abalone

shell

cardboard

 a stiff, thick material made from compressed paper pulp used to make boxes and other packaging materials

caviar

 the eggs of sturgeon or other large fish considered a delicacy and used especially in appetizers

synonym: roe, sturgeon eggs

graham

 a type of flour made from whole wheat that has had the bran and germ removed and is often used to make crackers or cookies; a cracker made with this type of flour

marshmallows over a glowing graham cracker.

landfill

animation
