 a cereal plant that is the most important kind grown in temperate countries, the grain of which is ground to make flour for bread, pasta, pastry, etc

blond

adj. of a light, yellowish-brown or golden color, typically describing hair color; (also spelled "blonde") a female with such hair color

synonym: blonde, light-haired

illusion

 a false idea or belief, especially about somebody or about a situation

dominant

adj. more important, influential, or easy to notice than anything else of the same type

passionate

childhood

 the mass of air that surrounds the Earth; the pervading tone or mood of a place, situation, or creative work

confess

v. to admit to having done something wrong or to reveal something personal or private

savage

adj. extremely wild, ferocious, or uncivilized

repeatedly

adv. again and again; many times

synonym: frequently, over and over, constantly

physically

adv. in a way related to a person's body or appearance rather than their mind

stepfather

 a man who is married to one's mother but is not one's biological father

synonym: stepdad, father figure, dad-in-law

grade

n. a particular level of quality, size, importance, etc.

synonym: score, rate, degree

rebuild

v. to build again or anew

synonym: reconstruct, renovate, restore

degree

adore

dictate

charm

- the power or quality of pleasing or fascinating people synonym: allure, appeal, beauty

to physically or socially separate someone or something from other people or things

synonym: separate, sequester, insulate

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hint

scream

v. to give a loud, high shout suddenly, especially because of fear, anger, excitement, etc.; to utter or declare in a very loud voice

coworker

 a person who works with another in the same company or organization

bruise

 a mark caused by a blow, typically one that is purple or black on the skin

synonym: contusion, injury, wound

quitter

 a person who gives up easily or does not have the determination to finish what they have started

synonym: coward, deserter, surrender

halfway.

(1) easy quitter, (2) serial quitterHe was labeled as a quitter after he abandoned the project

dysfunction

 a problem or fault in a system, organism, or part of the body or machine

synonym: malfunction, disorder, disfunction

(1) **dysfunction** of kidneys, (2) brain **dysfunction**The **dysfunction** in the relationship was causing problems for both partners.

sacrifice

n. the act of killing an animal or person or surrendering a possession as an offering to a deity; (verb) to give up something important or valuable to help another person or get or do something that seems more important

synonym: forfeit, immolation, gift

(1) small **sacrifice** for a great cause, (2) **sacrifice** anything to get ahead

You cannot accomplish great things without a **sacrifice** of your time or money.

headfirst

adv. with the head leading or going first or in front of the rest of the body while moving forward; in a daring, impulsive, or reckless manner without proper caution or preparation

synonym: dive, plunge, recklessly

(1) jump headfirst, (2) dive headfirst

She dove **headfirst** into the ocean, eager to cool off from the summer heat.

introduction

n. a preliminary explanation or remarks given before the start of a text, performance, or event; the act of bringing something new into existence or introducing something to a wider audience or new market

synonym: initiation, preamble, prologue

(1) **introduction** education, (2) self- **introduction**The **introduction** to the new class was informative and engaging.

threat

 a strong indication or likelihood of harm, danger, or adverse consequences; an expression of intent to inflict harm or injury on someone or something, often made as a means of coercion or intimidation

synonym: menace, danger, hazard

(1) economic threat,	(2) environmental threat
The threat of severe	weather prompted the city to issue an
evacuation warning.	

react

- v. to take action in response to something synonym: respond, reply, oppose
- (1) **react** at a high temperature, (2) **react** against his way of thinking

suppose

- v. to think that something is likely to be actual or possible synonym: guess, assume, presume
- (1) **suppose** you're right, (2) **suppose** beforehand What do you **suppose** the culprit's motive was?

glove

 a piece of clothing worn on the hand and wrist for protection against cold, dirt, etc., with separate parts for each finger

synonym: mitt

(1) a right-hand **glove**, (2) 5-finger **glove**She was wearing a black **glove**.

compartment

a separate section or part of a larger enclosed space,
 such as a train carriage or a ship's cabin

synonym: section, part, subdivision

(1) **compartment** door, (2) a watertight **compartment** The train's **compartment** was small but comfortable.

trauma

 an emotional wound or shock often has long-lasting effects caused by a highly upsetting or shocking experience

synonym: agony, injury, ordeal

(1) psychic trauma, (2) trauma care

Many civilians have suffered trauma as a result of the war.

grave

 a place where a dead body is buried, typically marked by a headstone or other memorial; a very serious, solemn, or important matter; (verb) to carve, cut, or etch a design, inscription, or mark onto a hard surface, such as stone or metal; (adjective) serious, solemn, or weighty in nature

synonym: tomb, crypt, sepulcher

(1) **grave** an image, (2) **grave** mistake

Many innocent civilians were killed and buried in mass **graves** outside the city during the war.

gown

 a long, flowing garment worn on formal occasions, especially by women

synonym: dress, robe, garment

freelance

- adj. doing particular pieces of work for different organizations rather than being employed by one specific organizationsynonym: self-employed, independent

writ

- n. a written legal order or commandsynonym: legal document, order, legal process

assignment

 a duty or task given to someone, usually as part of their job or studies

synonym: task, duty, designation

frustrate

v. to hinder or prevent efforts, plans, or desires from doing, succeeding, or being fulfilled; to make someone feel upset or annoyed because they are unable to change or achieve something

synonym: hinder, thwart, dishearten

(1) **frustrate** the advancement, (2) **frustrate** other team members

The coach explained a strategy to **frustrate** the opponent's schemes to the players.

excuse

 a reason or explanation, either true or invented, given to justify a fault or defend your behavior; (verb) to make someone free from blame or clear from guilt

synonym: apology, justification, reason

(1) **excuse** for inaction, (2) perfect **excuse**He quickly fabricated an **excuse** for not attending the meeting.

squeeze

v. to apply pressure from two or more sides; to hold someone or something tightly in your arms, usually with fondness

synonym: compress, crush, clamp

(1) **squeeze** a lemon, (2) **squeeze** a confession She **squeezed** the toothpaste tube from the middle to get the last bit out.

tight

adj. fixed, fastened, or kept together firmly or closely *synonym*: closed, secured, cramped

a tight game, (2) student on a tight budget
 The national election was held amid tight security.

chokehold

 a wrestling or martial arts hold in which the arms are used to exert pressure on an opponent's neck, cutting off their air supply and temporarily incapacitating them

synonym: stranglehold, grip, lock

chokehold technique, (2) police chokehold
 The wrestler put his opponent in a chokehold and won the

match.

fade

- v. to vanish; to fade away; to lose color; to lose freshness synonym: languish, wither
- (1) **fade** away almost completely, (2) **fade** in importance My memory will **fade**, but my heart will live on.

incident

an event or occurrence, often unexpected or unplanned;
 something that happens

synonym: event, occurrence, accident

(1) traffic incident, (2) security incidentThe incident at the airport caused a delay in my flight.

honeymoon

n. a period of time, often a few weeks, immediately following a wedding during which the newlywed couple goes on a vacation or trip together to celebrate their marriage and spend time together as a couple

synonym: post-wedding vacation, romantic getaway

punch

v. to strike someone or something with one's fist; to make a hole in something

proceed

v. to move forward or to continue with a process or action; to advance or progress

unique

stalk

v. to follow or track someone or something closely and quietly, usually to cause harm or surveillance; to move slowly and quietly to avoid detection; (noun) the main stem of a plant that supports leaves, flowers, and fruit; the stem or main axis of a support structure or framework

synonym: follow, creep up on, (noun) stem

ignition

- n. the act of starting a fire, engine, or other device; the beginning or starting point of a process or eventsynonym: kindling, start, activation
- ignition system, (2) ignition switch

highway

a main road, especially one connecting major towns or cities

synonym: road, expressway, freeway

grind

v. to reduce something to small particles or powder by crushing or rubbing it; to work hard over a long period of

time

synonym: mill, crush, grate

batter

- v. to hit something or someone repeatedly with much force; (noun, baseball) a ballplayer who is battingsynonym: beat, pound, strike

demon

 an evil spirit, supernatural being or entity often depicted as malevolent or harmful

synonym: fiend, devil, evil spirit

incredibly

adv. in a way that is very difficult to believe; exceedingly or extremely

synonym: enormously, exceptionally, extraordinarily

murder

- n. the crime of killing somebody intentionally synonym: slaying, killing

outcome

n. the result or effect of an action, event, etc.

manipulate

v. to influence or control something or someone to your advantage, often in an unfair or dishonest way

synonym: control, exploit, abuse

(1) **manipulate** figures, (2) vulnerable to **manipulate** Please tell me how to **manipulate** this computer.

terrify

- v. to frighten someone very much synonym: unnerve, scare, horrify
- (1) **terrify** people, (2) the threats **terrify** him It would be best not to **terrify** your associates into doing complex tasks.

regularly
