many countries have now agreed to a treaty banning the use of **nuclear** weapons.

uranium

a chemical element with the symbol U, atomic number
 92, that is a dense, silvery-white metal that is radioactive
 and is used as a fuel for nuclear power plants

synonym: U

The mining and processing of **uranium** can lead to releasing radioactive materials into the environment.

enrich

v. to make better or improve in quality by adding something else

synonym: enhance, improve, augment

facility

 a building or place that provides a particular service or is used for a particular industry

synonym: building, structure, installation

compromise

to settle a problem or disagreement by mutual concession

synonym: agree, settle, negotiate

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(1) **compromise** the matter, (2) cannot **compromise** anymore

They never **compromised** on development despite the lack of funds.

valve

 a device for controlling the flow of a fluid or gas through a pipe or duct by means of a movable part that opens, closes, or restricts the opening

synonym: tap, spigot, faucet

(1) electromagnetic valve, (2) valve control

The **valve** on the pipeline was leaking, so maintenance had to shut it off to make repairs.

centrifuge

n. a machine that uses centrifugal force (= a type of inertial force that appears to act on an object moving in a circular path and is directed away from the center) to separate substances of different densities, especially to separate liquids from solids

synonym: separator, extractor, spinner

- (1) **centrifuge** tube, (2) ultra-high-speed **centrifuges**The laboratory technician placed the blood samples in the **centrifuge** to separate the different components.
- a set of computer programs and associated documentation and data for doing particular computational jobs

synonym: program, system, operating system

- (1) **software** architect, (2) copyrighted **software**The company specializes in both hardware and **software**.
- a tiny infectious organic material that causes disease in people, animals, and plants

synonym: bacterium, germ, ailment

(1) spread of the **virus**, (2) a strain of **virus**An infected person in the hospital will likely pass the **virus** to others.

virus

maintenance

n. the act or process of keeping something, either artificial materials or living things, in good condition; the money needed for a person's or family's living expenses

synonym: care, perpetuation, support

(1) the **maintenance** of the car, (2) **maintenance** work We have decided to extend our **maintenance** contract until next year.

engineer

 a person whose job is designing, building, or maintaining something such as machines, structures, or software

synonym: architect, creator, builder

(1) a civil **engineer**, (2) **engineer** shortage

The **engineer** will repair my telephone tomorrow morning.

configure

v. to set up or arrange something in a particular way or for a specific purpose

synonym: arrange, set up, organize

- configure alarm notification, (2) configure options
 need to configure my computer's settings to connect to the internet.
- a secret plan or scheme to achieve a specific goal; the plan or main story of a literary work; (verb) to plan secretly, usually something illegal

synonym: scheme, plan, design

(1) plot twist, (2) plot a revolution

The **plot** of the novel centers around a group of friends who uncover a conspiracy to control the world's water supply.

payload

n. the amount of cargo or goods that a vehicle or equipment is designed to carry or transport; in computing, the amount of data that can be transmitted over a communication system

synonym: cargo, freight, shipment

(1) payload capacity, (2) satellite payload

The **payload** for the rocket launch included several satellites and scientific instruments.

plot

damage

v. to harm or cause injury to something or someone, often resulting in decreased value or functionality; to impair or negatively affect something, such as a reputation or relationship; (noun) harm or injury that is caused to a person, thing, or entity

synonym: harm, impair, injure

(1) **damage** a relationship, (2) **damage** assessment During the surgery, the doctor had to be extremely cautious not to **damage** a blood vessel.

delay

v. to cause something to happen at a later time than originally intended or expected

synonym: block, adjourn, detain

(1) **delay** a flight three hours, (2) **delay** the new project We **delayed** the payment because of an incorrect invoice.

accomplished

adj. having completed a task or achieved a goal successfully; skilled or proficient at somethingsynonym: achieved, finished, completed

(1) **accomplished** at a very early age, (2) **accomplished** goal

She felt accomplished after finishing her book.

complexity

 the state or quality of being complicated or intricate and difficult to understand

synonym: intricacy, sophistication, elaboration

vulnerable

adj. capable of being hurt or influenced physically or mentally

synonym: susceptible, exposed, weak

lab

 a workplace for the conduct of scientific research; a laboratory

synonym: workshop, laboratory, research chamber

(1) lab instrument, (2) medical lab

The Prime Minister will pay a courtesy visit to the Nobel laureate's **lab**.

infect

 to affect a person, an animal, or a plant with a disease-causing organism

synonym: pollute, contaminate, affect

(1) **infect** other animal species, (2) **infect** a computer with a virus

Children often **infect** parents with this head cold.

environment

 the natural world such as air, water, and land in which humans, animals, and plants live

synonym: atmosphere, surroundings, climate

environment affairs, (2) chaotic environment
 Every human is responsible for taking care of the Earth's environment.

sniff

v. to inhale audibly through the nose, often to detect or identify a smell; to draw in air through the nostrils with a quick, audible intake of breath

synonym: smell, inhale, scent

(1) **sniff** the air, (2) **sniff** the perfume

The dog stopped to **sniff** around the tree, looking for something interesting.

experiment

 the scientific test conducted to observe what happens and gain new knowledge

synonym: experimentation, investigation

flavor

the taste sensation produced by a substance in the mouth

synonym: taste, savor, essence

(1) a delicate **flavor**, (2) **flavor** enhancer

The **flavor** of the coffee was rich and full-bodied.

prowl

v. to move about stealthily, especially in search of prey or as part of a criminal act; to wander or roam around aimlessly or restlessly

synonym: creep, sneak, lurch

(1) **prowl** the streets, (2) **prowl** for food

The predator began to **prowl** around the forest's edge, searching for prey.

actively

adv. in a way that involves taking action or participating actively; with energy and determination

synonym: energetically, vigorously, diligently

(1) **actively** participate, (2) **actively** engage I am **actively** looking for a new job opportunity.

specific

adj. clearly defined or particular to a certain thing or situation; distinct, explicit, and precise

synonym: particular, definite, distinct

(1) **specific** instructions, (2) industry- **specific** regulations The scientist conducted a study that provided **specific** details about the species' behavior.

configuration

n. the arrangement or pattern of something or a group of related things

synonym: arrangement, composition, formatting

(1) **configuration** of the system, (2) engine **configuration**The **configuration** of molecules in steel changes significantly with temperature.

chemical

adj. relating to or connected with chemistry;

synonym: chemic, synthetic

(1) toxic chemicals, (2) a chemical compound

The firm has grown into a large **chemical** manufacturing.

extract

a short passage taken from a book, piece of music, etc.;
 a substance obtained from something through a specific process; (verb) to obtain from something or to remove something by effort or force

synonym: excerpt, quote, distillation

- v. to create a book, a list, a report, etc., by combining various objects, articles, music, etc.

digital

adj. processing or storing information as a succession of 1 and 0 to show that a signal is present or missing; relating to the use of computer technology, especially the internet

synonym: numerical, computerized, cyber

(1) a **digital** watch, (2) **digital** electronic signature

Sensors convert physical phenomena into **digital** signals.

professional

adj. having or showing the skill appropriate to a particular job; competent or skillful

synonym: skilled, competent, accomplished

(1) **professional** athlete, (2) certified **professional** secretary

He has a **professional** demeanor and always presents himself in a polished manner.

obvious

adj. easy to see, discover or understand synonym: apparent, conspicuous, evident

insider

- n. a person who has privileged access to special or secret information about a particular organization or field
- synonym: mole, privileged person

probable

adj. likely to happen or likely to be true synonym: likely, possible, potential

operator

 a person who uses and controls machinery or equipment; a mathematical symbol used to perform calculations

synonym: controller, handler, manipulator

(1) **operator** error, (2) an elevator **operator**The **operator** of the machine must follow strict safety protocols.

technological

adj. based on scientific and industrial progresssynonym: specialized, technical

(1) **technological** advancement, (2) **technological** policy **Technological** advances have disrupted many industries.

rocket

 a large tube-shaped object that moves very first by a stream of gases let out behind it, used for space travel or as a weapon

synonym: projectile, missile

- (1) **rocket** attack against the enemy, (2) **rocket** fuel The **rocket** launch platform is visible from this hill.
- a group of people who have been elected, especially one that meets regularly and makes decisions or laws for a specific region or country

synonym: crowd, gathering, mass

function

assembly

relate

disprove

hard-core

 a subgroup or subculture within a larger group or community that is characterized by a particularly intense, committed, or extreme set of practices, beliefs, or values

synonym: hard-line, purist, fanatic

sabotage

n. the deliberate and malicious damage, destruction, or disruption of equipment, machinery, or other property, often by someone with a particular agenda or motive; the subversion of an organization or institution by secret agents or spies

synonym: sabotage, subversion, destruction

locate

v. to specify or determine the exact position of someone or something

synonym: discover, find, place

infection

 a condition in which pathogenic microorganisms or viruses have entered the body

synonym: contagion, disease, transmission

(1) a bacterial **infection**, (2) treat the **infection** with antibiotics

Hospitals must meet various standards to prevent nosocomial **infections**.

fuel

a substance that is typically burned to generate heat or energy

synonym: energy, power, gas

(1) biomass fuel, (2) smokeless fuel

The **fuel** scarcity most severely impacted the manufacturing sector

assistant

someone who helps or supports someone else to do a iob

synonym: aide, helper, associate

an unwilling assistant, (2) assistant professor
 an executive assistant director administers each branch.

brain

n. the organ inside the head that is responsible for one's movement, thought, memory, and feeling

synonym: intellect, mind, encephalon

basic brain function, (2) permanent brain damage
 rays revealed a small tumor in his brain.

expertise

 specialized knowledge or skills in a particular field or subject; expert proficiency or knowledge

synonym: knowledge, skill, mastery

(1) marketing **expertise**, (2) demonstrate **expertise**The company's success can be attributed to the **expertise** of its employees.

associate

v. to mentally connect someone or something with someone or something else

synonym: tie in, link, consociate

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(1) **associate** alcohol with gambling, (2) **associate** with people widely

The majority of consumers associate this brand with quality.

warhead

n. the explosive or destructive part of a missile, rocket, or other weapons that are designed to explode on impact or detonation

synonym: payload, explosive

rot

v. to decay, or cause something to decay, naturally and gradually

synonym: perish, decay, corrode

moving

adj. causing strong emotions or feelings, especially sadness or sympathy

manipulate

v. to influence or control something or someone to your advantage, often in an unfair or dishonest way

crack

v. to break or cause to break without dividing into separate parts; (noun) a line on the surface of something along which it has separated without breaking

synonym: snap, burst, break

(1) crack an eggshell, (2) a crack in a board

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He that would eat the kernel must **crack** the nut.

eventually

adv. finally, particularly after a long time or a lot of struggle, complications, and so on

synonym: finally, someday, ultimately

(1) **eventually** become obsolete, (2) **eventually** succeed The corporation **eventually** dominated the entire tobacco business.

explode

v. to burst or break open violently and noisily; to cause something to burst or break open

synonym: detonate, blast, rupture

(1) **explode** in anger, (2) **explode** in popularity The old building **exploded** in a fiery inferno.

creepy

adj. causing an uneasy feeling of fear or unease synonym: eerie, unsettling, spooky

(1) feel creepy, (2) creepy atmosphere

crazy

adj. stupid or not sensible; very angry synonym: insane, absurd, bizarre

overlook

v. to fail to notice something; to watch over someone; to provide a view from above

synonym: disregard, look down, supervise

literature

 written works, such as novels, plays, poems, or short stories that are considered to have artistic or intellectual value

synonym: writing, prose, fiction

cascade

- n. a small waterfall or series of small waterfalls; a succession of stages or operations or processes or units
 synonym: waterfall, watercourse, step
- cascade connection, (2) transistor cascade

subdivision

a smaller part of something that is divided into such parts

synonym: part, section, branch

identical

confidence

labor

 productive work, especially physical work done for wages; the people who do manual or physical work in a country or company for wage; (verb) to work hard or to strive and make an effort to reach a goal

recover

- v. to return to a former condition, health, mind, or strength synonym: come back, convalesce, heal

aim

v. to try or plan to get or achieve something

spinning

n. the act of rotating rapidly around an axis; in the context of textiles, the process of twisting fibers together to form thread or yarn

synonym: whirling, rotating, spinning wheel

confident

adj. feeling sure about your abilities or qualities or having trust in people, plans, or the future

synonym: certain, sure, convinced

determinant

 a factor, circumstance, or condition that contributes to the shaping, influencing, or determining of a particular outcome or result

synonym: cause, factor, element

(1) environmental **determinant**, (2) a **determinant** of crop yields

One **determinant** of success is having a positive attitude and a strong work ethic.

intercept

v. to stop and catch someone or something to prevent them from continuing to a destination

synonym: ambush, block, prevent

sensor

 a device that receives a signal or stimulus such as heat, pressure, light, motion, etc. and responds to it in a specific manner

synonym: detector

(1) motion sensor lighting, (2) an image sensor
This automatic door could no longer be opened due to a sensor failure.

vibration

- n. a continuous quick and slight shaking movementsynonym: oscillation, fluctuation, reverberation
- (1) protection against **vibration**, (2) sympathetic **vibration Vibration** displaced part of the mechanism.

legitimate

adj. accordant with or allowed by law; lawful synonym: lawful, honest, fair

(1) a **legitimate** child, (2) **legitimate** question Public political demonstrations are considered **legitimate** rights for citizens.

fake

adj. not genuine; fraudulent or counterfeitsynonym: affected, bogus, counterfeit

heist

 a crime in which expensive items are illegally and frequently violently removed from a location or person

synonym:

robbery, theft, rip-off

(1) heist man, (2) jewel heist

Several airport security staff were involved in the **heist**.

observation

 the act or activity of carefully examining or monitoring something or someone

synonym: watching, notice, reflection

(1) class **observation** day, (2) **observation** instrument In the hospital, she will remain under constant **observation**.

aggressive

- adj. behaving in an angry, energetic, or threatening way towards another person; tending to spread quicklysynonym: assertive, combative, threatening
- (1) an **aggressive** war, (2) an **aggressive** tumor An **aggressive** tide wrecked the ship.

circumvent

v. to go around, avoid, or bypass something, often to achieve an intended goal or objective; to outmaneuver or outsmart a person or obstacle

synonym: evade, bypass, outsmart

(1) **circumvent** rules, (2) **circumvent** authority I took a back road to work on time to **circumvent** the traffic jam.

turbine

 a machine that rotates to generate power from fluids such as water or gas

synonym: engine, generator, power plant

(1) turbine energy, (2) turbine aerofoil

The wind **turbines** were spinning rapidly, generating clean energy for the nearby town.

relief

 a feeling of happiness and relaxation that comes when something burdensome is removed or reduced

synonym: remedy, consolation, alleviation

(1) tax relief, (2) sigh of relief

He devoted his life to establishing a humanitarian **relief** fund.

scare

- v. to frighten a person or animal, or to become frightened synonym: frighten, spook, intimidate
- (1) **scare** off her attacker by screaming, (2) **scare** the birds away

We hit the ground to **scare** out the rabbits.

generic

adj. not specific; not linked to a particular brand or product *synonym*: common, ordinary, typical

The **generic** aspirin brand was just as effective as the name brand but much cheaper.

specify

- v. to explain or state something clearly and exactly synonym: establish, pinpoint, identify
- (1) specify a cause, (2) specify an optionYou can specify the font color by clicking the Color tab.

automobile

- n. a road vehicle that has four wheels and is powered by an engine, used for transporting people or goodssynonym: car, vehicle, motorcar
- (1) driverless **automobile**, (2) **automobile** insurance The **automobile** industry is a major contributor to air pollution in cities.

stick

to put something, usually a sharp object, into something; to restrict yourself to doing or using one certain thing and not change; (noun) a thin piece of wood or other material

synonym: pierce, adhere, stay

(1) stick a key in a lock, (2) fire stick

You **stick** a bill in the change machine, and the coins pop out.

conventional

adj. based on or following traditional rules, standards, customs, etc.

synonym: ancestral, customary, established

(1) a **conventional** style, (2) get a **conventional** loan She is very **conventional** in her thoughts.

cyber

adj. relating to or involving computers, computer networks, or virtual reality

synonym: digital, computer, Internet

(1) cyber bullying, (2) cyber crime

Cyber espionage between countries can have serious consequences.

mass

 a large amount of a substance with no definite shape or form; a large number of people or things grouped or crowded together

synonym: abundance, crowd, mob

(1) a mass of molten rock, (2) critical mass

The **mass** of people who do not own property is politically impotent.

destruction

- n. the act of causing so much damage to somethingsynonym: devastation, annihilation, ruin
- (1) path of **destruction**, (2) cyclonic **destruction**The extinction of several subspecies has been linked to climate change and habitat **destruction**.

consequence

 the outcome of a particular action or event, especially relative to an individual

synonym: result, impact, outcome

(1) unintended **consequences**, (2) the **consequence** of an argument

These economic activities had disastrous environmental **consequences**.

unfortunately

adv. by bad luck; unluckily

synonym: regrettably, unluckily, alas

(1) **unfortunately** caught in a shower, (2) even more **unfortunately**

The treatments were done but, **unfortunately**, were unsuccessful.

statistics

- the discipline that concerns the collection, organization, analysis, interpretation, and presentation of data
- (1) statistics for cancer, (2) official statistics

The **statistics** demonstrate that poverty and unemployment are genuine problems.

assume

v. to think or accept something to be true without having proof of it; to take or begin to have power; to begin to exhibit a specific quality or appearance

synonym: guess, presume, suppose

(1) **assume** a lousy attitude to his boss, (2) **assume** an important role

The following example **assumes** that the capacity of each battery is the same.

entity

something that exists independently and has its own identity

synonym: body, object, existent

(1) legal entity, (2) government entity

A company is a distinct legal **entity**.

involve

v. to include or affect someone or something as a necessary part of something else

synonym: implicate, include, engage

(1) **involve** a lot of paperwork, (2) **involve** a high degree of risk

The investigation **involves** several government agencies and is expected to take several months.

superpower
