imbalance

n. a situation in which two or more things are not equal or equally treated

machinery

an enzyme responsible for the conversion of androgens n. (male hormones) into estrogens (female hormones), found primarily in the ovaries, placenta, testicles, and fat tissue, which plays a crucial role in the regulation of hormone levels and development

convert

regulate
