#### invitation

 a spoken or written request to participate or be present or take part in something

synonym: request, asking, proposal

#### contribution

n. the act of giving something, especially money, to a particular cause or organization; a voluntary gift as of money or service or ideas made to some worthwhile cause

synonym: donation, gift, offering

### groundbreaking

adj. producing fresh findings; using novel techniques synonym: innovative, revolutionary

#### instrument

#### scare

- v. to frighten a person or animal, or to become frightened synonym: frighten, spook, intimidate

#### distance

n. the amount of space between two points, measured in units such as miles, meters, or kilometers; the extent, scope, or range between two things, such as distance or emotional distance

#### cherish

### peaceful

#### patrol

n. the act of guarding an area or conducting surveillance of an area to maintain order, perform security functions, or prevent crime; a group of officers or soldiers that conducts such an operation

#### confront

oppress

#### intimidate

#### warlord

### hardworking

- adj. tending to work with a lot of effort and care synonym: diligent, dedicated, conscientious
- (1) **hardworking** student, (2) retire from **hardworking** life They sought candidates with **hardworking** and good-natured.

#### fin

 a thin flat part on the body of a fish or other aquatic animal used for propulsion or balance

synonym: flipper, appendage, stabilizer

(1) back fin, (2) a fin of a plane

The shark's powerful **fins** allowed it to swim at high speeds.

### bakery

 a place where bread and other baked goods are made and sold

synonym: bakeshop, bakehouse

(1) run a **bakery**, (2) **bakery** industry

He worked at the **bakery** as a baker.

### conscript

v. to enlist or draft someone into military service or to compel someone to serve in a certain capacity; to recruit or oblige someone to do something against their will or preference

### evident

### repress

 to restrain or control by force; to suppress feelings or memories

synonym: suppress, control, curb

(1) cannot **repress** laughter, (2) **repress** gene expression He **repressed** the memories of his traumatic childhood.

### diplomacy

 the art and practice of conducting negotiations between nations, organizations, or people; the fine art of dealing with people in a sensitive and effective way synonym: tact, negotiation, delicacy

- (1) the language of **diplomacy**, (2) the art of **diplomacy** Effective **diplomacy** is necessary to resolve conflicts and maintain relationships between countries.
- a very tiny living that causes the disease; a piece of something such as an organism, concept, etc., capable of growing into a new one or part of one

fir

opposition

the act of disagreeing or resisting; the state of strong disagreement

#### riverbank

 the land along the edge of a river, often used for recreation or agricultural purposes

### gratitude

 the quality of being thankful; readiness to show appreciation for and to return kindness

synonym: appreciation, thankfulness, indebtedness

### awareness

the fact or state of knowing something exists and is important

synonym: understanding, cognition, knowledge

evil

adj. profoundly immoral, cruel, and wicked; having or exerting a harmful effect on people

### destroy

 to ruin or damage severely or completely; to eradicate or eliminate completely

### vulnerable

adj. capable of being hurt or influenced physically or mentally

synonym: susceptible, exposed, weak

defend

v. to protect someone or something from attack, criticism, danger, etc.

synonym: protect, guard, support

(1) **defend** my country, (2) **defend** against a threat International law allows each nation to **defend** itself when its rights and interests are illegally violated.

### democracy

 a form of government in which the people have the authority to deliberate and decide legislation, or to choose governing officials to do so

*synonym*: self-government, republic, commonwealth

(1) **democracy** advocate, (2) principles of **democracy Democracy** often entails inclusive capitalism as well.

### glory

- n. great honor or success won by notable achievementssynonym: acclaim, credit, recognition

#### macho

brag

### stability

- n. the quality or attribute of being firm and steadfastsynonym: resilience, solidity, steadiness

### contradictory

adj. containing or consisting of conflicting or incompatible elements

synonym: conflicting, opposing, inconsistent

### deploy

- v. to move troops or weapons into a position or military action; to bring into something in an effective waysynonym: set up, expand, launch

### commonplace

adj. occurring very often; lacking originality or interest synonym: ordinary, routine, mundane

#### murder

- n. the crime of killing somebody intentionallysynonym: slaying, killing

#### relative

### revenge

#### ritual

any customary observance or practice; any prescribed procedure for conducting religious ceremonies

### purity

 the state of being undiluted or unmixed with anything else; the state of being free from immorality, especially of a sexual nature

### rage

n. a strong feeling of anger or violence

synonym: fury, anger, outrage

 to come to an end or close; to reach a judgment or opinion by reasoning

*synonym*: complete, finish, decide

#### constitutional

adj. of or relating to a constitution (= the set of fundamental principles), especially of a country or government; existing as an essential characteristic

synonym: fundamental, basic, inherent

(1) **constitutional** ban, (2) a **constitutional** disease The right to free speech is a **constitutional** right in the United States.

### introduction

n. a preliminary explanation or remarks given before the start of a text, performance, or event; the act of bringing something new into existence or introducing something to a wider audience or new market

synonym: initiation, preamble, prologue

(1) introduction education, (2) self- introduction
The introduction to the new class was informative and engaging.

### monopoly

n. exclusive control or possession of something, especially an area of business; a board game in which players try to gain a monopoly on real estate

synonym: cartel, trust, ownership

### legitimate

adj. accordant with or allowed by law; lawful synonym: lawful, honest, fair

### presence

 the fact or state that someone or something exists, occurs, or is present

*synonym*: existence, actuality, fact

### penalty

- n. a punishment for violating a law, rule, or contractsynonym: punishment, sentence, fine
- (1) death **penalty**, (2) corner of the **penalty** area The lawyer was reinstated after paying the **penalty**.

### outweigh

v. to be heavier, more significant, or more critical than something

synonym: dominate, outrank, overpower
