#### pervasive

adj. spreading or existing throughout every part of a thing or place

*synonym*: extensive, ubiquitous, prevalent

- a measure of the rate at which an engine or motor rotates, often expressed in revolutions per minute (RPM); (verb) to increase the number of rotations per minute

synonym: revolution, RPM, speed

- a loud, crackling noise made by something being crushed or broken; a difficult or critical situation synonym: crushing, snapping, crisis
- (1) financial crunch, (2) a gas crunch The **crunch** of the leaves underfoot was heard as they walked through the park.

#### numb

adj. unable to feel physical sensation and movement; not showing human feeling or sensitivity

synonym: dazed, insensitive, emotionless

(1) **numb** with cold, (2) a **numb** mind My left arm became **numb**.
