#### amine

### agent

transport

- a system for moving people or products from one location to another using automobiles, roads, and so on synonym: shipment, transit, conveyance

a short passage taken from a book, piece of music, etc.;

### separate

## chromatography

char

synonym: burn, scorch, singe

potentially

#### cancer

Breast **cancer** is the most common type of cancer in women.

### grand

adj. important and large in size, scope, or extent synonym: impressive, great, ambitious

### spinach

- a leafy green vegetable with a slightly bitter taste and high nutritional value, often used in salads or cooked dishes, and also famously associated with the cartoon character Popeye, who claimed eating spinach made him stronger

Fresh **spinach** is a good source of vitamins and minerals.

## standing

 adj. existing or remaining upright; having a vertical position; (noun) social, financial, or professional status or reputation

synonym: upright, vertical, (noun) position

#### ridiculous

 adj. very silly or unreasonable and deserving to be laughed at

synonym: absurd, fatuous, foolish

### complicated

adj. involving a lot of different things or parts in a way that is difficult to understand or analyze

#### atom

 the smallest unit of ordinary matter that forms a chemical element, composed of a nucleus and one or more electrons bound to the nucleus

### barely

### algebra

 a type of mathematics in which signs and letters represent numbers

### garbage

### passe

#### wisdom

- the quality of being wise, or the ability to use your knowledge and experience to make sensible decisions synonym: sagacity, discernment, insight
- (1) a fountain of wisdom, (2) wisdom literature The community greatly respected and sought after the older adult's wisdom.

#### decide

- to make up someone's mind about something; to come to a conclusion or judgment after considering options synonym: choose, determine, settle
- (1) **decide** a question, (2) **decide** on a course of action She couldn't **decide** whether to order the pizza or the pasta for dinner.

### profess

 v. to declare openly, often publicly or formally, that one has a particular skill, belief, or feeling; to admit or affirm
 synonym: declare, claim, confess

(1) profess innocence, (2) profess law

He **professes** his love for her every day, showering her with gifts and affection.

### supervision

 the act or process of overseeing or directing the work or performance of others

synonym: oversight, management, direction

(1) under **supervision**, (2) **supervision** by the police She was put in charge of the project and had full **supervision** over the team.

### reject

v. to refuse to accept, consider, or use something or someone

synonym: decline, turn down, repudiate

(1) **reject** the proposal, (2) **reject** all imperfect merchandise The company **rejected** the job candidate's application due to a lack of experience.

fort

- n. a military structure designed to be defended from attacksynonym: stronghold, bastion, fortress

### ovary

- n. either of the pair of organs in the female reproductive system that produces eggs; (of a plant) the organ that bears the ovules of a flower

### diagnose

v. to determine or distinguish the nature of a problem or an illness through a careful analysis

### chemotherapy

the treatment of disease, particularly cancer, using special drugs that have a toxic effect on cancer cells; frequently used in conjunction with other therapies such as surgery and radiation

(1) chemotherapy regimen, (2) chemotherapy side effects Many cancer patients undergo chemotherapy as a treatment option.

involve

to include or affect someone or something as a necessary part of something else

patient

a person who is receiving medical treatment, care, or attention from a healthcare professional, such as a doctor, nurse, or therapist; a personal quality or characteristic


