analyst

swampland

 an informal talk between two or more people to exchange their views, ideas, information, etc.

glob

 a small, round mass or lump; a drop or blob of liquid or viscous substance

synonym: ball, lump, sphere

She squeezed a **glob** of toothpaste onto her toothbrush.

privilege

 a special right or advantage that only one person or group of people has, usually because they are rich and powerful in a society

synonym: benefit, authorization, advantage

(1) a breach of **privilege**, (2) **privilege** of membership In the Middle Ages, the right to hunt in the wild was the **privilege** of royalty and nobility.

paralyze

v. to cause a person or part of the body to become unable to move or feel

synonym: immobilize, disable, numb

The venom from the snake bite **paralyzed** his arm.

brilliant

adj. extremely clever, skilled, or impressive synonym: luminous, intelligent, clever

killing

n. the act of causing death; a sudden and intense force or effect that causes significant damage or destruction; a situation where someone is making a substantial amount of money or experiencing significant financial success

synonym: slaughter, homicide, assassination

The killing of unarmed civilians is considered a war crime.

surgery

medical treatment of injuries or diseases involving an incision with instruments and often removing or replacing some parts of the body; the branch of medical science that treats disease or injury by operative procedures

synonym: operation, (medical) procedure

(1) cardiac **surgery**, (2) the professor of **surgery** He had undergone heart **surgery** years before.

checklist

 a list of items, tasks, or points to be considered or acted upon, used as a reminder and to ensure that all necessary steps have been taken

synonym: inventory, list, roll call

folk

 people in general, especially those of a particular group or type

synonym: community, family, person

(1) **folk** art, (2) the **folk** songs of a particular district Some seaweed was used as **folk** medicine in ancient times.

suture

n. a stitch or series of stitches used to hold together the edges of a wound or incision so that it can heal; a line of junction between two bones, particularly in the skull of an animal or human

synonym: stitch, seam

stitch

anemia

 a medical condition in which the body lacks enough red blood cells or hemoglobin, causing fatigue, weakness, or difficulty breathing; a lack of vitality or liveliness in something

The doctor diagnosed the patient with **anemia** due to a lack of iron in their blood.

unnecessary

applause

amazing

adj. extremely surprising, especially in a way that you like or admire

synonym: exceptional, extraordinary, wonderful

(1) **amazing** advances, (2) the most **amazing** feeling The golfer recorded an **amazing** distance.

miserable

adj. very unhappy, uncomfortable, or unpleasant; causing great distress or suffering

synonym: unhappy, wretched, cheerless

(1) **miserable** weather, (2) **miserable** experience She felt **miserable** after her dog passed away.

quotation

 a group of words taken from a text or speech and repeated by someone other than the original author or speaker

synonym: excerpt, passage, quote

(1) double **quotation** marks, (2) take a **quotation** He included a **quotation** from the book in his essay.

refer

v. to direct someone's attention, thoughts, or questions to another source or person; to mention, cite, or allude to something as evidence or support

synonym: cite, allude, mention

(1) refer to a book, (2) refer to a map

Please **refer** to the instruction manual for further assistance.

arena

 a large, flat area, often circular or oval-shaped, designed to showcase theatre, musical performances, or sporting events

synonym: stadium, theatre, auditorium

(1) indoor arena, (2) political arena

The company is planning to build a 20,000-seat **arena** with a retractable roof.

critic

 someone who expresses opinions about the quality of books, music, etc.

synonym: pundit, analyst, attacker

doer

a person who performs or carries out an action or task; a person who is proactive or productive

synonym: actor, performer, achiever

deed
