despair

confidence

- the feeling or attitude that one can trust or rely on the abilities or good qualities of someone or something

 to accomplish or achieve a desired or intended result or goal; to prosper or attain success in a given field or endeavor

hubris

 excessive pride, arrogance, or overconfidence, often leading to someone's downfall or ruin

overconfidence

develop

plunge

v. to dive quickly and steeply downward; to thrust or throw into something; (noun) a steep and rapid fall

humiliate

v. to cause someone to feel ashamed, embarrassed, or degraded, especially in public or through revealing personal information

acknowledge

mullah

insurgent

politician
