conductor

n. someone who leads the performance of musicians or a piece of music; (in physics) an object, substance, or material that readily allows the flow of electricity, heat, etc.

bond

mutual

adj. common to or shared by two or more parties *synonym*: shared, common, joint

spin

v. to cause something to rotate rapidly; to cause someone to feel dizzy or disoriented

synonym: rotate, twirl, swirl

narrative

 a story or a description of a series of events or process of telling a story

synonym: the tale, chronology, annals

(1) **narrative** poetry, (2) personal **narrative**The **narrative** handles multiple plot lines and has unpredictable ends.

conduct

- v. to organize and carry out a particular activitysynonym: behave, lead, carry on
- (1) **conduct** a background check, (2) **conduct** research Police will **conduct** random breath testing for drunk driving.

frank

adj. honest and sincere; open and candid in expression synonym: candid, direct, freehearted

(1) **frank** and open discussion, (2) make a **frank** apology Full involvement means **frank** and prompt responses.

coercion

n. the use of force, threats, or intimidation to persuade someone to do something against their will; the practice of controlling or manipulating someone through the use of power or authority

synonym: pressure, force, compulsion

invariably

adv. in every case or on every occasion; without exception synonym: consistently, always, uniformly

dictator

 a political leader who has complete power over a country, especially one who has obtained control by force

synonym: autocrat, tyrant, despot

(1) military **dictator**, (2) a **dictator** with enormous powers A popular uprising led to the overthrow of the **dictator**.

tyrannical

adj. using power or authority over people, especially in a specific country, group, etc., in an unfair and cruel waysynonym: despotic, oppressive, authoritarian

fig

- a sweet and soft edible fruit with many seeds or a tree on which these grow

rehearse

v. to practice or repeat something, such as a performance, speech, or action, to prepare for an event or to improve one's skills; to go through the motions of a planned activity before executing it

individual

democracy

 a form of government in which the people have the authority to deliberate and decide legislation, or to choose governing officials to do so

synonym: self-government, republic, commonwealth

rehearsal

 a practice session, usually for a performance or presentation, during which people prepare and fine-tune their performance, often with the help of feedback from others; the act of rehearsing

synonym: practice, run-through, drill

cast-iron

- a strong, heavy, and durable metal or alloy that is used in various industrial applications, such as machinery, piping, and construction

architecture

gentle

synonym: mild, delicate, soft

scot

a tax or payment, particularly a share or portion of n. something; a person from Scotland or a Scottish immigrant

synonym: tax, charge, toll

ensemble

a group of people who perform together, especially in music or theater; a coordinated or matching set of something

gesticulate

blur

a faint or indistinct image or sound; something that is not clear or distinct; (verb) to become unclear; to lose clear vision

useless

adj. not serving any useful purpose; having no practical result

ridicule

dismal

podium

 a raised platform or stand that is used for delivering speeches, conducting meetings, or presenting awards

synonym: lectern, stand, dais

engender

v. to make a feeling or situation exist; to cause or give rise to

synonym: beget, spawn, generate

(1) **engender** a crisis, (2) **engender** the trust

The discussion about war helps **engender** a sense of shared humanity.

crescendo

 a gradual increase in volume or intensity, often about a musical piece or performance; figuratively, a gradual buildup or intensification of a feeling, emotion, or action

synonym: escalation, apex, zenith

upsurge

 a sudden and significant increase, a rise, or surge in something, especially in intensity or frequency

volume

veteran

 a person who has had long experience in a particular area or activity

synonym: expert, pro, vet

tight

adj. fixed, fastened, or kept together firmly or closely synonym: closed, secured, cramped

crush

v. to press it firmly, usually with your hands or a tool, so that it becomes flat or smaller

synonym: destroy, demolish, pulverize

loose

 adj. not securely fixed or fastened in place or able to be detached or separated from something

adventure

 a journey or a series of events that is unusual, exciting, or dangerous

dizzy

adj. having or causing a whirling sensation and not able to keep balance

planet

 any of the nine large celestial bodies that circle in the solar system; any celestial body that revolves around a star

opportune

adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purpose

synonym: suitable, timely, practical

 a drama set to music, in which the words are sung rather than spoken

synonym: musical, operetta, oratorio

audit

an official inspection of the accounting procedures and records of business by a trained accountant or CPA that is independent of the subject; a methodical inspection or review of a specific condition or situation

synonym: review, examination, inspection

rural

adj. of or relating to the countrysidesynonym: agrarian, country, rustic

(1) rural accents, (2) people in rural areas

locate

 to specify or determine the exact position of someone or something

jaw

 either of the two bones at the bottom of the face that moves when you open your mouth; (verb) talk socially without exchanging too much information

amazing

adj. extremely surprising, especially in a way that you like or admire

performer

 a person who entertains an audience or group by presenting artistic or theatrical acts, such as an actor, musician, dancer, or singer

handful

 a small quantity or number, usually referring to the amount that can be held in one hand; a person or thing that is difficult to control or manage

synonym: small number, couple, few

emerge

v. to move out of or away from something and become visible

synonym: arise, occur, appear

incarnation

n. the embodiment of a concept or idea in a physical form; a person or thing that personifies something

synonym: embodiment, personification, avatar

regime

 the organization, a system, or method that is the governing authority of a political unit

adv. on a regular or habitual basis; in a manner that is customary or expected

communal

creative
