## explosion

 a violent release induced by a chemical or nuclear reaction

*synonym*: burst, eruption, outbreak

(1) a lot of explosions,(2) site of the explosionA broken gas pipe triggered the explosion.

## shocking

adj. extremely or surprisingly bad, or causing a strong emotional response such as surprise or disgust

synonym: startling, surprising, astounding

(1) **shocking** response, (2) **shocking** revelation

The news of the accident was **shocking** and left many in shock.

## convey

v. to express ideas, feelings, etc. so that it is known or understood by other people; to carry something from one place to another

synonym: communicate, transfer, deliver

(1) **convey** a complex idea, (2) **convey** goods by truck An ironic remark often **conveys** an intended meaning obliquely.

#### stare

v. to gaze or look fixedly and intently at someone or something, often in a questioning, curious, or suspicious

manner; (noun) a fixed, intense, and prolonged gaze or look

synonym: gaze, look, gawk

(1) stare blankly, (2) give a menacing stare

He couldn't help but **stare** at the beautiful sunset over the ocean.

## disappear

v. to cease to exist or be visible

synonym: fade, evaporate, vanish

(1) **disappear** without a trace, (2) **disappear** after a week They watched the train **disappear** into the distance.

## pray

- v. to make a request or petition to a higher power, especially in the form of a respectful or humble request synonym: implore, supplicate, entreat
- (1) **pray** devoutly, (2) **pray** for rain

She closed her eyes and **prayed** for strength to overcome difficult times.

## missile

 a weapon, such as a rocket or guided projectile, that is self-propelled and directed by remote control or by an internal guidance mechanism

*synonym*: projectile, rocket, bomb

(1) **missile** defense, (2) cruise **missile** attack

The military launched a ballistic **missile** at the enemy's stronghold.

#### passe

adj. no longer fashionable or current; outdated; considered to be old-fashioned or out of date

synonym: outdated, old-fashioned, antique

(1) passe entertainment, (2) passe trend

Bell-bottom jeans, once considered **passe** fashion, have made a surprising comeback in recent years.

## guilty

adj. feeling responsible for or having done something wrong or criminal

synonym:

culpable, blameworthy, at fault

(1) feel a bit guilty, (2) guilty verdict

After much contemplation, the suspect decided to plead **guilty** to the theft charge.

beg

v. to ask for something urgently or earnestly; to appeal to someone to do something

*synonym*: plead, implore, entreat

(1) **beg** the question, (2) **beg** for help

She **begged** her parents to let her go to the concert.

#### nameless

adj. without a name or unknown; not named or identified synonym: anonymous, unknown, unidentified

(1) nameless fear, (2) nameless child

The victim could only describe their attacker as a **nameless** figure in the darkness.

## survivor

a person who remains alive after an event in which others have died

synonym: subsister

(1) ovarian cancer **survivor**, (2) a single **survivor**The shipwreck **survivor** was rescued after floating in the ocean for three days.

## refugee

 a displaced person who has crossed national borders and who cannot or is unwilling to return home due to political, religious, or economic reasons or because of a war

synonym: emigrant, evacuee, exile

(1) global **refugee** crisis, (2) the **refugee** camp The community warmly welcomed the **refugees**.

## stereotype

- n. a fixed and unvarying idea or image that people have about what someone or something is like, but which is often not true in reality and may cause hurt and offense
- (1) avoid **stereotype**, (2) negative **stereotypes**

Changing **stereotypes** about LGBTQ requires considerable effort.

#### tattered

 adj. worn, torn, or ragged in appearance or condition, usually as a result of long use or hard wear; frayed or falling apart

synonym: ripped, shabby, worn-out

(1) tattered clothes, (2) tattered umbrella

The **tattered** book was falling apart at the seams from being read too many times.

#### scared

adj. afraid or frightened

synonym: frightened, fearful, dreading

(1) scared all the time, (2) scared dog

I'm scared of insects.

## hop

 to jump lightly and quickly on one foot or both feet; to move rapidly from one place to another; to travel using an aircraft, bus, etc.

synonym: jump, bounce, skip

(1) **hop** on one foot, (2) **hop** from one place to another The rabbit **hopped** over the fence.

## accomplishment

n. the successful completion of a task or goal; an ability that has been acquired by training

synonym: success, achievement, complete

proud of his accomplishments, (2) the accomplishment of a social goal

Graduating from college was a major **accomplishment** for her.

## vision

 n. the ability to think about or see the future with imagination and intelligence; the faculty of being able to see

synonym: sight, image, concept

a prodigious vision,
 telescopic vision
 difficult for me because of my poor vision.

wit

n. the ability to say or write things or ideas in a clever and humorous way

synonym: humor, comedy, funniness

(1) the wit of man, (2) full of wit

He has the wit to keep talking about this topic.

explode

v. to burst or break open violently and noisily; to cause something to burst or break open

synonym: detonate, blast, rupture

(1) **explode** in anger, (2) **explode** in popularity

The old building **exploded** in a fiery inferno.

piercing

adj. going through something; appearing to notice things about another person that would typically go unnoticed, especially in a way that causes that individual to feel uncomfortable

synonym: sharp, acute, biting

(1) piercing laughter, (2) piercing pain

A piercing scream filled the room.

staccato

 adj. a style of musical performance or composition that involves playing each note separately and distinctly, with a sharp or abrupt tone; speech or writing that is abrupt or disjointed

synonym: abrupt, sharp, detached

(1) staccato rhythm, (2) staccato speech

The pianist played the piece with **staccato** notes, creating a lively and upbeat sound.

gunfire

 the sound or act of shooting a firearm; the noise created by multiple guns firing at the same time

synonym: gunshots, firing, shooting

(1) lethal **gunfire**, (2) burst of **gunfire** 

The journalist heard the sound of **gunfire** while reporting in a war zone.

#### wrench

v. to pull or twist something suddenly or violently

synonym: twist, turn, bend

(1) wrench off the lock, (2) wrench my back

A deep sigh was **wrenched** from his chest.

#### boom

 a sudden increase in economic activity, or a sudden happening that brings good fortune; a deep, loud, and prolonged sound

*synonym*: roaring, prosperity, boost

(1) boom in sales, (2) a sonic boom

The high-technology industry is enjoying a **boom**.

## ominous

adj. giving the impression that something bad is going to happen; foreboding

synonym: foreboding, portentous, ill-boding

(1) an **ominous** silence, (2) **ominous** sign

The **ominous** clouds in the sky foretold of an approaching storm.

## drone

 a low continuous humming noise; someone who takes more time than necessary; a pilot-less aerial vehicle that is operated by remote control

synonym: hum, whirr, idler

(1) **drone** flight, (2) the speaker's **drone** 

He heard a **drone** of sirens roar from the neighboring town.

jet

 a type of aircraft that is powered by one or more jet engines and can fly at high speeds, typically over long distances

synonym: plane, aircraft, flier

(1) private **jet**, (2) commercial **jet** 

The **jet** flew over the ocean at high speed, reaching its destination in hours.

#### overhead

 the expense of maintaining something that is involved in operating a business, such as rent and heating; (adverb) above your head; in the sky synonym: expense, upkeep, (adverb) aloft

(1) **overhead** capital, (2) a cloud passing **overhead** This merger will help them reduce **overhead** costs substantially.

wail

 to make a prolonged, high-pitched cry expressing grief, pain, or anger

synonym: moan, keen, lament

(1) wail in sorrow, (2) wail in pain

The baby **wailed** loudly, signaling its hunger.

warn

siren

v. to make someone aware of potential danger or difficulty, particularly one that may occur in the future

synonym: alert, caution, admonish

- (1) warn a reckless driver, (2) warned me of the plan I attempted to warn him, but he ignored me.
- a device that emits a loud, piercing sound, typically used as a warning or to get attention; historically, a creature in Greek mythology whose enchanting voice would lure sailors toward danger

synonym: alarm, warning, alert

(1) fire truck siren, (2) police siren

I heard the **siren** of an ambulance and moved my car to the side of the road.

dissonant

adj. sounds that are not in harmony or are in conflict with one another; an uncomfortable or tense feeling caused by conflicting ideas or emotions

synonym: discordant, harsh, inharmonious

(1) a dissonant voice, (2) dissonant note

The **dissonant** sound from the poorly tuned instruments was painful to listen to.

concert

 a musical performance given in public by one or more players or singers

synonym: gig, musical, show

(1) have a **concert** again, (2) a benefit **concert** This artist always packs the **concert** halls.

## flock

- n. a gathering of sheep, goats, or birdssynonym: herd, crowd, assembly
- (1) flock of sheep, (2) flock of spectatorWhen a flock of birds flies in, the hunt begins.

## screech

v. to make a loud, high-pitched, piercing sound, often indicating pain or fear

synonym: shriek, scream, yelp

(1) **screech** out a slogan, (2) **screech** with laughter The brakes on the car began to **screech** as the driver suddenly stopped at the intersection.

pitch

n. the property of sound that varies with variation in the frequency of vibration; the degree of a slope, especially of a roof; short presentation for selling or sharing something

synonym: angle, gradient, slope

(1) make a **pitch** for a new product, (2) a low- **pitched** sound

Her voice gradually increased in **pitch**.

#### thunderous

adj. producing or accompanied by a loud, deep, rumbling sound, like that of thunder; intense, forceful, or impressive

synonym: thundering, booming, loud

(1) thunderous roar, (2) thunderous noise

The **thunderous** applause lasted for several minutes after the performance.

#### unbearable

adj. not able to be tolerated or endured; too difficult, severe, or intense to be dealt with or suffered through; intolerable or insufferable

synonym: intolerable, insufferable, unendurable

(1) unbearable heat, (2) unbearable pain

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The loss of his wife was an **unbearable** sorrow that he found hard to overcome.

#### silent

adj. without any or little sound synonym: quiet, hushed, mute

(1) silent reading, (2) give silent consent

The politician remained **silent** despite intense media scrutiny.

## humanity

 all people living on the earth; the quality or state of being human rather than an animal, a machine, etc.

synonym: humankind, society, human race

(1) humanity at large, (2) mass of humanity

They donated large sums of money for the development of **humanity**.

## hero

 a person who is admired or idealized for courage, outstanding achievements, or noble qualities; a character in literature or history who is central to the plot and who exhibits heroic qualities

synonym: champion, protagonist, savior

(1) local hero, (2) unsung hero

The soldier who sacrificed his life for his country is considered a national **hero**.

#### scare

- v. to frighten a person or animal, or to become frightened synonym: frighten, spook, intimidate
- (1) **scare** off her attacker by screaming, (2) **scare** the birds away

We hit the ground to **scare** out the rabbits.

#### survive

- v. to live or exist despite a dangerous event or period synonym: endure, persist, stay
- survive a blizzard, (2) survive a plane crash
   These birds can only survive in temperate climates.

## besiege

v. to surround and attack or harass with relentless persistence; to crowd or overwhelm with a large number of requests or demands

synonym: beset, encircle, surround

(1) **besiege** a fortress, (2) **besiege** an enemy Enemy troops **besieged** the town during the war.

#### march

- v. to walk militarily with stiff, regular steps synonym: parade
- (1) **march** against the war, (2) **march** east The troops **marched** shoulder-to-shoulder.

### **bullet**

- n. a metal projectile that is shot from a gun synonym: projectile, slug, shot
- (1) **bullet** wound, (2) **bullet** train

  The stray **bullet** went through the window and hit the wall.

## discuss

v. to talk about or examine in detail through conversation or debate; to exchange ideas, opinions, or information on a particular topic

synonym: talk about, converse, debate

(1) discuss options, (2) discuss solutions

We need to **discuss** the next steps for the project during our meeting tomorrow.

#### consume

v. to spend something, especially fuel, energy, or time, in a large amount

synonym: absorb, ingest, use up

(1) **consume** a large of alcohol, (2) **consume** electricity A smaller car will **consume** less fuel.

## preoccupation

the state or condition of thinking about something continuously or obsessively

*synonym*: fetish, obsession, fixation

(1) **preoccupation** with work, (2) military **preoccupation**She has an obsessive **preoccupation** with weight and

shape.

## troop

a group of soldiers, especially a large one; a group of people, animals, or things considered as a unit.

synonym: group, unit, band

(1) the members of a military **troop**, (2) a **troop** of deer The **troop** of soldiers marched through the city in a parade.

## drawdown

the reduction or depletion of a resource, such as water, as a result of extraction or use; the act of withdrawing funds from an account or asset, typically associated with investment or borrowing

synonym: decline, reduction, decrease

(1) drawdown period, (2) investment drawdown The organization initiated a **drawdown** of resources from its disaster relief fund to assist the affected communities.

timeline

a series of events arranged in chronological order and displayed along a line, usually drawn left to right or top to bottom

*synonym*: agenda, timetable, chronology

- (1) **timeline** of science history, (2) lay out a **timeline** He imposed a **timeline** on the project.
- a sudden and great increase of something, such as a feeling, the amount or number, etc.

synonym: rush, spate, deluge

(1) a **surge** of shoppers, (2) the **surge** in foreign tourism She drowned her **surge** of anger through her creative work.

## sting

to cause a sharp, painful sensation or injury with a ν. poison, venom, or other substance or by a physical action such as a bite or prick

synonym: bite, prick, poke

(1) **sting** me on the arm, (2) **sting** his face Bees **sting** as a defense mechanism when they feel threatened.

## surge

## operate

- v. to work in a particular way; to supervise something synonym: work, use, employ
- (1) **operate** 24 hours a day, (2) manually **operate** a machine

This machine is too difficult to **operate** for me.

#### examine

v. to study or consider a person or object attentively and thoroughly to learn something about them

synonym: study, probe, analyze

(1) **examine** the data studiously, (2) **examine** the issue Initially, we must **examine** all project-related expenses.

fabric

 cloth or other material produced by weaving wool, cotton, silk, etc., used for making clothes, covering furniture, etc.

synonym: cloth, material, goods

(1) a hand-loomed **fabric**, (2) **fabric** of creation

These synthetic **fabrics** are used in military vests because of their excellent abrasion resistance.

## communal

adj. belonging to or used by a group rather than individuals;for common use

synonym: collaborative, combined, collective

(1) **communal** swimming pool, (2) **communal** combination of funds

**Communal** elections were held in several European countries.

## improvisation

n. the act of making something up on the spot or creating or performing something without preparation

synonym: spontaneity, ad-lib, extemporization

(1) **improvisation** on stage, (2) jazz **improvisation** He created a beautiful piece of music using only **improvisation**.

#### resilient

adj. able to withstand or recover quickly from difficult conditions

synonym: robust, sturdy, tough

(1) a hard and **resilient** steel, (2) **resilient** population She is a **resilient** person and has always bounced back from setbacks.

## amazing

courage

adj. extremely surprising, especially in a way that you like or admire

synonym: exceptional, extraordinary, wonderful

- (1) **amazing** advances, (2) the most **amazing** feeling The golfer recorded an **amazing** distance.
- n. the ability to face danger, difficulty, uncertainty, or pain without being overcome by fear or despair; the quality of being brave or courageous

synonym: bravery, valor, fearlessness

(1) mental courage, (2) inspire courage It takes a lot of **courage** to stand up for what you believe is right.

## objective

a goal, aim, or purpose that is intended or sought after; a goal that is based on facts, evidence, or unbiased reasoning rather than personal opinions, feelings, or beliefs; (adjective) of or relating something that is based on facts and not influenced by personal feelings or biases

synonym: goal, purpose, aim

(1) **objective** assessment, (2) financial **objective** The study's main **objective** is to identify risk factors for heart disease.

tactics

the methods or strategies used to achieve a specific goal or outcome, particularly in the context of military, business, or sports

synonym: strategy, maneuvers, plan

(1) blitz tactics, (2) political tactics

The marketing team developed new **tactics** to boost sales.

## doll

 a child's toy that typically represents a human figure, especially a young girl; an attractive woman; a woman who is subservient or passive

synonym: puppet, dolly, toy

(1) plastic **doll**, (2) rag **doll** 

The antique **doll** was worth thousands of dollars.

## casualty

 a person who has been killed or injured in a war, accident, or other disasters; a victim

synonym: victim, injured, fatality

(1) civilian casualty, (2) military casualty

Unfortunately, the driver was the only **casualty** in the car accident.

#### sterile

adj. free from living microorganisms, especially bacteria, fungi, and viruses; incapable of reproducing

synonym: clean, germ-free, hygienic

(1) **sterile** environment, (2) a **sterile** man

Surgeons must use **sterile** instruments to prevent infection during an operation.

#### casual

adj. relaxed and informal in manner or dress, not planned or expected; not involving commitment or seriousness

synonym: informal, relaxed, offhand

(1) casual dress, (2) take a casual glance

They had a **casual** conversation over coffee at the local cafe.

#### context

 the circumstances, facts, or conditions that surround a particular event, situation, or statement and that give it meaning

synonym: background, setting, environment

(1) historical **context**, (2) legal **context** 

It's important to understand the **context** of a situation before making a decision.

## topic

n. a subject that is being discussed or written aboutsynonym: subject, theme, issue

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(1) a serious **topic**, (2) the **topic** of the book

The **topic** of the discussion was the current state of the economy.

#### conceive

 to have or develop an idea, a plan, etc. in mind; to become pregnant

synonym: imagine, envision, concoct

(1) **conceive** of an idea, (2) **conceive** a child I can't **conceive** he'd want to harm us.

## rap

 a type of music characterized by a strong, repetitive beat and lyrics that often focus on social and political issues; a reproach for some lapse or misdeed

synonym: hip-hop, emceeing, MCing

(1) rap music, (2) get a rap

The new rap album is getting a lot of attention.

## inevitable

adj. certain to happen and unavoidable synonym: inescapable, unavoidable, sure

(1) **inevitable** changes of the seasons, (2) **inevitable** result In times of recession, an increase in unemployment is **inevitable**.

#### modern

adj. of or belonging to the present time or recent times synonym: contemporary, stylish, current

(1) **modern** poetry, (2) pre- **modern** agricultural society Their headquarters are in a **modern** skyscraper.

#### civilian

 a person who is not a member of the military or armed forces; a person who is not a law enforcement officer or public official in a position of authority or responsibility

synonym: citizen, inhabitant, resident

(1) civilian casualties, (2) civilian life

The army is instructed not to target any **civilians** during the conflict.

## mutilate

v. to cause severe damage, disfigurement, or injury, usually to a person or an animal; to destroy, alter, or damage something severely or irreparably

synonym: maim, disfigure, deform

(1) mutilate a document, (2) mutilate a body

It is cruel for anyone to **mutilate** an animal for any reason.

## numb

adj. unable to feel physical sensation and movement; not showing human feeling or sensitivity

*synonym*: dazed, insensitive, emotionless

(1) **numb** with cold, (2) a **numb** mind

My left arm became **numb**.

#### refer

v. to direct someone's attention, thoughts, or questions to another source or person; to mention, cite, or allude to something as evidence or support

synonym: cite, allude, mention

(1) refer to a book, (2) refer to a map

Please **refer** to the instruction manual for further assistance.

## increasingly

adv. more and more

*synonym*: more and more, progressively

(1) **increasingly** become common, (2) face **increasingly** complicated challenges

Our company found it **increasingly** difficult to keep up with the competition.

#### peer

n. a person who has the same age, status, or ability

synonym: fellow, associate, counterpart

(1) **peer** group, (2) **peer** review

Among young people, **peer** pressure can be pretty influential.

## perceive

v. to become aware or conscious of something through the senses

synonym: sense, discern, feel

(1) perceive a threat, (2) perceive light

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Australia is widely **perceived** as having low levels of corruption.

#### unseen

adj. not seen or noticed; not perceived synonym: invisible, hidden, undercover

(1) unseen danger, (2) an unseen force

The consequences of the pandemic remain **unseen** as scientists continue to research the virus.

#### conduct

- v. to organize and carry out a particular activity synonym: behave, lead, carry on
- (1) **conduct** a background check, (2) **conduct** research Police will **conduct** random breath testing for drunk driving.

## orchestra

 a large group of musicians who play classical music together, usually with instruments such as strings, woodwinds, brass, and percussion

synonym: ensemble, symphony, band

(1) full **orchestra**, (2) **orchestra** conductor The accomplished **orchestra** will give two more performances this week.

## relation

 the way two persons or groups of people feel and act toward one another

*synonym*: association, linkage, connection

(1) **relation** between cause and effect, (2) **relation** of inclusion

The industrial **relations** laws were passed with little to no alteration.

## villager

 a person who lives in a village or small rural community;
 a person who is part of a close-knit and traditional community

synonym: resident, inhabitant, countryperson

(1) villager community, (2) local villager

The rural villagers were saddened by the destruction of their

homes in the natural disaster.

#### extremist

nation

 a person who holds extreme political or religious views and who is willing to use violent or illegal methods to promote those views

synonym: radical, fanatic, zealot

- (1) **extremist** political views, (2) radical **extremist**The **extremist** group planned a series of violent attacks to push its agenda.
- a large organized community of people living in a particular country or region and having a particular culture

synonym: country, state, sovereign entity

(1) **nation-state**, (2) a seafaring **nation**The **nation** of Japan is known for its unique culture and advanced technology.

## leadership

*n*. the ability, act, or status of leading a group of people or an organization

*synonym*: captaincy, direction, initiative

(1) under his **leadership**, (2) **leadership** by politicians The country's **leadership** has decided to take large-scale measures against global warming.

## checkmate

v. to win a game of chess by putting the opponent's king in a position where it is unable to escape capture; to defeat or frustrate an opponent entirely; (noun) a situation where one person or side has put another in a position where they cannot escape defeat

*synonym*: outwit, outmaneuver, defeat

- (1) **checkmate** with a pawn, (2) a **checkmate** situation The chess player carefully planned his moves to **checkmate** his opponent in just a few moves.
- a sudden short attack, usually by soldiers, ships, or aircraft

## raid

synonym: attack, invasion, aggression

(1) make a **raid** on an enemy's camp, (2) air- **raid** siren Throughout the **raid**, the bank robbers wore masks.

## electrify

v. to make a machine or system work by using electricity; to make someone extremely enthusiastic about or interested in something

synonym: wire, amaze, astonish

(1) **electrify** the audience, (2) **electrify** a manufacturing process

The product developed through years of research continues to **electrify** the market.

## puppet

 a doll or figure that is manipulated by strings, wires, or hands to represent a person or animal; a person who is controlled or manipulated by someone else

synonym: marionette, dummy, mannequin

(1) puppet theater, (2) corporate puppet

The politician was merely a **puppet** for the wealthy elite.

### broth

 a liquid in which meat, fish, or vegetables have been cooked, used as a base for soups and stews

*synonym*: bouillon, consomme, soup

(1) chicken **broth**, (2) remains of **broth** 

I always add a bit of **broth** to my soup to give it more flavor.

## snipe

 to make a sly or spiteful remark, often in a concealed or indirect way; to target someone with an unfair or unwarranted attack or criticism

synonym: criticize, disparage, sharpshoot

(1) **snipe** at the suspect, (2) **snipe** at each other The politician **sniped** at his opponent during the debate.

violin

 a four-stringed wooden musical instrument held against the neck and played by passing a bow across the strings

synonym: fiddle

(1) violin soloist, (2) play the violin

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The cello is a member of the **violin** family.

cello

 a large stringed instrument of the viola family, typically held between the knees when played; also known as violoncello

synonym: violoncello, violincello

(1) the beautiful sound of a **cello**, (2) **cello** music She played a passionate solo on her **cello**.

duration

- n. the length of time something lasts or continuessynonym: period, span, course
- (1) the duration of insurance, (2) short durationThe military incarcerated him for the duration of the war.

stud

a small object with a head on one end and a sharp point on the other, used for fastening clothing, leather, or other materials; an animal used for breeding, typically a male horse or bull that is of superior breeding stock; (verb) to decorate or adorn with studs; to provide with studs for support

synonym: beam, scantling, framing

(1) horse **stud**, (2) wall **stud** 

He bought a new **stud** to attach the strap to his watch.

glove

 a piece of clothing worn on the hand and wrist for protection against cold, dirt, etc., with separate parts for each finger

synonym: mitt

(1) a right-hand **glove**, (2) 5-finger **glove**She was wearing a black **glove**.

resistance

 the act of defending oneself from an aggressor or refusing to accept something

synonym: opposition, antagonism, defiance

(1) **resistance** movement, (2) **resistance** to insulin The bill to increase the consumption tax had passed despite much **resistance** from the public.

#### cease

v. to stop an action or event

synonym: stop, end, terminate

(1) cease to exist, (2) cease drinking

The company decided to **cease** production of the product.

#### violet

adj. between blue and purple in hue

synonym: purple

(1) bluish- violet, (2) violet quartz

Red and **violet** are opposites on the color spectrum.

## genocide

the intentional killing of a large group of people,
 especially those of a particular ethnic group or nation
