synonym: redefine, restructure, reposition

(1) **reframe** resource allocation, (2) **reframe** problem The therapist tried to **reframe** his negative thoughts.

#### onstage

adv. onto or on a stage in a theater; in front of an audience

(1) appeared onstage, (2) walk onstage

He performed his magic trick **onstage**, leaving the audience in awe.

#### mania

 a psychological or emotional state that is marked by excessive enthusiasm, excitement, or delusions; a strong and uncontrollable desire or craving for something

synonym: obsession, craze, frenzy

(1) start-up mania, (2) dance mania

The **mania** for collecting rare books led him to spend his savings on a first edition.

#### **Christ**

 the man that Christians believe is the prophet and the son of God, and whose life and sermons form the basis for Christianity

synonym: Savior, Jesus Christ, Jesus

(1) teaching of Christ, (2) before Christ

Christmas is the day to celebrate the birth of Christ.

#### rehearsal

n. a practice session, usually for a performance or presentation, during which people prepare and fine-tune their performance, often with the help of feedback from others; the act of rehearsing

synonym: practice, run-through, drill

(1) dress rehearsal, (2) music rehearsal

The theater company had its final **rehearsal** before opening night.

## psychiatry

- n. the branch of medicine concerned with the study, treatment, and prevention of mental illness
- synonym: mental health, psychology, psychoanalysis(1) psychiatry therapy, (2) biological psychiatry

The field of **psychiatry** is constantly evolving, with new treatments and approaches being developed all the time.

nap

n. a short sleep, especially during the day

synonym: rest, doze, drowse

(1) take a nap,(2) daytime napShe woke the kids up from their nap.

### bugle

 a brass wind instrument similar to a trumpet but with a more conical shape and no valves; the sound produced by the bugle or a similar instrument

synonym: trumpet, brass instrument

(1) military bugle, (2) bugle sound

The **bugle** call woke up the soldiers at dawn.

## hypomania

n. a mood state characterized by intense feelings of joy or excitement, increased energy, talkativeness, and impulsivity, but at a less severe level than full mania, often associated with bipolar disorder and other mental health conditions

synonym: mania, frenzy, excitement

(1) **hypomania** symptoms, (2) **hypomania** disorder People with bipolar disorder may experience periods of **hypomania**, characterized by an elevated mood but less severe than full-blown mania.
