### slump

#### panic

 a sudden strong feeling of fear that cannot be controlled and prevents reasonable thought and action

#### sweep

#### chemical

adj. relating to or connected with chemistry;

synonym: chemic, synthetic

#### hormone

 a chemical substance made by organs that encourages or influences the development, growth, sex, etc., of an animal and is carried around the body in the blood

### oxygen

#### intern

#### brain

### hypothalamus

- a basal part of the brain that autonomically controls body temperature, hunger, and the release of hormones

#### controller

 a person or device that manages or regulates the operation of a system, equipment, or machine; a high-level position within an organization responsible for overseeing management, operations, and reporting

#### release

#### corticosteroid

### trigger

### pituitary

 a small, pea-sized gland located at the base of the brain that influences the growth and sexual development of the body by producing hormones

### pea

gland

### superhuman

#### feat

#### sebaceous
