#### medical

#### surgery

#### bottleneck

n. a narrow or busy section of road or a junction where the traffic often gets slower and stops; anything that slows down development or progress, especially in business or industry

#### anesthesia

- a state of controlled, temporary loss of bodily sensation or awareness that is induced for medical purposes

#### environment

 the natural world such as air, water, and land in which humans, animals, and plants live

synonym: atmosphere, surroundings, climate

(1) **environment** affairs, (2) chaotic **environment**Every human is responsible for taking care of the Earth's **environment**.

#### operate

- v. to work in a particular way; to supervise somethingsynonym: work, use, employ
- (1) **operate** 24 hours a day, (2) manually **operate** a machine

### develop

v. to grow or expand; to improve or refine through a process of progress and refinement, often to achieve greater sophistication or complexity; to elaborate or add detail to something that is in the process of being created

synonym: evolve, progress, advance

(1) **develop** a strategy, (2) **develop** a skill

We must **develop** a new system to streamline our workflow and increase efficiency.

### background

n. the details of a person's social heritage, such as family, vocational or educational experience; past information that is essential to understanding a situation or problem

synonym: ground, experience, backdrop

(1) a **background** color, (2) a criminal **background**The company's hiring criteria emphasize personality, not a person's **background**.

### sophisticated

adj. having a great deal of worldly experience and knowledge of people's behavior, culture, and fashionsynonym: refined, cultured, worldly

(1) **sophisticated** look, (2) a **sophisticated** lifestyle Marketing strategies are growing more **sophisticated**.

#### extreme

adj. very great in amount or degreesynonym: farthermost, outermost, fierce

extreme sports, (2) extreme weather events
 Solar gravity creates extreme pressures and temperatures.

### anesthesiologist

n. a medical doctor who specializes in administering anesthesia to help control pain and monitor the vital signs of patients during procedures and surgeries
 synonym: anesthetist, pain specialist, sedationist

(1) specialized anesthesiologist, (2) clinical anesthesiologist

The experienced **anesthesiologist** monitored the patient's vital signs throughout the procedure.

### complexity

 the state or quality of being complicated or intricate and difficult to understand

synonym: intricacy, sophistication, elaboration

(1) cognitive **complexity**, (2) **complexity** theory

The project's **complexity** made it difficult for the team to complete it on time.

#### monitor

v. to observe, check, and track the progress or quality of something over a period of time

synonym: proctor, check, observe

### patient

 a person who is receiving medical treatment, care, or attention from a healthcare professional, such as a doctor, nurse, or therapist; a personal quality or characteristic

#### anesthetize

 to administer a drug or other substance that causes a loss of sensation or consciousness, often to perform a medical procedure; to numb or dull a physical or emotional sensation

synonym: numb, sedate, drug

(1) **anesthetize** a patient, (2) **anesthetize** a wound The dentist will **anesthetize** your mouth before removing your wisdom teeth.

#### delicate

adj. very fine, subtle, and pleasing; easily broken or damaged or destroyed

*synonym*: dainty, exquisite, fragile

The fresh green trees cast a **delicate** web of shadows over the lawn.

### algorithm

- n. a set of rules or rigorous instructions typically used to solve a specific problem or to perform a computationsynonym: logic, method, rule

#### biomedical

 adj. relating to the application of the natural sciences, especially biology, and physiology, to clinical medicine and healthcare

synonym: medical, clinical, health-related

(1) **biomedical** assay, (2) cutting-edge **biomedical Biomedical** engineering focuses on developing new medical technologies and innovations to improve patient health outcomes.

### engineer

 a person whose job is designing, building, or maintaining something such as machines, structures, or software

synonym: architect, creator, builder

The **engineer** will repair my telephone tomorrow morning.

### upward

 adv. toward the top or highest point, or a higher position or level; (adjective) extending or moving toward a higher place

#### obvious

adj. easy to see, discover or understandsynonym: apparent, conspicuous, evident

#### concept

- n. an idea or principle associated with something abstractsynonym: idea, notion, vision
- learn new concepts, (2) concept car

#### illustrate

v. to provide pictures, photographs, diagrams, etc. in a book or something for explanation

synonym: demonstrate, explain, exemplify

#### infrastructure

 the basic systems, services, or features that are necessary for an organization or country, such as transport and power supplies

synonym: foundation, framework

### supple

adj. flexible and easy to bend or move; gracefully agile; adaptable or responsive to change or new ideas

### interrupt

v. to say or do something that causes someone to stop in their speech or action

### electrify

v. to make a machine or system work by using electricity; to make someone extremely enthusiastic about or interested in something

synonym: wire, amaze, astonish

The product developed through years of research continues to **electrify** the market.

### compress

v. to press or squeeze together to make something take up less space

synonym: condense, constrict, squeeze

She **compressed** the files into a single ZIP archive to save space on her computer.

### oxygen

critic

- n. the chemical element with the symbol O that is present in air and water and is necessary for people, animals, and plants to live

- *n.* someone who expresses opinions about the quality of books, music, etc.

synonym: pundit, analyst, attacker

#### **function**

n. the purpose or use of an object, system, or process; a particular activity or operation that is designed to serve a specific purpose; a mathematical concept that describes a relationship between two sets of values, called the input and output sets; (verb) to operate or work in a specific way, or to perform a particular task or purpose

synonym: purpose, mapping, job

(1) function properly, (2) immune function

The brain is an incredibly complex organ that controls the body's **function**.

#### electrical

adj. relating to electricity

(1) an **electrical** storm, (2) degree in **electrical** engineering Actuators convert **electrical** pulses into motion.

#### rural

adj. of or relating to the countrysidesynonym: agrarian, country, rustic

(1) **rural** accents, (2) people in **rural** areas Many **rural** areas are still impoverished.

### qualified

adj. officially recognized as having completed a training course or passed the exams that are necessary to perform a particular job

synonym: eligible, skillful, accomplished

(1) a **qualified** doctor, (2) **qualified** in medicine We seek a person **qualified** for the post.

### proverb

 a short saying that expresses a truth or gives advice based on practical experience

synonym: adage, saying, maxim

(1) a hackneyed **proverb**, (2) ancient **proverb**The famous **proverb** "actions speak louder than words" reminds us to focus on deeds instead of words.

### junk

n. discarded or unused material or objects, often considered worthless or of little value; also used to describe cheap or poorly made items or food that is high in calories but lacking in nutrition

synonym: trash, debris, waste

(1) junk mail, (2) hunk of junk

I need to clear out some of the junk in my garage.

#### mention

- v. to speak or write about something or someone briefly synonym: reference, allude, cite
- (1) **mention** name, (2) **mention** in a report I **mentioned** to him that I had seen his sister at the grocery store earlier that day.

#### represent

v. to speak, act, or be present on behalf of another person or group; to form or constitute

synonym: depict, express, describe

(1) **represent** by a diagram, (2) the characters that **represent** numbers

We elected him to **represent** us at the international conference.

### quarter

- n. one of four equal parts; a fourth part or portionsynonym: fourth, one-fourth
- (1) a **quarter** mile, (2) end of the first **quarter**The unemployment rate in the first **quarter** was 2.3
  percentage points higher than in the previous.

### grid

 a pattern of regularly spaced horizontal and vertical lines; a system of high tension cables by which electrical power is distributed throughout a region

synonym: gridiron, battery grid, power system

(1) a grid design, (2) a wire grid

**Grid** pattern roads often appear in urban areas.

### frequent

adj. happening constantly

synonym: periodic, recurring, routine

(1) **frequent** absence, (2) **frequent** use His heartaches are less **frequent** now.

### generator

a machine that produces electricity

synonym: dynamo, alternator, creator

(1) random number **generator**, (2) major revenue **generator** 

Most data centers have emergency **generators** on standby at all times.

fuel

a substance that is typically burned to generate heat or energy

synonym: energy, power, gas

(1) biomass fuel, (2) smokeless fuel

The **fuel** scarcity most severely impacted the manufacturing sector

#### estimate

v. to guess or calculate the cost, size, value, etc. of something

synonym: calculate, gauge, evaluate

(1) **estimate** a fair value, (2) **estimate** this chicken to weigh

### three pounds

We **estimated** the season's total trade deficit at \$50 billion.

### similarly

adv. in almost the same way synonym: also, likewise, ditto

(1) **similarly** situated, (2) have **similarly** great abilities We argue that wages for temporary workers should **similarly** rise.

### **luxury**

a state of great comfort or sophistication, mainly provided by expensive and beautiful things

synonym: extravagance, indulgence, opulence

(1) get into the **luxury** car market, (2) **luxury** hotel His anti- **luxury** practices were quite strict.

### crazy

adj. stupid or not sensible; very angry synonym: insane, absurd, bizarre

The rain and thunder are **crazy** today.

(1) crazy about cars and racing, (2) a crazy scheme

#### Don

- a Spanish gentleman; a university lecturer, especially a senior member of a college at Oxford or Cambridge
- (1) the **don** of the university, (2) **Don** Giovanni He could never go against what **Don** Carlos said.

## inappropriate

adj. not suitable or proper for a particular occasion, purpose, or person

synonym: improper, unsuitable, unacceptable

(1) **inappropriate** behavior, (2) **inappropriate** language It was highly **inappropriate** to make jokes during a serious business meeting.

#### observe

v. to watch or notice something carefully, often to gather information or insights; to take note of something or someone; to celebrate or commemorate a special event or occasion

synonym: watch, monitor, scrutinize

(1) **observe** a tradition, (2) **observe** wildlife

It is important to **observe** safety procedures in the workplace to prevent accidents.

#### obstetrics

n. the branch of medicine that deals with the care of women during pregnancy, childbirth, and the postpartum period, including the management of complications and the health of the mother and baby

synonym: midwifery, childbirth, tocology

(1) obstetrics ward, (2) obstetrics clinic

The hospital's **obstetrics** department is responsible for caring for pregnant women and delivering babies.

### emergency

 a sudden unforeseen crisis usually involving danger that requires immediate action

synonym: crisis, trouble, difficulty

(1) emergency action, (2) acute emergency

The president declared a state of emergency.

#### cesarean

adj. (also known as "C-section") relating to the delivery of a baby through a surgical incision made in the mother's abdomen and uterus rather than through vaginal birth

synonym: C-section, surgical birth

(1) **cesarean** delivery, (2) emergency **cesarean** 

The **cesarean** recovery period can be longer and more challenging than a vaginal birth recovery.

### auspicious

adj. a situation or event that is marked by potential success, favorable circumstances, or good fortune; a period that is believed to be a sign of favorable outcomes or prosperity

synonym: propitious, favorable, promising

(1) auspicious timing, (2) auspicious sign

The **auspicious** start to the new year brought hope for better times ahead.

### surgeon

 a doctor who is trained to perform medical operations that involve cutting open a person's body

synonym: sawbones, doctor

(1) an excellent brain **surgeon**, (2) army **surgeon**He is a skilled **surgeon** that has many years of training and experience.

#### scrub

v. to clean something thoroughly, typically with a brush and soap or detergent

synonym: clean, wash, sanitize

(1) **scrub** off graffiti, (2) **scrub** dirt from potatoes

She decided to **scrub** the kitchen floor to remove all the dirt and grime.

#### nurse

 a healthcare professional who is trained to provide care for the sick or injured; (verb) to try to cure by special care or treatment of an illness or injury

synonym: healthcare worker, caregiver, medic

(1) **nurse** practitioner, (2) a volunteer **nurse**The night shift **nurse** checked my vital signs before administering the medication.

### headlight

n. a bright forward-facing light on a vehicle, typically used at night to illuminate the road ahead

synonym: headlamp, beam, lamp

My car's **headlight** must be replaced before I drive again at night.

### literally

adv. in the real or original meaning of a word or phrase; in a literal sense or way; not figuratively

synonym: actually, truly, verily

(1) translate **literally**, (2) bite his tongue **literally** 

He **literally** jumped out of his chair when he heard the news.

### asleep

adj. in a state of sleep

synonym: sleeping, fallen, at rest

#### routine

 a usual or habitual way of doing things; a set sequence of steps, part of a larger computer program

synonym: habit, custom, procedure

(1) **routine** business, (2) a built-in diagnostic **routine** She studies gardening on a **routine** basis.

### probable

*adj.* likely to happen or likely to be true *synonym*: likely, possible, potential

(1) **probable** outcome, (2) **probable** cause of a fire It seems **probable** that he has forgotten our scheduled meeting.

### tragedy

n. an event or situation causing great loss, misfortune, or destruction; a play or literature that deals with a severe and sad event and often ends with the death of the main character

synonym: disaster, adversity, calamity

(1) a **tragedy** during work, (2) the aftermath of this **tragedy** Macbeth is a famous **tragedy** by Shakespeare.

#### frustrate

v. to hinder or prevent efforts, plans, or desires from doing, succeeding, or being fulfilled; to make someone feel upset or annoyed because they are unable to change or achieve something

synonym: hinder, thwart, dishearten

(1) **frustrate** the advancement, (2) **frustrate** other team members

The coach explained a strategy to **frustrate** the opponent's schemes to the players.

### singular

n. being only one of its kind; unique

synonym: unique, sole, individual

(1) singular purpose, (2) singular goal

The **singular** beauty of the night sky never ceases to amaze him.

### attempt

 an act or effort of trying to do something, especially something difficult

synonym: endeavor, effort, try

(1) the **attempt** to rescue the hostages, (2) a reckless **attempt** 

The third **attempt** was far more successful.

### colleague

 one of a group of a coworker, especially in a profession or a business

synonym: coworker, associate, fellow

collaborate with colleagues,
 former colleague
 decided to seek counseling on the advice of my colleague.

#### chief

adj. most important or primary; (noun) a person who is in charge

synonym: essential, primary, leading

(1) **chief** accountant, (2) **chief** events of the year Mining is a **chief** source of income for the country.

### equip

v. to provide a person or a place with the things that are needed for a particular purpose or activity

synonym: prepare, furnish, provide

(1) **equip** an army, (2) **equip** our children with some special skills

The construction company **equipped** the building with an earthquake-resistant device.

#### unreliable

adj. not able to be trusted or depended onsynonym: inconsistent, erratic, undependable

(1) prove **unreliable**, (2) **unreliable** source of information By incorrect assumption, statistics can be notoriously **unreliable**.

#### frank

adj. honest and sincere; open and candid in expression synonym: candid, direct, freehearted

(1) **frank** and open discussion, (2) make a **frank** apology Full involvement means **frank** and prompt responses.

### umpteen

adj. very many; relating to a large or indefinite number of something

synonym: countless, numerous, many

(1) **umpteen** hours, (2) **umpteen** attempts
After moving around the world **umpteen** times, I finally settled in my hometown.

### unspeakable

*adj.* too terrible, shocking, or distressing to speak about *synonym*: unspeakably horrible, indescribable, unutterable

(1) **unspeakable** crime, (2) **unspeakable** pain
The survivors of the plane crash could only describe the **unspeakable** horror of the experience.

### tinker

v. to make repairs, adjustments, or improvements to something, especially in an experimental or makeshift way

synonym: fiddle, play, fix

(1) tinker with the bill,(2) tinker with the settingsHe spent the afternoon tinkering with his car engine.

### prototype

- n. a first or preliminary example of something such as a device or vehicle from which other forms are developed synonym: mock-up, precursor, model
- (1) complete a **prototype** product, (2) early **prototype** The flying car is presently in the **prototype** stage.

universal

adj. existing or affecting everywhere or everyonesynonym: common, broad, worldwide

universal life, (2) principles of universal design
 picture earned near- universal acclaim from critics.

#### circumstance

*n.* the specific conditions or events that surround a particular situation or occurrence

*synonym*: condition, context, environment

(1) circumstance of birth, (2) circumstance of injury

She explained the **circumstances** surrounding the accident.

### pediatrics

 the branch of medicine that deals with the care and treatment of children

synonym: pedology, child health

(1) pediatrics department, (2) pediatrics clinic

I am studying **pediatrics** in medical school because I love working with children.

### geriatrics

 a branch of medicine specializing in the healthcare of elderly individuals, including the diagnosis, treatment, and prevention of diseases and conditions that affect older adults

synonym: senescence, old age, elderly care

(1) geriatrics clinic, (2) geriatrics specialist

The **geriatrics** department focuses on the healthcare needs of elderly patients.

#### built-in

adj. included as an integral part of something synonym: integrated, inherent, equipped

(1) **built-in** feature, (2) **built-in** battery

The new car had a built-in navigation system.

#### concentration

 the ability to focus all your time and energy on one thing without thinking about anything else.

synonym: attention, engagement, assiduity

(1) **concentration** of armaments, (2) his research area of **concentration** 

This exam requires excellent **concentration** to pass.

### essentially

adv. relating to the essential features or concepts of anything synonym: fundamentally, basically, virtually

(1) essentially correct, (2) become essentially same

### **Essentially**, a society is an organism.

### purity

n. the state of being undiluted or unmixed with anything else; the state of being free from immorality, especially of a sexual nature

synonym: sinlessness, innocence, cleanliness

(1) the degree of **purity**, (2) high **purity** 

Higher **purity** requires additional equipment and energy.

### eventually

adv. finally, particularly after a long time or a lot of struggle, complications, and so on

synonym: finally, someday, ultimately

(1) **eventually** become obsolete, (2) **eventually** succeed The corporation **eventually** dominated the entire tobacco business.

dilute

v. to make a substance less concentrated by adding a liquid or another substance to it

*synonym*: weaken, thin, reduce

(1) **dilute** acid with water, (2) **dilute** a great idea She **diluted** the concentrated juice with water.

#### mixture

 a combination of different elements, substances, or entities, usually in non-uniform proportions, resulting in a homogeneous or heterogeneous blend of physical or chemical properties

synonym: blend, amalgam, concoction

(1) mixture of emotions, (2) perfect mixture

The paint was a **mixture** of different pigments to achieve the desired color.

#### inhale

- v. to breathe in air or a different substance, such as smoke synonym: breathe in, take in, draw in

### percentage

*n.* the number, amount, or rate of something, which is usually the amount per hundred

### glorious

adj. having or deserving great admiration, praise, and honor; having great beauty and splendor

synonym: exquisite, magnificent, majestic

(1) a glorious victory, (2) photo in glorious colorI choose a glorious death rather than a shameful life.

### abundant

adj. present in great quantity

synonym: ample, plentiful, generative

(1) live an **abundant** life, (2) an **abundant** supply of water The country has **abundant** oil and natural gas resources.

filter

 any of several types of equipment or systems used to separate particles from liquids or gases or to remove specific forms of light

*synonym*: strainer

(1) gas filter, (2) clogged filter

Ozone is a primary **filter** to protect Earth's surface from harmful UV rays.

#### anesthetic

 a substance that is administered to a person or an animal to produce a loss of sensation or consciousness so that medical or surgical procedures can be performed without causing pain

synonym: sedative, anesthesia, painkiller

(1) anesthetic injection, (2) local anesthetic

The dentist administered an **anesthetic** to numb the patient's mouth before the procedure.

agent

 a person who represents and negotiates on behalf of someone else, such as a literary agent or talent agent; (of chemistry and medicine) a substance that brings about a chemical or physical effect; (of computer science) a piece of software that performs a task autonomously

*synonym*: representative, delegate, envoy

(1) **agent** system, (2) antidiarrheal **agent**The FBI **agent** went undercover to infiltrate the criminal organization.

lung

- *n*. either of the two organs in the chest that people and some animals use for breathing
- (1) **lung** capacity, (2) do **lung** transplantation He has terminal **lung** cancer.

sensor

 a device that receives a signal or stimulus such as heat, pressure, light, motion, etc. and responds to it in a specific manner

*synonym*: detector

(1) motion **sensor** lighting, (2) an image **sensor**This automatic door could no longer be opened due to a **sensor** failure.

forbid

- v. to order somebody not to do something, especially officially; to keep something from happening or arising synonym: prohibit, ban, outlaw
- (1) **forbid** smoking in public areas, (2) **forbid** the use of chemical weapons

God forbid you should regret your marriage.

transition

 the process or period of changing from one state or circumstance to another

synonym: change, growth, shift

(1) **transition** phase, (2) ensure a smooth **transition**The nation's healthcare system is in **transition** at the moment.

### automatically

adv. without needing a direct human control

synonym: mechanically, unconsciously, spontaneously

(1) record driving **automatically**, (2) **automatically** adjusted Our subscription plan is **automatically** renewed.

### drawing

 the act of making a picture with a pencil, pen, or other instruments on paper, cardboard, or other material

synonym: sketch, depiction, illustration

(1) technical **drawing**, (2) **drawing** for design

She is talented at **drawing** and has won several awards for her artwork.

### inlet

a small arm of the sea, a lake, or a river, usually leading inland

synonym: cove, bayou, estuary

(1) inlet valve, (2) inlet temperature

The boat sailed through the narrow **inlet** and into the harbor.

### **battery**

a device that is placed inside a car, gadget, equipment,
 etc. and that provides electrical power to them

synonym: electric cell, array, batch

(1) a dry **battery**, (2) **battery** charging

The engine did not start because the **battery** was flat.

### provider

 a person or an organization that supplies somebody with something needed or wanted

*synonym*: supplier

(1) an information **provider**, (2) the **provider** of the family People select Internet **providers** not only in terms of price but also in terms of transmission speed.

### adjust

 to make a minor modification to something to make it more suited for a new set of conditions or to make it function better.

synonym: adapt, alter, acclimate
