# perversion

### dramatic

# disproportionate

adj. too large or too small when compared with something else, or not deserving its importance or influence

# struggle

# identity

n. the fact of being who or what somebody or something is; the features, emotions, or ideas that distinguish persons from one another

synonym: character, personality, individuality

crave

v. to have a strong desire for something; to long for or want intensely

synonym: desire, yearn, long for

approval

the belief that someone or something is good or acceptable

synonym: acceptance, endorsement, permission

peer

- n. a person who has the same age, status, or abilitysynonym: fellow, associate, counterpart

vital

adj. necessary for the success or continued existence of something

acne

 a skin condition that causes pimples, blackheads, and other blemishes on the face, chest, and back

# personality
