## flatline

- v.* to experience a cessation of electrical activity in the heart or other vital organs, leading to a loss of function and potential death; to cease or level off (as in an economic trend or another line graph) at a low or bottomed-out point

*synonym*: die, expire, pass away

(1) **flatline** over the past few quarters, (2) before the patient's heart **flatline**

The patient's heart rate suddenly **flatlined**, requiring immediate resuscitation.

## dorm

- n.* a residence hall or building that provides living quarters for students or other occupants, typically on a college or university campus

*synonym*: residence hall, hostel, boarding house

(1) **dorm** room, (2) university **dorm**

Living in a **dorm** can be a great way to meet new people when you're in college.

## crowdsourcing

- n.* the practice of obtaining needed services, ideas, or content by enlisting the services of a large number of people, either paid or unpaid, typically via the internet

The company used this **crowdsourcing** platform to gather ideas for its next product.

## kite

*synonym* : irrelevant, unnecessary, unrelated

The **extraneous** information in the report made it difficult to understand the main points.

## inflow

*n.* a stream or movement of something, typically liquid or gas, that is flowing into a particular place or system; the amount of incoming resources or funds into a system or organization

*synonym* : influx, incursion, income

(1) river **inflow**, (2) **inflow** of refugees

The **inflow** of cash from investors helped the startup company grow and expand.

## secondly

*synonym* : in the second place, next, subsequently
