atherosclerosis

 a disease in which plaque builds up in the arterial walls, leading to a narrowing and hardening of the arteries, potentially causing reduced blood flow and an increased risk of heart disease and stroke

synonym: hardening of the arteries, arterial plaque

harden

pustule

preposterous

lesion

osteoporosis

- a medical condition characterized by a loss of bone density or mass, resulting in fragile and porous bones that are at increased risk for fractures
- (1) **osteoporosis** treatment, (2) **osteoporosis** prevention As we age, we become more at risk for **osteoporosis**, a condition that weakens the bones in our bodies.

osteopenia

 a condition characterized by lower than normal bone mineral density but not as severe as osteoporosis, often considered a precursor to osteoporosis and an increased risk of fractures

synonym: low bone mass, weak bone density
