synonym: story, account, tale

# python

n. a nonvenomous snake found in Africa, Asia, and Australia, known for its ability to squeeze and suffocate its prey before swallowing it whole; a high-level programming language used for various purposes, often in scientific computing and data analysis

synonym: anaconda, boa, serpent

(1) python species, (2) Python programming

The African rock **python** can eat prey as large as antelopes and crocodiles.

#### sketch

 a simple, quickly-made picture that does not have many details; a short descriptive summary of something

synonym: drawing, outline, blueprint

(1) a penciled **sketch**, (2) first design **sketches** 

Yesterday, I created a rough **sketch** of the plan.

#### bet

v. to risk money on the result of an event or a competition, such as a race or game, to get more money; to have faith or confidence in something

synonym: stake, wager, gamble

(1) **bet** on a race, (2) **bet** my future

I **bet** that you know it.

# crystal

n. a solid material with many even sides that is formed naturally when the substance becomes solid and has a highly regular atomic structure; clear and colorless glass made of almost pure silica

synonym: quartz

(1) liquid **crystal**, (2) **crystal** analyses

A vast **crystal** chandelier glittered brightly above us.

#### accurate

adj. correct and exact in all details

synonym: exact, precise, proper

(1) provide **accurate** information, (2) **accurate** measurements

The official transcript contains accurate academic records.

# curiosity

- n. a strong desire to know or learn about somethingsynonym: interest, inquisitiveness, novelty
- (1) boundless **curiosity**, (2) satisfy my intellectual **curiosity** We are motivated by **curiosity** rather than necessity.

# nation

 a large organized community of people living in a particular country or region and having a particular culture

synonym: country, state, sovereign entity

(1) nation-state, (2) a seafaring nation

The **nation** of Japan is known for its unique culture and advanced technology.

#### prosecute

v. to bring legal action against someone in a court of law; to pursue or carry out something to completion or achievement

synonym: charge, sue, bring to trial

(1) prosecute criminal, (2) prosecute case

The attorney decided to **prosecute** the suspect for stealing from the store.

bin

- n. a container, usually that has a lid and used for wastesynonym: container, trunk, garbage can
- (1) a waste bin, (2) mail bin

You can open the overhead bin after landing.

laden

adj. heavily loaded or burdenedsynonym: loaded, weighed down, heavy

(1) a **laden** ship, (2) water- **laden** soil

The traffic- **laden** street was gridlocked during rush hour, with cars moving at a snail's pace.

anchor

a device, typically made of metal, that is used to moor a ship or boat in a particular place, typically by being dropped to the seabed; a central cohesive source of support and stability

synonym: mainstay, ballast, backbone

(1) anchor bolt, (2) anchor weight

The ship dropped anchor in the bay.

gaze

v. to stare at something or someone for an extended time, usually out of surprise or adoration, or because you are thinking about something else

synonym: stare, gawk, look

(1) **gaze** steadily at his face, (2) **gaze** absently out a window The youngster was **gazed** at by the beast.

#### demonstrate

v. to display something or give an exhibition to an interested audience

synonym: show, illustrate, display

(1) **demonstrate** a difference, (2) **demonstrate** mastery How can you **demonstrate** that the earth is a sphere?

# justice

 the quality of being fair and reasonable and treating people equally according to their due

synonym: fairness, equity, impartiality

(1) criminal justice, (2) justice of Heaven

The judge's ruling was based on the principles of **justice** and fairness.

#### claim

v. to assert that something is true; to demand or request something as one's own; to lay legal or moral right to something; (noun) a demand or assertion of a right or something that one believes to be true

synonym: assert, declare, maintain

(1) claim responsibility, (2) false claim

He wants to **claim** ownership of the abandoned property.

# inspire

 to make somebody fill with the desire, confidence, or enthusiasm, especially to do something creative

synonym: boost, encourage, enlighten

(1) **inspire** a feeling of curiosity, (2) **inspire** him to write a novel

The unique style of this martial arts **inspired** many action film producers.

#### institute

 an organization that has a specific purpose, particularly one dealing with science, education, or a particular profession; (verb) to initiate, introduce, or establish something

synonym: academy, university, college

(1) **institute** a lawsuit, (2) research **institutes** 

This region has many institutes offering higher education.

#### historic

adj. famous or significant in history, or potentially so synonym: memorable, momentous, historical

(1) **historic** accomplishment, (2) achieve the **historic** feat The Chinese people have accomplished several **historic** feats.

#### racial

adj. of or related to the race (= classification of humans into groups based on physical traits or social relations)synonym: ethnic, tribal, ethnical

(1) **racial** prejudice, (2) **racial** and ethnic backgrounds A minor **racial** conflict later led to a civil war.

# struggle

v. to make a great effort to do something when it is difficult, or there are a lot of problems; to use force or violence to break away from restraint or constriction

synonym: toil, strive, compete

(1) **struggle** against discrimination, (2) **struggle** to get the job

He could not **struggle** against temptation.

## troop

 a group of soldiers, especially a large one; a group of people, animals, or things considered as a unit.

synonym: group, unit, band

(1) the members of a military **troop**, (2) a **troop** of deer The **troop** of soldiers marched through the city in a parade.

union

n. a group of employees who have banded together to advocate for their rights and better their working conditions; the act or the state of joining together or being joined together

synonym: alliance, coalition, confederation

(1) bank and credit **unions**, (2) a craft **union**The trade **union** remained adamant about its demands.

#### nonviolence

n. the use of peaceful means, such as civil disobedience or passive resistance, rather than violence to achieve a goal, especially in the context of political or social

# change

synonym: pacifism, nonresistance, peacekeeping

(1) **nonviolence** movement, (2) **nonviolence** protest Martin Luther King Jr. was a champion of **nonviolence** in the fight for civil rights.

#### movement

 a group of people working together to achieve a shared goal, especially a political, social, or artistic one; the process of moving or being moved, physically or figuratively

synonym: motion, progression, action

(1) a circular **movement**, (2) **movement** of troops

The **movement** of the dancers on stage was graceful and elegant.

# analytical

 adj. relating to or using analysis (= the process of breaking down a complex system or concept into smaller, simpler parts to understand it better), or able to analyze

synonym: investigative, logical, cogent

(1) **analytical** approach, (2) **analytical** ability

He is **analytical** and can break down complex problems into manageable parts.

# perception

n. a belief, opinion, or image you have based on how you regard, understand, or interpret something; the ability to see, hear, or notice something through the senses

synonym: understanding, idea, awareness

(1) keen **perception**, (2) **perception** of a stimulus He is a man admired for the depth of his **perception**.

#### literally

adv. in the real or original meaning of a word or phrase; in a literal sense or way; not figuratively

synonym: actually, truly, verily

(1) translate literally, (2) bite his tongue literallyHe literally jumped out of his chair when he heard the news.

# refrigerator

 an appliance or device used for preserving and cooling food and beverages by maintaining a low temperature within a closed compartment

synonym: fridge, cooler, icebox

(1) **refrigerator** magnet, (2) empty **refrigerator**Don't forget to put the eggs in the **refrigerator** after you've used them.

#### steak

*n.* a thin slice of meat, typically beef, grilled or fried and served as a main dish

synonym: beef, chop, cutlet

(1) steak dinner, (2) salmon steak

He ordered a rare **steak** for dinner.

## military

 adj. relating to or characteristic of members of the armed forces; of or relating to war or warfare

synonym: armed, martial, warlike

(1) a military operation, (2) a military leader

The **military** academy was known for its strict discipline and training.

#### dictator

 a political leader who has complete power over a country, especially one who has obtained control by force

*synonym*: autocrat, tyrant, despot

(1) military **dictator**, (2) a **dictator** with enormous powers A popular uprising led to the overthrow of the **dictator**.

#### theocracy

 a form of government in which religious leaders or institutions hold the ultimate authority and religious laws are the basis of governance

synonym: ecclesiocracy, priest-dominated state

(1) Christian theocracy, (2) modern theocracy

The **theocracy** debate has taken center stage in many academic circles due to the rise of religious movements worldwide.

#### amaze

- v. to fill with wonder, surprise, or admiration synonym: astound, surprise, stagger
- (1) **amaze** and entertain visitors, (2) **amaze** everyone The magician's tricks **amazed** the audience.

#### secular

adj. not connected with religious or spiritual matters; worldly synonym: nonreligious, materialistic, temporal

(1) **secular** trends, (2) normal **secular** life
The school was founded as a **secular** institution with no religious affiliations.

## steppe

n. a vast, wide, and usually treeless plain, typically found in semi-arid or arid regions, characterized by fertile soil and grassy vegetation, often used for grazing livestock; an expansive and open grassland ecosystem found in Eurasia and North America

synonym: prairie, savannah, grassland

(1) steppe climate, (2) barren steppeThe nomadic tribes set up camp on the vast steppe.

# demographic

- a statistic characterizing that describes people or groups of people based on their age, sex, income, etc.
- (1) **demographic** analyses, (2) **demographic** policy Several **demographic** indicators correlate with care admission.

#### obsolete

adj. no longer in use or helpful because something newer or better has been invented and introduced

synonym: ancient, bygone, outdated

(1) an **obsolete** word, (2) become **obsolete** 

New technology has rendered my old smartphone obsolete.

# expire

v. to come to the end of the period of validity of a document, authorization, agreement, etc.

synonym: run out, terminate, cease

(1) expires next month, (2) it will expire

I forgot to renew my driver's license, and it **expired**.

#### awaken

- to stop sleeping or to cause someone to stop sleeping synonym: rouse, arouse, revive
- (1) awaken at daybreak, (2) awaken a child The friend's death awakens them.

#### generation

- all the people born and living at about the same time, regarded collectively; the production of heat or electricity synonym: cohort, age group, era
- (1) **generation** gap, (2) the **generation** of electricity The younger **generation** has different values and beliefs than the older one.

#### academic

- adj. associated with schools, colleges, and universities, especially studying and thinking, not with practical skills synonym: educational, scholarly, theoretical
- (1) academic probation, (2) an academic discussion An excellent historian must possess an **academic** mentality.

# profess

- to declare openly, often publicly or formally, that one has a particular skill, belief, or feeling; to admit or affirm synonym: declare, claim, confess
- (1) profess innocence, (2) profess law He **professes** his love for her every day, showering her with gifts and affection.

# regime

- the organization, a system, or method that is the governing authority of a political unit synonym: administration, establishment, government
- (1) a puppet regime, (2) exercise regime Totalitarian **regimes** are less likely to innovate because they deprive individuals of economic incentives.

# oppressive

- adj. treating people in a cruel and authoritarian way synonym: stifling, overwhelming, depressing
- (1) the atmosphere was **oppressive**, (2) **oppressive** governments

The political situation has become increasingly **oppressive**.

#### conflict

 a strong disagreement, argument, or a violent clash between two opposing groups or individuals

synonym: clash, discord, competition

(1) the **conflict** between good and evil, (2) the longstanding **conflict** 

He and I often had **conflicts**, not only in personality but also in ideology.

# unity

- the condition of being together or in agreementsynonym: accord, agreement, integrity
- (1) **unity** of authority, (2) cultural **unity**

Complete political unity is impossible to establish.

#### maintain

v. to continue to uphold or sustain; to keep in a particular state or condition; to assert or declare something to be true

*synonym*: preserve, uphold, sustain

(1) **maintain** order, (2) **maintain** good health I need to **maintain** my car regularly to prevent any major mechanical issues.

# discipline

 the practice of training people to obey rules or a code of behavior, using and punishments if these are broken; a region of activity, knowledge, or influence

synonym: training, restraint, field

(1) break **discipline**, (2) rigid **discipline**He quickly learned the military **discipline**.

unite

v. to come or join together as one; to combine or merge separate elements, individuals, or groups into a single entity or whole; to form a union or alliance

synonym: join, merge, connect

(1) **unite** our resources, (2) **unite** against a common enemy. The school's diversity club worked to **unite** students from all different backgrounds.

#### opposition

the act of disagreeing or resisting; the state of strong disagreement

synonym: resistance, hostility, antagonism

(1) **opposition** campaign, (2) meet with **opposition** The **opposition** party strongly disagreed with the government's proposed legislation.

ego

- n. a consciousness of your own identity; a person's sense of self-esteem or self-importance, especially inflated one
   synonym: self-esteem, personality, psyche
- (1) **ego** defense mechanisms, (2) national **ego**She was constantly trying to boost her **ego** by talking about her accomplishments.

#### candidate

- a person who is seeking or being considered for some kind of position, title, honor, or award; a job applicant
   synonym: applicant, nominee, contender
- (1) **candidate** selection, (2) PhD **candidate**The **candidate's** platform focused on healthcare reform and reducing income inequality.

#### defeat

- v. to win against somebody in a fight, war, or attempt synonym: conquer, beat, overpower
- (1) **defeat** a global power, (2) **defeat** body odor Despite his best efforts, he was unable to **defeat** the enemy.

rid

v. to make someone or something free of unwanted or unpleasant tasks, objects, or person

synonym: do away with, free, clear

(1) get **rid** of the rats, (2) **rid** the body of waste products We must **rid** ourselves of pollution.

#### individual

- n. a single person or thing, as distinct from a group synonym: person, being, self
- (1) a private **individual**, (2) **individual** freedom

  As an **individual**, he had the right to make his own decisions

and live his life as he saw fit.

# symbol

something visible that is used to represent something else

synonym: mark, character, insignia

(1) **symbol** color, (2) **symbol** for happiness The dragon is considered a **symbol** of bravery.

#### counter-example

 an example that contradicts or disproves a given statement, theory, or hypothesis

synonym: counterinstance, counterproof, counterargument

(1) mathematical **counter-example**, (2) logical **counter-example** 

The philosopher provided a **counter-example** to challenge the argument.

## president

 the leader of a republic, for example, the US; the person in charge of the organization such as a company, university, club, etc.

synonym: leader, CEO, chairperson

president emeritus, (2) vice- president for finance
 The club president does not have absolute power.

#### outcome

n. the result or effect of an action, event, etc.

synonym: result, consequence, effect

(1) improved student **outcomes**, (2) a desirable **outcome** They awaited news of the **outcome** of the election.

#### achieve

 to successfully complete a task or goal, often through hard work, perseverance, and dedication; to attain or accomplish something that one has set out to do

synonym: accomplish, attain, reach

(1) achieve success, (2) achieve milestonesI will work hard to achieve my goals and realize my dreams.

# spontaneous

adj. happening or being done naturally, often unexpected way, without being made to happen

synonym: willing, impulsive, intuitive

(1) a **spontaneous** behavior, (2) **spontaneous** labor The crowd broke out into **spontaneous** laughter.

#### revolution

a large-scale attempt to overthrow the government of a country, often using violence or war;

synonym: coup, innovation, rebellion

(1) beginning of the industrial **revolution**, (2) a political **revolution** 

The **revolution** by the citizen resulted in a redistribution of wealth.

row

- n. an arrangement of objects or people side by side in a line; (verb) to propel a boat through the water using oarssynonym: line, sequence, layer
- (1) criminal on death **row**, (2) a **row** of cherry trees He was the leader of the demonstrators and spoke out against the war in the front **row**.

#### fraternity

 a group of people, especially men, who are associated with each other through a common interest or occupation

synonym: brotherhood, association, society

(1) the medical **fraternity**, (2) **fraternity** party My college students join a **fraternity** to make connections and build a sense of community.

#### probable

*adj.* likely to happen or likely to be true *synonym*: likely, possible, potential

(1) **probable** outcome, (2) **probable** cause of a fire It seems **probable** that he has forgotten our scheduled meeting.

#### exclusive

adj. not divided or shared with others synonym: sole, deluxe, limited

(1) exclusive authority, (2) exclusive clubs

The condo offers **exclusive** access to the beach.

#### march

v. to walk militarily with stiff, regular steps

synonym: parade

(1) march against the war, (2) march east

The troops **marched** shoulder-to-shoulder.

#### idiot

 a foolish or stupid person who lacks common sense or judgment; a derogatory term used to describe someone who is mentally deficient

synonym: dummy, imbecile, bubblehead

(1) idiot driver, (2) what an idiot

He acted like an **idiot** and spilled his drink all over the floor.

# agent

 a person who represents and negotiates on behalf of someone else, such as a literary agent or talent agent; (of chemistry and medicine) a substance that brings about a chemical or physical effect; (of computer science) a piece of software that performs a task autonomously

synonym: representative, delegate, envoy

(1) agent system, (2) antidiarrheal agent

The FBI **agent** went undercover to infiltrate the criminal organization.

# provocateur

 a person who deliberately behaves in a way to provoke or challenge others, often to incite strong reactions or controversy

synonym: inciter, agitator, instigator

(1) political **provocateur**, (2) social media **provocateur** The movie director is considered a **provocateur** for his controversial films that often address taboo subjects.

#### violent

adj. involving or caused by physical force or aggression against someone or something

synonym: aggressive, intense, turbulent

(1) victim of a violent crime, (2) violent incident

The protesters became **violent** when the police tried to disperse them.

# destroy

 to ruin or damage severely or completely; to eradicate or eliminate completely

synonym: demolish, ruin, obliterate

(1) destroy the ecosystem, (2) destroyed evidence

The building was **destroyed** in the fire and had to be rebuilt.

# strategy

 a detailed plan of action designed to achieve a long-term or overall goal.

synonym: approach, procedure, scenario

(1) military strategy, (2) develop a strategy

Our plan includes a comprehensive marketing **strategy**.

#### tactics

 the methods or strategies used to achieve a specific goal or outcome, particularly in the context of military, business, or sports

synonym: strategy, maneuvers, plan

(1) blitz tactics, (2) political tactics

The marketing team developed new tactics to boost sales.

# organ

 a part of the body of an animal or plant that has a particular purpose and performs a specific job

synonym: function, structure

(1) organ bleeding, (2) damage to internal organs

These infections have the potential to impact practically every **organ** system.

#### spray

 a fine mist of liquid that is dispersed into the air; flower arrangement consisting of a single branch or shoot bearing flowers and foliage

synonym: mist, aerosol, atomizer

(1) a **spray** of mist, (2) an insect **spray** 

The artist used a **spray** paint can to create a graffiti mural on the wall.

#### graffiti

writing or drawings scribbled, scratched, or sprayed illicitly on a wall or other surface in a public place

synonym: street art, tagging, vandalism

(1) graffiti art, (2) graffiti tag

The city spent a lot of money cleaning up the graffiti on the buildings downtown.

#### accommodate

to provide someone with a place to live or to be stored in; to make fit for or to change to suit a new purpose *synonym*: house, rent, adjust

(1) accommodate a person with money, (2) accommodate these needs

This large SUV **accommodates** eight people.

#### disperse

to spread out or distribute over a broad region, or to cause something to do so

synonym: dissipate, spread, scatter

(1) **disperse** false information, (2) **disperse** the protesters Before authorities **dispersed** the protesters, they yelled slogans.

# oppress

to treat people in a cruel and authoritarian way, especially by denying them the same freedoms, rights, etc. as other people

synonym: antagonize, distress, burden

- (1) **oppress** the minority, (2) **oppress** the people with force Historically, many countries have often oppressed certain religions to gain the support of the majority of the population.
- the ability to say or write things or ideas in a clever and humorous way

*synonym*: humor, comedy, funniness

(1) the wit of man, (2) full of wit

He has the **wit** to keep talking about this topic.

#### communal

adj. belonging to or used by a group rather than individuals; for common use

wit

synonym: collaborative, combined, collective

(1) **communal** swimming pool, (2) **communal** combination of funds

**Communal** elections were held in several European countries.

# constantly

adv. all the time

synonym: continuously, always, frequently

(1) a **constantly** innovative enterprise, (2) a **constantly** varying mind

The mobile application industry is **constantly** changing.

# frightening

*adj.* causing fear or alarm, or very surprising and alarming *synonym*: scary, terrifying, alarming

(1) cast **frightening** eyes, (2) **frightening** experience The news of the pandemic was a **frightening** reminder of the fragility of human health.

#### overtake

v. to catch up to and pass by someone or something that is in front of you, usually about moving vehicles; to come to a point where you become more successful, important, or influential than someone or something else

synonym: surpass, outstrip, catch up with

(1) **overtake** a rival, (2) **overtake** a milestone

The race car driver knew he had to **overtake** the other drivers to win the race.

# **Christ**

 the man that Christians believe is the prophet and the son of God, and whose life and sermons form the basis for Christianity

synonym: Savior, Jesus Christ, Jesus

(1) teaching of Christ, (2) before Christ

Christmas is the day to celebrate the birth of Christ.

# pray

v. to make a request or petition to a higher power, especially in the form of a respectful or humble request synonym: implore, supplicate, entreat

(1) **pray** devoutly, (2) **pray** for rain

She closed her eyes and **prayed** for strength to overcome difficult times.

#### cheer

- v. to give a loud shout to show support, praise, or approval synonym: comfort, encourage, hearten
- (1) **cheer** for the home team, (2) **cheer** me up Supporters in the stands **cheered** at every goal.

## security

n. the state of being free from danger, risk, or harm; measures taken to protect against threats or attacks; a financial asset, such as a stock or bond that derives value exclusively from the ownership interest or claim to a particular underlying asset or obligation

*synonym*: safety, protection, stock

(1) national **security**, (2) **security** analyst

The building's **security** system includes cameras, alarms, and security guards.

# dynamic

adj. having a lot of energy, ideas, and enthusiasm, and a strong personality; of or relating to dynamics (= the branch of physics and engineering concerned with the forces that cause motions of bodies)

synonym: energetic, active, vital

(1) a **dynamic** market, (2) **dynamic** person

The sprinter has a dynamic way of running.

# analyst

 someone whose job is to examine something to learn or understand more about it

synonym: reviewer, investigator, judge

(1) banking analyst, (2) senior research analyst

The **analyst** concluded that bankruptcy was inevitable.

## normally

adv. usually; under normal conditions synonym: commonly, generally, naturally

(1) complete **normally**, (2) not **normally** drink much I don't **normally** take a vacation in the middle of summer.

## apathy

n. lack of emotion, concern, or enthusiasmsynonym: affectlessness, dispassion, indifference

(1) apathy in the election, (2) political apathy

The global economic crisis has led to pervasive **apathy** and powerlessness.

#### enthusiasm

 a strong feeling of excitement and interest in a particular subject or cause and an eagerness to become involved in it

synonym: eagerness, zeal, willingness

(1) unflagging **enthusiasm**, (2) lose **enthusiasm**We are tackling the development for updates with **enthusiasm**.

#### humor

 the quality of being amusing or funny; the liquid parts of the body

synonym: comedy, funniness, liquid substance

sardonic humor,
 vitreous humor
 wife seems to be in ill humor.

quo

*n*. the existing state or condition of something, especially in relation to a particular situation or issue

synonym: status, condition, state

(1) status **quo** politician, (2) **quo** warranto

The company has been successful in maintaining the status **quo**.

melt

v. to turn from something solid into something soft or liquid as a result of heating

synonym: disintegrate, soften, disappear

(1) melt the ice, (2) melt down gold

Her resistance **melted** under his persuasion.

crazy

adj. stupid or not sensible; very angry

*synonym*: insane, absurd, bizarre

(1) **crazy** about cars and racing, (2) a **crazy** scheme

The rain and thunder are **crazy** today.

stud

n. a small object with a head on one end and a sharp point on the other, used for fastening clothing, leather, or other materials; an animal used for breeding, typically a male horse or bull that is of superior breeding stock; (verb) to decorate or adorn with studs; to provide with studs for support

synonym: beam, scantling, framing

(1) horse stud, (2) wall stud

He bought a new **stud** to attach the strap to his watch.

skit

 a short, often humorous performative piece or act, typically performed in a comic or satirical tone or style, as part of a variety show or a theatrical or musical performance

synonym: sketch, parody, routine

(1) comedy skit, (2) political skit

The comedy group performed a hilarious **skit** about life in quarantine.

petrol

 a flammable liquid made from petroleum that is used as a fuel in internal combustion engines, commonly known as gasoline in North America

synonym: gasoline, fuel, gas

(1) **petrol** station, (2) **petrol** engine

I must fill my car with **petrol** before going on a long road trip.
