dorm

synonym: residence hall, hostel, boarding house

singe

synonym: sear, char, burn

(1) **singe** off the hair over the flames, (2) **singe** the edges of a fabric

I didn't realize the iron was still hot and **singed** my dress.

humility

the quality or condition of being humble; a low estimate of one's self

synonym: humbleness, modesty, unpretentiousness

develop an attitude of humility, (2) lack of humility

whirlwind

 a very strong wind that moves rapidly in circles and causes a lot of damage

synonym: tornado, waterspout, dust devil

(1) economic **whirlwind**, (2) **whirlwind** of events We went on a **whirlwind** visit to the sightseeing spot.

### beak

- n. the hard and pointed or curved mouse of a bird synonym: nib, pecker, snoot
- (1) sharp **beak**, (2) a tip of the **beak**

The bird's **beak** evolves according to the type of prey it can take on the area.

## peck

## pomegranate

#### thorn

a sharp, pointed projection or spine on a plant or animal;

synonym: spike, prickle, spine
