liturgy

a form of public worship or religious service, especially in the Christian Church

sand

n. finely granulated particles of rock or mineral material typically found along beaches, deserts, or riverbeds; used in construction, landscaping, and other applications requiring drainage or abrasive action

synonym: grit, dust, powder

(1) sand dunes, (2) sand castle

The **sand** on the beach was warm and golden.

infrared

adj. relating to or denoting electromagnetic radiation with a wavelength just longer than that of red light but shorter than that of microwave radiation, used for sensing heat and for remote control

synonym: thermal, warm, radiant

invisible

X-ray

 a type of electromagnetic radiation that has a wavelength shorter than visible light allowing hidden objects such as bones and organs inside the body to be photographed

synonym: roentgenogram, photon radiography

The doctor ordered an **X-ray** to see if there was any damage to the bones.

fluorescence

n. the property of certain substances to absorb light at one wavelength and emit light at a longer wavelength, often producing a visible glow or color change; the visible light or color change resulting from this process

electron

 hard outer covering or case of eggs, nuts, some seeds, and some animals

atom

 n. the smallest unit of ordinary matter that forms a chemical element, composed of a nucleus and one or more electrons bound to the nucleus

chemical characteristics.

shed

 the energy that comes from a nuclear reaction in the form of rays, waves, or particles and that can be hazardous to health

synonym: dissemination, emission, irradiation

(1) exposure to **radiation**, (2) electromagnetic **radiation**He tried every possible treatment, including chemotherapy and **radiation** therapy.

specific

adj. clearly defined or particular to a certain thing or situation; distinct, explicit, and precise

synonym: particular, definite, distinct

(1) **specific** instructions, (2) industry- **specific** regulations The scientist conducted a study that provided **specific** details about the species' behavior.

wavelength

- the distance between two points in the same phase in consecutive cycles of a wave
- (1) wavelength of light, (2) long- wavelength laser White color is made up of many different wavelengths of

light.

theoretical

 adj. relating to the concepts and principles upon which a particular topic is founded, rather than practice and experience

synonym: conceptual, conjectural, ideal

(1) **theoretical** models, (2) **theoretical** physicist Absolute zero is the lowest **theoretical** temperature.

synchrotron

 a large and powerful particle accelerator that produces highly intense beams of light or other particles, often used in scientific research, particularly in physics and chemistry

synonym: particle accelerator, atom smasher

(1) **synchrotron** radiation, (2) **synchrotron** facility Scientists use a high-energy **synchrotron** to accelerate particles for research purposes.

laboratory

 a workplace for doing scientific research or teaching science; a lab

synonym: lab, workshop, testing room

(1) **laboratory** accident, (2) anthropology **laboratory**Animal protection groups call for an end to animal testing in a **laboratory**.

accelerate

v. to make something faster or earlier; to cause to develop or progress more quickly

synonym: speed up, quicken, rev

positron

 an antiparticle of the electron with a positive charge that has the same mass as the electron but an opposite charge

atomic

adj. of or relating to atom (= the smallest component of an element)

synonym: tiny, microscopic, nuclear

charm

- n. the power or quality of pleasing or fascinating peoplesynonym: allure, appeal, beauty

quark

- n. a type of elementary particle and a fundamental constituent of matter that make up the heavier elementary particles, such as protons, neutrons, etc.; fresh unripened cheese of a smooth texture made from pasteurized milk, a starter, and rennet

 The Big Bang theory states that quark-gluon plasma filled the entire universe before matter as we know it was created.

tau

- the 19th letter of the Greek alphabet, transliterated as "t"; (of physics, tau particle) a fundamental particle known as the tau lepton that is an elementary particle with a negative electric charge and a spin of 1/2
- (1) **tau** particle, (2) the symbol of **tau**The **tau** protein has been found to play a role in the development of Alzheimer's disease and other neurological disorders.

lepton

 a subatomic particle that is one of the basic building blocks of matter, having little or no mass and carrying an electrical charge

synonym: subatomic particle, quark

(1) **lepton** particle, (2) charged **lepton**

The discovery of the muon **lepton** helped to confirm the existence of the weak nuclear force.

beam

 a long, sturdy piece of timber, metal, or other material used to support a structure or span a distance; a ray or stream of light emitted by a source

synonym: ray, ray of light, shaft of light

The sun's **beam** shone through the window and illuminated the room.

solar

adj. of, from, or relating to the sun
