# **symbiotic**

- adj. involving two varieties of animal or plant, each of which supplies the conditions for the other to exist
- (1) **symbiotic** economy, (2) **symbiotic** bacteria We have a mutually **symbiotic** connection with them.

#### cellulose

- a complex carbohydrate that is the main structural component of plant cell walls and fibers; a substance used to make paper, textiles, and other materials
- synonym: fiber, paper, wood pulp

(1) **cellulose** acetate, (2) **cellulose** insulation The **cellulose** content in fruits and vegetables contributes to their dietary fiber.

#### fermentation

the chemical breakdown of a substance by bacteria, yeasts, or other microorganisms, typically involving effervescence and the giving off of the heat

synonym: brewing, culturing, pickling

- (1) oxidative **fermentation**, (2) **fermentation** tank The process of **fermentation** is used to make beer, wine, and many other products.
- to make beer or tea by mixing a substance with hot water

synonym: make, prepare

(1) **brew** a cup of tea, (2) **brew** beer I am going to **brew** some coffee this morning.

### dissolve

to be or cause to be absorbed by a liquid to form a part of the solution: to close down or dismiss

synonym: disband, disappear, liquefy

(1) **dissolve** the sugar, (2) officially **dissolved** the marriage The political party **dissolved** after much internal fighting.

#### acetic

adj. relating to vinegar or containing acetic acid (= a colorless, pungent-smelling liquid organic compound with the chemical formula CH3COOH); having a sour or sharp taste or smell resembling vinegar

synonym: sour, acidic, tart

(1) acetic fermentation, (2) acetic smell Adding **acetic** acid to a solution can lower its pH.

## recycle

to sort and collect things to process them and produce valuable materials that can be used again

*synonym*: reclaim, reuse, reprocess

(1) **recycle** the cardboard boxes, (2) **recycle** milk packaging into new paper

brew

We largely **recycle** the circuit board of cell phones because they contain a lot of valuable metals.

#### ferment

v. to experience a chemical change or action that results in the production of alcohol or effervescence of gases; (noun) a state of agitated activity or change, especially in the context of social or political movements

*synonym*: ripen, simmer, (noun) agitation

(1) **ferment** sugar into ethanol, (2) political **ferment**The dough was left to **ferment** overnight to give the bread its distinctive flavor.

#### thermostat

 a device that automatically regulates temperature by controlling the heating or cooling system based on the temperature in a room or building

synonym: thermoregulator, climate control

(1) thermostat settings, (2) smart thermostat

The digital **thermostat** has a programmable feature, and it can be controlled through your smartphone.

aft

- adj. (the opposite of "forward") located at or towards the rear or back of a ship, aircraft, or other vehicle
- (1) aft cabin, (2) aft view

The **aft** section of the ship suffered significant damage after the collision with the reef.

#### nanoscale

- adj. on a scale that can be measured in nanometres (= one billionth of a meter); on a very small scale
- (1) nanoscale device, (2) things at the nanoscale

This process improves the strength of the metal by controlling the **nanoscale** lattice structure of the metal.

#### evaporate

v. to turn a liquid into a gas; to become less intense and disappear gradually

synonym: vaporize, disappear, vanish

(1) **evaporate** the water, (2) **evaporate** almost overnight The sun will **evaporate** the mist.

### compress

v. to press or squeeze together to make something take up less space

synonym: condense, constrict, squeeze

(1) **compress** the chest, (2) **compress** gas

She **compressed** the files into a single ZIP archive to save space on her computer.

#### sew

v. to join, fasten, or repair two pieces of something by putting the thread through them with a needle

synonym: stitch, darn, tailor

(1) **sew** with thread, (2) **sew** a button

My mother taught me how to **sew**.

# conventionally

adv. in a way that follows accepted customs, rules, or standards; in a way that is typical or traditional

synonym: traditionally, customarily, conventionally

(1) **conventionally** dressed, (2) **conventionally** grown crops

**Conventionally**, doctors recommend getting at least 8 hours of sleep per night for optimal health.

#### seam

 a line of stitching or joining where two pieces of fabric or material are united; also, a narrow furrow or fissure in rock or soil

synonym: stitch, seam, joint

(1) uneven **seam**, (2) the **seam** on the shoulder She took the dress to the tailor to fix the torn **seam**.

### intrigue

v. to make someone interested, especially by being strange, unusual, or mysterious; to make a secret plan with other people to harm someone

synonym: attract, captivate, charm

# indigo

### hydrophobic

#### excite

# biodegrade

- v. to decay naturally by microorganisms, such as bacteria and fungi

# peel

# degrade
