ocular

albino

disabled

educated

adj. having received a high standard of education *synonym*: knowledgeable, erudite, enlightened

consult

synonym: confer, consider, see

extraordinary

temporarily

environment

 the natural world such as air, water, and land in which humans, animals, and plants live

synonym: atmosphere, surroundings, climate

(1) **environment** affairs, (2) chaotic **environment** Every human is responsible for taking care of the Earth's **environment**.

impersonate

v. to pretend to be someone else, often with the intent to deceive or defraud; to imitate the mannerisms or speech of another person as a form of tribute or satire

operate

sight

disaster

determinant

triangle

 a three-sided polygon with three angles; something that has three sides or parts

exhaust

n. the system in a vehicle that removes waste gases from the engine; (verb) to make someone completely tiredsynonym: emission, fumes, (verb) deplete

The factory's **exhaust** fumes polluted the air and affected the health of the nearby residents.

bother

v. to disturb, annoy, or cause inconvenience or worry to someone; to take the trouble or effort to do something

therapy

n. the act of caring for someone through medication, remedial training, etc.

quest

n. a long or challenging search for something synonym: exploration, inquisition, pursuit

(1) the **quest** for truth, (2) on a **quest** for happiness That adventurer traveled in **quest** of buried treasure.

firm

adj. resolute or unwavering in decision-making or action; strong or secure in structure, make, or composition; reliable, trustworthy, or dependable; (noun) a business or company

synonym: stable, secure, steadfast

(1) firm grip, (2) accounting firm

The **firm** deadline for submitting the project is tomorrow, so we need to work efficiently to finish on time.

chip

- n. a small fragment of something broken off from the whole; a long and thin piece of potato fried in oil or fat synonym: flake, fragment, chunk
- (1) a **chip** of wood, (2) I don't care a **chip**We can use this campaign as a bargaining **chip** in the negotiations.

choke

- v. to prevent or obstruct the normal breathing or swallowing of someone or somethingsynonym: strangle, suffocate, clog

motorbike

- n. a lightweight, two-wheeled vehicle with an engine designed for use on roads; also known as a motorcycle synonym: motorcycle, bike, two-wheeler

appropriate

- adj. suitable or proper in the circumstances; fitting synonym: fitting, suitable, proper

ache

 to experience a dull, persistent pain or discomfort, typically of moderate or low intensity; to feel a continuous dull pain

synonym: hurt, throb, smart

(1) ache abominably, (2) ache all the time

I ache all over after running a marathon yesterday.

sensible

 adj. having good sense or judgment; reasonable; practical;
 marked by a perception of the importance or seriousness of something

synonym: reasonable, practical, pragmatic

(1) **sensible** decision, (2) **sensible** approach It's **sensible** to wear a helmet when riding a bike.

lamppost

a tall standing pole that supports one or more electric lamps

synonym: streetlight, light post, pole light

(1) lamppost light, (2) hit a lamppost

The **lamppost** on the corner of the street has been out for a week, making it difficult to see at night.

tendency

 an inclination or predisposition towards a particular behavior, attitude, or course of action; a natural or prevailing tendency or characteristic

synonym: inclination, propensity, proclivity

(1) economic tendency, (2) curious tendency

There is a growing **tendency** among young people to prioritize experiences over material possessions.

smashing

 adj. very successful or impressive; causing something to be broken or destroyed

synonym: great, wonderful, breaking

(1) a **smashing** blow, (2) give **smashing** results

The band's new album was a **smashing** success, reaching the top of the charts.

bash

v. to strike or hit hard, often with a blunt object or a fist; to criticize harshly or with force; to hold a social gathering or party, often involving loud music or revelry; (noun) a lively, informal party or gathering, often characterized by loud music, dancing, and socializing

synonym: strike, hit, pound

(1) bash the door, (2) beach bash

I accidentally **bashed** my elbow on the door frame while walking through.

typical

adj. having the usual characteristics or traits of a specific group of things

synonym: characteristic, usual, distinctive

This artwork is **typical** of her work.

snot

 mucus produced by the nose, often mixed with saliva or other secretions that can be expelled by blowing the nose or sneezing

synonym: mucus, phlegm, nasal discharge

(1) runny **snot**, (2) excess **snot** production

The child wiped away the sticky **snot** from his nose with a tissue.

ridiculous

adj. very silly or unreasonable and deserving to be laughed at

synonym: absurd, fatuous, foolish

pity

 a feeling of sorrow and compassion caused by the suffering or misfortunes of others; an object of contempt or disdain

crumple

 to collapse or crumple into a disordered or wrinkled mass; to fall apart or lose strength suddenly; to become emotionally distressed or overwhelmed

The car **crumpled** after colliding with the tree.

woo

v. to seek the affection or favor of someone; to court or pursue someone romantically or with flattery

synonym: court, pursue, charm

scoot

v. to move or glide along quickly and smoothly on a surface, especially on a scooter or similar device

synonym: glide, slide, scurry

sprint

v. to run at full speed over a short distance or period of time

synonym: dash, bolt, race

grab

hire

cataract

amazing

adj. extremely surprising, especially in a way that you like or admire

synonym: exceptional, extraordinary, wonderful

chuck

v. to throw something carelessly or casually; to get rid of something or someone

synonym: toss, throw, discard

entrepreneur

 an individual who creates or invests in one or more businesses, especially when this involves taking financial risks

organization

a group of people who work together for a shared purpose

synonym: association, institution, community

conservation

synonym: preservation, protection, saving
