to convert information or data into a code, thereby making it unreadable without a key or password; to conceal or obscure information in a way that makes it inaccessible to unauthorized persons

synonym: encode, cipher, scramble

(1) encrypt data, (2) encrypt message

To protect their sensitive information, many businesses **encrypt** their files.

decode

 to convert something, such as a message or piece of information, from a specific form into one that you can understand

synonym: decipher, translate, interpret

(1) **decode** a message, (2) ability to **decode** the differences The software could **decode** the encrypted data and reveal the hidden information.
